AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BUDGET AND FINANCE, RESOURCES
AND DEVELOPMENT, AND NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEES, AND
THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING \$200,000 FROM
THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE ("UUF")
FOR THE SAWMILL CHAPTER RENOVATION PROJECT

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Budget and Finance Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council with the authority to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the management of all funds, which includes the Navajo Nation's Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance ("UUF"). 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(9); 2 N.N.C. §300(A); 2 N.N.C. §301(B)(2).
- B. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council with oversight authority over Navajo Nation Chapters. 2 N.N.C. §500(C) and 26 N.N.C. §102.
- C. The Navajo Nation established the Naabik'iyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee, and all proposed legislation requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Council is assigned to the Naabik'iyáti' Committee for its review. 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(9) and 2 N.N.C. §700(A).

1 D. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §102(A).
2 As such, the Council “. . . may adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual
3 Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds
4 within the current fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above
5 and beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in
6 excess of the reserve amount set forth at §820(J).” 12 N.N.C. §820(L). Generally,
7 supplemental funding is appropriated from the UUFB.

8 E. The Title 12 restrictions on supplemental appropriations from the UUFB, include:

- 9 1. Payment of recurring government operating expenses shall be from recurring revenues,
10 and payment of nonrecurring expenses shall be from nonrecurring revenues such as UUFB
11 funds. 12 N.N.C. §820(E); 12 N.N.C. §820(F).
- 12 2. Specifically, the UUFB shall not be used for recurring government expenditures or
13 operations. 12 N.N.C. §820(J); 12 N.N.C. §820(L).
- 14 3. Nonrecurring revenues such as UUFB funds may be used only after the Controller
15 determines whether or not such revenues are subsidizing an imbalance between the
16 Navajo Nation’s recurring revenues and expenditures, and government expenditures shall
17 only be authorized if a long-term (3-year to 5-year year) forecast shows that the operating
18 deficit will not continue; otherwise, nonrecurring revenues will be added to the
19 Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance. 12 N.N.C. §820(F).
- 20 4. The above provisions in Title 12 may be amended or waived by a two-thirds vote of the
21 full membership of the Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. §820(F); 12 N.N.C. §880.
- 22 5. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820(F) all UUFB funding requests must be reviewed by the
23 Controller. Such review is also required because the Controller determines which
24 revenues and expenses are recurring and which are non-recurring. 12 N.N.C. §820(L).
- 25 6. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820(M) all UUFB funding requests must be submitted to the
26 Office of Management and Budget (“OMB”) for a budget impact analysis.

27 28 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

29 A. The Capital Management Department within the Division of Community Development
30 (“CPMD”) and the Sawmill Chapter are requesting \$200,000 to cover the funding shortfall

1 for the Sawmill Chapter Renovation Project (Phase 2).

2 B. In Resolution No. SAW-04-25-22-02 the Chapter explains that the Navajo Nation Council
3 appropriated \$500,000 for this Project in Resolution No. CHA-04-22. However, the
4 President vetoed this appropriation on February 13, 2022. Resolution No. SAW-04-25-22-
5 02 is attached hereto as **EXHIBIT A**.

6 C. In Resolution No. SAW-04-25-22-01 the Chapter gives a line-item listing of the Chapter's
7 needed expenditures that total approximately \$200,000. **EXHIBIT B**.

8 D. CPMD has provided an Appendix K "Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary" for this
9 UUFB funding request, along with completed and signed Budget Forms 1, 2, and 4, and a
10 Project Process Schedule. **EXHIBIT C**.

11 E. An itemized and detailed Scope of Work and Schedule of Values for this Project is attached
12 as **EXHIBIT D**.

13 F. The Office of the Controller's memorandum required by 12 N.N.C. §820(L) is attached as
14 **EXHIBIT E**. The Controller has indicated that FMD's proposed expenditures are considered
15 "non-recurring" expenses.

16 G. The Office of Management and Budget has provided a budget impact analysis as required by
17 12 N.N.C. § 820(M). **EXHIBIT F**.

19 **SECTION THREE. APPROPRIATING \$200,000 FROM THE UUFB FOR THE**
20 **SAWMILL CHAPTER RENOVATION PROJECT**

21 A. The Navajo Nation hereby appropriates \$200,000 from the UUFB to the Capital
22 Management Projects Department for its use in completing the Sawmill Chapter Renovation
23 Project, as described in the attached **EXHIBIT C** and **EXHIBIT D**.

