

**RESOLUTION OF THE
RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE
of the 25th NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - First Year, 2023**

AN ACTION

RELATING TO THE RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE; APPROVING AND RECOMMENDING TO THE BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE DIVISION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND RELATED MATTERS, TO BE INCLUDED IN THE NAVAJO NATION'S FY2024 COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council with oversight authority over the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development. 2 N.N.C. §500(A); 2 N.N.C. §501(C)(1).
- B. The Resources and Development Committee shall review and make recommendations regarding the programs under its oversight responsibility, regarding the Navajo Nation's Comprehensive Budget for the upcoming Fiscal Year. 12 N.N.C. §840(A).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. Oversight Committee recommendations shall not exceed the base planning amounts established in the FY2024 Budget Instructions Manual. 12 N.N.C. §840(A). The base planning amounts were established by the Budget and Finance Committee in the FY2024 Budget Instructions Manual through Resolution No. BFJY-15-23.
- B. The Resources and Development Committee held budget meetings and heard reports from Program staff and the Office of Management and Budget regarding the proposed FY2024 Budget for the Division of Community Development. 12 N.N.C. §840(A).
- C. The Resources and Development Committee reviewed and considered the proposed FY2024 Budget for the Division of Community Development, as compared to the base planning amounts established in the FY2024 Budget Instructions Manual and as recommended by the Office of Management and Budget.

- D. The Resources and Development Committee finds that approval of the proposed FY2024 Budget for the Division of Community Development and inclusion of such Budget in the Navajo Nation's FY2024 Comprehensive Budget is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation.

SECTION THREE. APPROVING AND RECOMMENDING TO THE BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE DIVISION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND RELATED MATTERS

- A. The Resources and Development Committee hereby approves the FY2024 Budget for the Division of Community Development, as detailed in the "Fund Type Budget Summary" attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
- B. The Resources and Development Committee hereby approves certain revisions to the Branch Chiefs' proposed FY2024 Budget amount for the Division of Community Development, as shown in Columns D and E in the "General Fund Comparative Summary" attached hereto as **Exhibit B**.
- C. The Resources and Development Committee recommends the changes to the General Fund Budget described in **Exhibit C**.
- D. The Resources and Development Committee recommends certain Conditions of Appropriation and Legislative Concerns, as listed in **Exhibit D**.
- E. The Resources and Development Committee recommends that certain Unmet Needs for the Division of Community Development be included in the FY2024 Comprehensive Budget, as explained in **Exhibit E**.
- F. The Resources and Development Committee recommends that the Budget and Finance Committee approve the Division of Community Development's FY2024 Budget and all Committee recommendations as set forth in **Exhibits A-E**.
- G. The Resources and Development Committee hereby authorizes the Chairwoman and the Vice-Chairman to negotiate with the Budget and Finance Committee on these recommendations.

SECTION FOUR. DIRECTIVE


The Division of Community Development Administration is hereby directed to research and develop a plan to decrease the number of Administrative Service Centers (ASC) from the current number of eight ASCs to five ASCs. The plan should include a description of the geographic service areas the five ASCs would serve. The Division of Community Development Administration is further directed to provide a cost-benefit analysis of changing the number of ASC offices from eight offices to five offices. The analysis should include cost of maintaining the offices. The Division of Community Development Administration shall present its research and plan as a report to the Resources and Development Committee by the end of the 2nd Quarter of FY2024.

SECTION FIVE. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Action shall become effective as provided in 2 N.N.C. §189(A).

Additional funding will replenish the personnel budget and continued service delivery to the local communities, with no interruption in chapter services.
108128	Navajo Nation Addressing Authority	137,025	The newly created Navajo Nation Addressing Authority is in need of two essential personnel positions, a full-time Department Manager I to oversee the department and a full-time Office Specialist for administrative support. With the additional two positions, the department will be able to strategize and seek resources, partnership, and network with local communities to identify & name roads, and ultimately enable the 9-1-1 system. Because a 9-1-1 address identifies the physical location of a caller on a road, the emergency responders (EMS, Fire, and Sheriff) are able to locate the caller much easier and quicker in an emergency, saving precious time and often lives. 1) Department Manager I Salary \$66,670 Fringe Benefits \$28,921 = \$95,591 2) Office Specialist Salary \$28,898 Fringe Benefits \$12,536 = \$41,434


