PURPOSE: This resolution, if approved, will approve supplemental funding from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance for home renovation or replacement in the Former Bennett Freeze Area and waive certain sections of the Finance Act related to capital improvement.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committee. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each committee member to review the proposed resolution in detail.

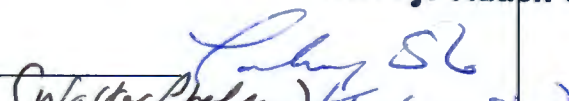

AREA AND WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820 AND 860

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS

- A. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), "[t]he Navajo Nation Council may adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in excess of the reserve amount set forth at § 820(J)."
- B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(9), a proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee before it is heard by the Navajo Nation Council.

- 1 C. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 300 (C)(1)(3) and (4) the Budget and Finance Committee is
2 authorized to recommend adoption of resolutions related to the expenditure of the
3 Nation's financial resources.
- 4 D. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 501 (C)(1), the Resources and Development Committee
5 exercises oversight authority over chapter activities, and economic and community
6 development, for the purpose of establishing Navajo Nation policy with respect to the
7 optimum utilization of all Navajo Nation resources and to protect the rights, interests,
8 sacred sites and freedoms of the Navajo Nation and People to such resources, now
9 and for future generations; and to promote, review, coordinate and approve projects to
10 be financed by funds designed for capital improvement.
- 11 E. The Navajo Nation President and Vice-President, on two separate trips, visited
12 impacted Chapters on the Former Bennett Freeze Area in October 2015 and as a
13 result of the visits launched the Former Bennett Freeze Area Action Team whose
14 short term focus is on the immediate rehabilitation of homes in the impacted
15 communities.
- 16 F. The existing housing units in the impacted Chapters are in need of renovation or
17 replacement and will be categorized by Major Repair Work, Modernization of
18 Existing Homes, and Replacement of Existing Homes.
- 19 G. The proposed budget for the renovation or replacement of existing housing units in
20 the Former Bennett Freeze Area is One Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars
21 (\$1,600,000). FY 2016 Budget forms attached as Exhibit A.
- 22 H. The Title 12 Finance Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:
- 23 1. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), all requests for annual operating funds and
24 supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and
25 Budget ("OMB") for budget impact analysis. A preview of the appropriation
26 legislation is available to the OMB for their budget impact analysis response.
- 27 2. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(L), when the Controller identifies additional
28 sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue
29 projections, supplemental appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo
30

1 Nation Council. The attached memorandum, Exhibit B, from the Office of the
2 Controller has identified the additional revenues.

3 I. The Title 12 Capital Improvement Process includes:

4 1. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 810(F), "Capital Improvement" means a major
5 project undertaken by the Navajo Nation that is generally not recurring on
6 an annual basis and which fits within one or more of the following
7 categories:

8 (1) All projects requiring debt obligation or borrowing;

9 (2) Any acquisition or lease of land;

10 (3) Purchase of major equipment or vehicles, with a life expectancy of five
11 years or more, valued in excess of an amount to be established by the
12 Controller;

13 (4) Major building improvements that are not routine maintenance expenses
14 and that substantially enhance the value or extend the useful life of a
15 structure;

16 (5) Construction of new buildings or facilities including engineering,
17 design, and other pre-construction costs with an estimated cost in excess
18 of an amount to be determined by the Controller; and/or

19 (6) Major equipment or furnishing required to furnish new buildings or
20 other projects, the cost of which is above a certain amount to be
21 established by the Controller.

22 2. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (I), the "[d]evelopment of the Capital Budget
23 shall be coordinated with development of the Operating Budget. All budget
24 requests for capital improvements shall be in compliance with an adopted
25 Capital Improvement Plan and shall not be approved unless in compliance
26 with the Plan."

27 3. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (M), the Office of Management and Budget
28 shall coordinate the overall preparation, adoption and implementation of
29 both the annual operating and capital budgets of the Navajo Nation. All
30 requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be

submitted to the Office of Management and Budget for budget impact analysis and other appropriate action.

4. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 501 (B)(4)(c), the Resources and Development Committee is to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council through the appropriate process supplemental appropriations to the capital improvement projects annual budget to fund necessary additional capital improvement projects.

5. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 860 (C)(2) “[t]he appropriation portion of the Capital Improvement Plan is subject to approval of the Navajo Nation Council upon recommendation of the Budget and Finance Committee. Any modification or amendment affecting the approved Capital Improvement Plan is subject to review and concurrence by the Resources and Development Committee prior to consideration by the Navajo Nation Council.”

J. Any modification or amendment affecting the approved Capital Improvement Plan is subject to review and concurrence by the Resources and Development Committee prior to consideration by the Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. § 860.

K. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest to waive 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) and 860 (C), regarding the Capital Improvement Plan, for the renovation or replacement of existing housing units in the Former Bennett Freeze Area.

L. It is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation to appropriate One Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,600,000), under 12 N.N.C. § 820(O), to the Division of Community Development, FBFA Housing Project, Business Unit New. Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) 1 AND 860 (C) REGARDING THE RENOVATION OR REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING HOMES IN THE FORMER BENNETT FREEZE AREA

1 The Navajo Nation Council hereby waives 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) and 860(C) with
2 regard to renovation or replacement of existing housing units in the Former Bennett
3 Freeze Area.

5 **SECTION 3. APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE**
6 **UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF**
7 **ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,600,000) FOR THE**
8 **RENOVATION OR REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING HOMES IN THE FORMER**
9 **BENNETT FREEZE AREA**
10

11 A. The Navajo Nation, having received certification by the Office of the Controller
12 of the availability of certain funds from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund
13 Balance (UUFb) for supplemental appropriation hereby approves the
14 supplemental appropriation of One Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars
15 (\$1,600,000) for the renovation or replacement of existing homes in the Former
16 Bennett Freeze Area, and as further described in budget documents attached as
17 Exhibit A.

18 B. This supplemental appropriation of One Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars
19 (\$1,600,000) shall be to the Division of Community Development, FBFA
20 Housing Project, Business Unit Number New, as identified in Exhibit A, and from
21 that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the UUFb.

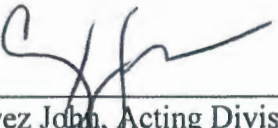

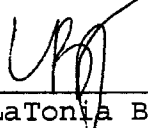

The above-mentioned document was submitted through the 164B process. Because this document was deemed time sensitive, the Department of Justice (DOJ) was not able to outline the issues in a written form. As such, the DOJ is taking the opportunity to provide its comments during the legislation 5-day comment period. In reviewing the legislation, the purpose is to request for supplemental appropriation from the Undesignated Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB) to renovate and replace existing housing units in the Former Bennett Freeze Area. Specifically, the funding is to fund the following¹: (1) Temporary salary; (2) Fringe Benefits; (3) Fleet; (4) Personnel Travel; (5) Fuel; (6) Building/Space; (7) Equipment/Supplies; (8) External Contractors; (8) Other Contractual Services; (10) Insurance Premiums; and (11) Infrastructure. The legislation also

requires the waiver of 12 N.N.C. §§ 820 and 860, which requires the development of a Capital Budget and deems the purpose of the request to be a Capital Improvement Project.

UUFB:

Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(J), the UUFB "shall not be utilized for funding recurring expenditures or operations of the Navajo Nation government." As noted above, the request is to renovate and replace existing housing units. To the DOJ's knowledge, this legislation is the first request. Specifically, the budget is to hire individuals on a temporary basis and it appears that the cost (i.e., Fringe Benefits, Fuel, etc.) associated with the hiring of the temporary individuals is also on one-time cost/request. In other words, the expenditure of this request is temporary and non-recurring. As such, this request appears to be consistent with the limitation of the UUFB. It should be noted that any future requests for this same purpose may be limited and may be deemed as a recurring cost.

