PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is for the Navajo Nation to authorize reenrollment of Willard Tsingine as a member of the Navajo Nation.

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. Pursuant to the Navajo Nation law: Any enrolled member of the Navajo Nation may renounce [her] membership by written petition to the President of the Navajo Nation requesting that his name be stricken from the Navajo Nation roll. *See* 1 N.N.C. § 705 (Renunciation of membership).
- B. The Navajo Nation in addition states, “[n]o person, otherwise eligible for membership in the Navajo Nation, may enroll as a member of the Navajo Nation, who, at the same time, is on the roll of any other tribe of Indians.” *See* 1 N.N.C. § 703 (Member of another tribe).
- C. Renounced members may be reinstated by the Navajo Nation only by the vote of majority of the Navajo Nation Council. *See* 1 N.N.C. § 705 (Renunciation of membership).

1 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

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- 3 A. Willard Tsingine was previously enrolled with the Hopi Tribe on November 8,
- 4 1988. See Exhibit A, p. 1.
- 5 B. The Hopi Tribe has since confirmed that Willard Tsingine formally relinquished
- 6 his Hopi tribal membership on November 27, 2000. See Exhibit A, p. 1. The
- 7 reason given is that Willard Tsingine was going to enroll with the Navajo Nation.
- 8 See Exhibit A, p. 2.
- 9 C. Willard Tsingine is ½ Navajo blood, as confirmed by the Hopi Tribe. See Exhibit
- 10 A, p. 3. He is therefore eligible to enroll as a member of the Navajo Nation. 1
- 11 N.N.C. §701(B).
- 12 D. Willard Tsingine has sent a letter to the Navajo Nation requesting reenrollment
- 13 with the Navajo Nation. See Exhibit B.

15 **SECTION THREE. REENROLLMENT**

17 Willard Tsingine (DOB:) is and shall be reinstated, or otherwise

18 reenrolled, as a member of the Navajo Nation. By this action of the Navajo Nation

19 Council and pursuant to the laws of the Navajo Nation, he shall be entitled to all rights,

20 benefits and privileges associated with membership with the Navajo Nation.

**9/6/00: Hopi relinquishment form sent to Willard this date. He will be in the process of enrolling into the Navajo Tribe. Further action will be taken once the relinquishment is received.
**9/27/00: Hopi relinquishment rec'd this date, with the condition that it be effective 60 days from the date of receipt, which will be on, November 27, 00. No action to remove name from the Hopi Roll will be done, until after 11/27/00.
**No withdrawal of Hopi relinquishment occurred, therefore, as of 11/27/00, Willard's relinquishment is effective as of this date. Also his E# is considered null and void, and will be used for reference purpose only. File placed with Enrolled with Other section.

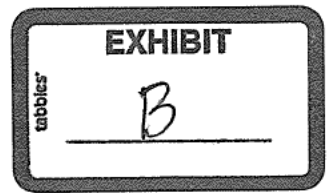

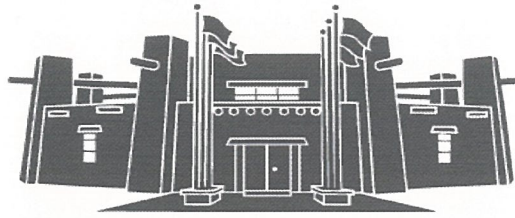
To Whom It May Concern:
