## SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has legislative oversight over the Navajo Nation Division of Economic Development. See 2 N.N.C. § 501 (C)(1).
B. A proposed resolution requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. See 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A) (9).

## SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

A. The President appoints a person as the Navajo Nation Division of Economic Development Division Director. See 2 N.N.C. \$1503.
B. The Navajo Nation Council confirms the Presidential appointment, who serves at the pleasure of the President of the Navajo Nation. See 2 N.N.C. § 1503.
