**PURPOSE:** To approve the reinstatement of Louise Rae Pavinyama as a member of the Navajo Nation.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

18	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY
19	A. Under the laws of the Navajo Nation, any enrolled member of the Navajo Nation may
20	renounce [her] membership by written petition to the President of the Navajo Nation
21	requesting that his name be stricken from the Navajo Nation roll. See 1 N.N.C. § 705
22	(Renunciation of membership).
23	B. The Navajo Nation in addition states, "[n]o person, otherwise eligible for membership
24	in the Navajo Nation, may enroll as a member of the Navajo Nation, who, at the same
25	time, is on the roll of any other tribe of Indians." See 1 N.N.C. § 703 (Member of
26	another tribe).
27	C. Renounced members may be reinstated by the Navajo Nation only by the vote of
28	majority of the Navajo Nation Council. See 1 N.N.C. § 705 (Renunciation of
29	membership).

# SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

A. The Navajo Nation Office of Vital Records confirmed Louise Rae Pavinyama (Ms. Pavinyama) was enrolled with the Navajo Nation on July 14, 1971, with blood quantum one-half Navajo and one-half Hopi. See Memorandum dated February 26, 2021 authored by Ronald D. Duncan, Program Manager I, Navajo Nation of Vital Records as Exhibit A.

- B. The Hopi Tribe furnished the Navajo Nation a letter verifying Louise Rae Pavinyama was eligible to enroll in the Hopi Tribe. See Letter dated October 28, 2003 authored by Mary L. Polacca, Director of the Hopi Tribal Enrollment Office as Exhibit B.
- C. The Navajo Nation Office of Vital Records confirmed Louise Rae Pavinyama requested relinquishment of her Navajo membership on November 3, 2003. *See* Letter Requesting Relinquishment as **Exhibit C.**
- D. The Navajo Nation Office of Vital Records confirmed Louise Rae Pavinyama completed a Section 164 Review Process. See Section 164 Review Process # 17275 as
   Exhibit D.
- E. The Navajo Nation Office of Vital Records confirmed Louise Rae Pavinyama relinquished her Navajo membership on February 13, 2004 for the purpose of enrolling in the Hopi tribe. See Membership Relinquishment form endorsed by Navajo Nation President Joe Shirley as Exhibit E.
- F. The Navajo Nation Office of Vital Records has further confirmed Louise Rae Pavinyama is one-half (1/2) Navajo blood and eligible to enroll as a member of the Navajo Nation. 1 N.N.C. § 701 (B).

G. The Hopi Tribe has confirmed Louise Rae Pavinyama formally relinquished her Hopi Tribal Membership on March, 5, 2020, for the purpose of applying for a home-site lease and land. See Notarized Hopi Tribe Relinquishment Statement and Notice of Relinquishment as Exhibit F.

 H. The Hopi Tribe has confirmed Louise Rae Pavinyama was provided a formal Notice of Relinquishment herein as Exhibit G. I. Louise Rae Pavinyama has formally requested reinstatement as a Navajo Nation tribal member. See letter authored by Louise Rae Pavinyama dated December 9, 2020 as Exhibit H.

#### SECTION THREE. REENROLLMENT

Louise Rae Pavinyama is and shall be reinstated, or otherwise reenrolled, as a member of the Navajo Nation. By this action of the Navajo Nation Council and pursuant to the laws of the Navajo Nation, she shall be entitled to all rights, benefits and privileges associated with membership with the Navajo Nation.

This memorandum is to verify the enrollment and subsequent relinquishment of Louise Rae Pavinyama, date of birth June 28, 1971.

Ms. Pavinyama enrolled with the Navajo Nation on July 14, 1971 with enrollment number Her blood quantum is one-half Navajo and one-half Hopi. Ms. Pavinayama petitioned for relinquishment from the Navajo Nation through the Section 164 Review Process, #17275, with the intent to enroll with the Hopi tribe.

Relinquishment occurred on February 13, 2004 upon the signature of Joe Shirley, President. Relevant documents from that time are attached for reference in her current request for reinstatement to the Navajo Nation.

Pursuant to Title 1, § 703, no person may enroll as a member of the Navajo Nation who is on the roll of another Indian tribe. In this instance, Ms. Pavinyama would need to demonstrate that she has relinquished from the Hopi tribe. Should she be reinstated to the Navajo Nation, Ms. Pavinyama original enrollment number would be restored to her.







The Hopi Enrollment Ordinance #33, Section 11.1 (A) states "Any adult member who decides to relinquish his or her membership from the Hopi Tribe shall so notify the Hopi Tribal Enrollment Office in writing, stating the reasons for relinquishment. The relinquishment shall be effective as of the date of its receipt by the Enrollment Office, unless the relinquishment itself states otherwise. The Enrollment Office shall provide a copy of the notice of relinquishment to the Hopi Tribal Council and to the member's Village affiliation. Only an adult member of the Hopi Tribe may relinquish his or her membership."



I feel it is not only unfair but it is not right that Louise Rae Pavinyama re-enroll into the Navajo Nation. I say this without prejudice. I make this statement because her only reason to make the re-enrollment request is to obtain a Homesite lease. Which I, myself a full navajo has yet to receive and if Council is to approve her request then they are setting an example. The example being that any Tribe should they be part navajo relinquish their tribal enrollment and only return to be approved for a homesite lease, for about 5 years maybe less. The newly enrolled navajo may opted out, of the navajo nation again and keep the land as a Hopi or another tribe. It's like giving away our precious Navajo Land so the individual may claim Navajo, only for a short period of time before claiming their real tribe. I do not stand behind my Navajo Nation losing land to another tribe because for a short time that New Member decided to be Navajo for 5 years or less. It is not feasible especially since there is still a HOPI and Navajo Land Dispute.
