#### 25TH NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - First Year, 2023

#### AN ACTION

RELATING TO THE BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE; APPROVING AND ESTABLISHING THE COMMITTEE'S PRIORITIES FOR THE FOUR-YEAR TERM OF THE  $25^{\text{TH}}$  NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

#### BE IT ENACTED:

#### SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Budget and Finance Committee ("BFC") is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council that is authorized to review, and make recommendations concerning budgeting and management of all Navajo Nation funds. 2 N.N.C. § 300(A), 2 N.N.C. § 301(B)(2).
- B. The BFC also coordinates, oversees, and regulates the Navajo Nation's financial, investment, contracting, and audit policies. 2 N.N.C. § 300(A), 2 N.N.C. § 300(C)(1).
- C. The BFC is extensively involved in the Navajo Nation's annual Comprehensive Budget process. 12 N.N.C. §830 and §840.
- D. The BFC has authority over the Navajo Nation's Procurement Regulations, as delegated by the Navajo Nation Council in the Navajo Nation Procurement Act. 12 N.N.C. § 320(A).

#### SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

A. The BFC met on May 16, 2023 and the Committee members discussed and deliberated on the BFC's overall priorities for matters within the Committee's authority.

The Committee members agreed upon the following list of overall priorities, as shown in the attached **EXHIBIT 1**, titled: "25<sup>th</sup> Navajo Nation Council Budget and Finance Committee Priorities:"

- 1. procurement reform;
- 2. appropriation reform;
- 3. prioritize funding based on return on investment;
- 4. eliminate earmarks:
- 5. identify and act upon revenue streams.

## SECTION THREE. APPROVING AND ESTABLISING THE COMMITTEE'S PRIORITIES FOR THE FOUR-YEAR TERM OF THE 25<sup>TH</sup> NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

- A. The Budget and Finance Committee hereby approves and establishes the Committee's priorities, as shown above and in the attached **EXHIBIT 1**, titled: "25<sup>th</sup> Navajo Nation Council Budget and Finance Committee Priorities."
- B. The EXHIBIT 1 list of priorities shall remain in effect during the term of the 25<sup>th</sup> Navajo Nation Council unless and until the BFC rescinds or amends the list.

#### SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Action shall become effective pursuant to 2 N.N.C. \$ 301, and 2 N.N.C. \$ 221(C).