24 B. This supplemental appropriation shall be from those funds that exceed the minimum fund
25 reserve balance in the UUFB required by 12 N.N.C. §820(J), as determined by the Controller.

26 C. This supplemental appropriation shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year, as would
27 otherwise occur pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820(N). However, any UUFB funds not spent or
28 encumbered within twenty-four (24) months of the date the funds are provided to CPMD
29 shall immediately revert to the UUFB, unless otherwise approved by both the Resources and
30 Development Committee and the Naabik'íyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council.

1 **SECTION FIVE. EFFECTIVE DATE**

2 This Act shall become effective as provided in 2 N.N.C. §221(B) and 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(17).
3

4 **SECTION SIX. SAVING CLAUSE**

5 If any portion of this Act is determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or by a
6 District Court of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the
7 remainder of this Act shall be the law of the Navajo Nation.

Requesting the Resources and Development Committee, Budget & Finance Committee, Naabik'iyati Committee and the Navajo Nation Council to appropriate \$200,00.00 from the Undesigned Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB) for the planning and construction of the Sawmill Chapter renovation project phase II.

WHEREAS:

1. The Sawmill Chapter, a recognized certified local government of the Navajo Nation, vested with the power and authority to advocate on behalf of its constituents for the improvement of health, education, safety, and general welfare; and
2. The Resources and Development Committee is a Standing Committee of the Navajo Nation Council with statutory authority over the Division of Community Development and the local Chapters; and
3. The Budget and Finance Committee was established as a Standing Committee of the Navajo Nation Council with the authority to review and recommend to the Council the budgeting, appropriation, investment and management of all funds; and
4. The Naabik'iyati' Committee was established as a Standing Committee of the Navajo Nation Council with authority to hear all proposed resolutions requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Council; and
5. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation as such, the Council may adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in excess of the reserve amount; and
6. The Sawmill Chapter pursuant to chapter resolution SAW-07-19-21-06, requested the Budget and Finance Committee, Resources and Development Committee, Capital Project Management Department and the Navajo Nation Council to appropriate funds of \$400,000.00 from the Navajo Nation Sihsin funds for the Phase II of the chapter renovation project; and
7. The Navajo Nation Council on January 26, 2022 approved legislation CJA-04-22 to appropriate \$500,000.00 to Capital Projects Management Department (CPMD) for the Planning and Construction of the Sawmill Chapter renovation project, Phase II; and
8. The Office of the President / Vice President on February 13, 2022 exercise its line-item veto on legislation CJA-04-22 and recommending to the Navajo Nation Council to utilize federal funds for the project; and
9. The Sawmill Chapter and Capital Projects Management Department (CPMD) is continuing to pursuant the project and is determined to utilized its chapter FY2021

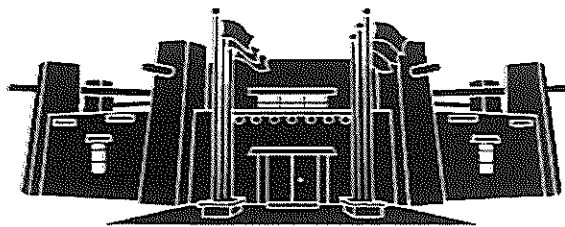
The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) reviewed the proposed budget document and provides the following:

1. The FY 2022 Budget Instructions Manual, Section XII (the Supplemental Funding Request Procedures), states the Navajo Nation Leadership should carefully weigh the laws, priorities and any extenuating circumstances before consideration of supplemental funding requests. Further, the Nation is to consider court mandates, required matching funds, the health and safety of the general public, emergency situations, unmet needs, and other extenuating circumstances, which may arise during the fiscal year.
2. During the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget Process, there was approximately \$24 million in Unmet Needs supported by the Legislative Oversight Committees. The SAWMILL CHAPTER RENOVATION is not a part of the Unmet Needs.
3. Review of Budget Forms. The forms are sufficient contingent upon the following:
 - a. Appendix K, Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary should be signed by the President, or designee, indicating support of the funding proposal in accordance with #1 above.
 - b. If the funding is approved, the budget will be set up as a project so the funds are available beyond fiscal year end. DCD/CPMD will administer the project.
4. According to the Controller, the UUFb (Undesignated, Unreserved Fund Balance) is \$19,966,288 as of June 08, 2022.
5. Based on the above, the document is sufficient.
6. Another potential fund source is the Sihasin Fund. The Division of Community Development should advise on this.