Capital Projects:

All supplement requests must be made consistent with the Budget Instruction Manual (BIM) and Appropriation Act (Act), 12 N.N.C. § 800 et. seq. Section 810(F) of the Act notes the definition of "Capital Improvement" as follows:

generally not recurring on an annual basis and which fits within one or more of the following categories:

1. All projects requiring debt obligation or borrowing;
2. Any acquisition or lease of land;
3. Purchase of major equipment or vehicles, with a life expectancy of five years or more, valued in excess of an amount to be established by the Controller;
4. Major building improvements that are not routine maintenance expenses and that substantially enhance the value or extend the useful life of a structure;
5. Construction of new buildings or facilities including engineering, design, and other pre-

construction costs with an estimated cost in excess of an amount to be determined by the Controller; and/or
6. Major equipment or furnishings required to furnish new buildings or other projects, the cost of which is above a certain amount to be established by the Controller.

Section 810(N) provides the definition of "Local Government Project" as government improvement projects that include, but are not limited to, house wiring, bathroom additions and projects that address individual or community needs but which may not meet the requirements for, or definition of, capital improvement projects. Section XI(E) of the BIM also provides that all supplemental requests for capital projects are to be submitted to the Capital Improvement Office (CIO) for proper review pursuant to the established Capital Plan.

In practice, the Capital Plan has been the Transportation and Community Development (TCDC) Objective Criteria, Resolution No. TCDCJY-77-99. The TCDC Objective Criteria outlines the process to develop a Capital Plan, list the "Capital Improvement" and "Local Government" projects and the required documents that need to be submitted and the duties of various entities that assist in the development and review of the Capital Plan. The TCDC Objective Criteria includes projects such as, but not limited to powerline extensions, renovation and construction of Senior Citizen Centers/Chapter House and bathroom additions. See Section XV of the TCDC Objective Criteria.

CIO has noted that upon completion of the projects, the projects constitute as the Navajo Nation's asset and it is the responsibility of the Navajo Nation to pay the insurance premium except for the "Local Government" projects. In this case, it appears that the renovation and replacement of homes would constitute as "Local Government" projects not a "Capital Improvement" project. Therefore, it is recommended that the legislation is amended to deem that this request is a "Local Government" project.

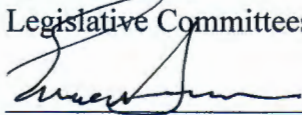

Subject: Legislation # 0014-16, Supplemental Funding Budget for DCD/FBFA Housing Project in the Amount of \$1,600,000

The Office of Management and Budget has reviewed the above subject document and its findings are as follows:

1. Renovation of housing in the former Bennett Freeze Area is a rather new Navajo Nation government activity and, therefore, this capital improvement project is probably not listed on the approved Capital Improvement List recently issued. It would, therefore, bypass other already improved Navajo Nation capital improvement priorities to fund this new activity.
2. The supplemental request should include completion of the Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary form displayed on page 78 of the 2016 Budget Instructions Manual and available on the NN-OMB website. This will enable the reviewers to have written information in summary form regarding the request. At the minimum, information such as condition of the homes to be renovated, the home owner(s), the location of the homes, the cost of renovating each home and other funding alternatives sought (possibly from the Navajo Housing Authority) would be extremely helpful.
3. Budget Form 5 with a listing of the proposed positions is not part of the budget package. This form is required by the Department of Personnel Management for their part of the processing of positions and personnel to be hired.
4. The annual supplemental proposal process, by resolution CS-39-15 (paragraph L) and the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget Instructions Manual, directs the Branch Chiefs to prioritize proposals for funding consideration. As it is, there are over 100 proposals exceeding \$100 million in regards to this Council directive. A comprehensive plan should be prepared, using funds from the Sihasin Fund, UUFB and possibly the Ramah settlement. These funds together exceed \$500 million.

The above findings by the Office of Management and Budget need to be addressed as soon as possible or before the supplemental budget is presented any oversight committee.
