RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

23RD NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL -- Second Year, 2016

AN ACTION

RELATING TO LAW AND ORDER, HEALTH, EDUCATION AND HUMAN SERVICES, AND NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEES AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; AMENDING NAVAJO NATION CODE, TITLE 2 AT 2 N.N.C. § 403 TO CHANGE THE REGULAR MEETING DAY OF THE HEALTH, EDUCATION AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE FROM WEDNESDAY TO MONDAY, EXCEPT THE FIRST MONDAY OF EACH MONTH

BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Findings

- A. The Navajo Nation empowered the Navajo Nation Law and Order Committee to review and recommend proposed Navajo Nation Code enactments and amendments. 2 N.N.C. § 601(B)(14); see also CJA-03-13.
- B. The Navajo Nation Council Speaker shall assign "[a] proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council to...the Naabik'íyáti' Committee." 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(9); see also CJA-03-13.
- C. This resolution proposes a positive law amendment and requires the Navajo Nation Council's approval. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(9)(2012) and 2 N.N.C. § 164(A); see also CJA-03-13.
- D. It is in the best interests of the Navajo Nation to change the regular meeting date of the Health, Education and Human Services Committee from Wednesday each week to Monday each week, except the first Monday of each month, as it is more convenient for the Committee and so that the Committee may conduct business more effectively.

Section Two. Amendments to Title 2 of the Navajo Nation Code

The Navajo Nation hereby amends the Navajo Nation Code, Title 2, § 403 as follows:

TITLE 2. NAVAJO NATION GOVERNMENT

CHAPTER 3. LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

SUBCHAPTER 9. STANDING COMMITTEES

Article 2. Health, Education and Human Services Committee

* * *

§ 403. Meetings

Except when the Navajo Nation Council is in session, all regular meetings of the Committee shall be held on Monday of each week, except the first Monday of each month.

* * *

Section Three. Effective Date

The Navajo Nation Code amendment enacted herein shall be effective pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 221(B).

Section Four. Codification

The provisions of this Act which amend or adopt new sections of the Navajo Nation Code shall be codified by the Office of Legislative Counsel. The Office of Legislative Counsel shall incorporate such amended provisions in the next codification of the Navajo Nation Code.

Section Five. Savings Clause

Should any provisions of this ordinance be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation, without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those portions of this ordinance which are not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.
