# RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

# 23rd NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL -- Fourth Year, 2018

## AN ACTION

RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE, BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE, AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION, TWENTY ONE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY ONE DOLLARS (\$1,021,431) TO THE NAVAJO DIVISION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, BUSINESS UNITS 108014-108123, WAIVING 12 N.N.C. § 820(F)

## BE IT ENACTED:

# Section One. Authority

- A. The Resources and Development Committee has oversight of the Division of Community Development. 2 N.N.C. § 500(C)(1).
- B. The Budget and Finance Committee is empowered to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation, investment and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. § 301 (B)(2).
- C. A proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9).
- D. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 102(A).
- E. The Title 12 Appropriations Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:
  - 1. When the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
  - 2. Supplemental appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall only be made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at § 820(F). This provision may be amended or

- waived only by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the full Council.
- 3. The Controller of the Navajo Nation shall be responsible for designating recurring and non-recurring revenues. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
- 4. All requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget for budget impact analysis and other appropriate actions. 12 N.N.C. § 820 (M).

# Section Two. Findings

- A. This is a funding request for a supplemental appropriation to the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development for Chapter Official stipends from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB). See Exhibit A.
- B. The need and justification for the request of funds from the UUFB is the decrease in the Chapter budget for FY 2018. The impact of the decrease is a need created for Chapter Officials stipends of \$987,771 with worker's compensation need of \$33,660, a total of \$1,021,431.
- C. The Office of the Controller provided a memorandum dated, November 30, 2017, which indicated the request is a recurring cost. This memorandum is included in **Exhibit B**. The Office of the Controller also provided a document that the updated balance in the UUFB as of May 16, 2018 is \$3,378,986, which is included as **Exhibit C**.
- D. The Office of Management and Budget is aware of the supplemental request and should provide a budget impact analysis as required by 12 N.N.C. § 820(M).

Section Three. Approving the Supplemental Appropriation from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance in the Amount of \$1,021,431 to the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development to Business Units 108014-108123

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the supplemental appropriation from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance to the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development to Business Unit Numbers 108014-108123 in accordance with **Exhibit A**.
- B. This supplemental appropriation of \$1,021,431 shall be from that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance

of the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance as determined by the Office of the Controller.

C. In the event a Chapter has previously used an account, that was legally allowable to pay for Chapter stipends, or at a lessor amount, they may be reimbursed, to pay for Chapter Officials' stipends in compliance with Navajo Nation laws and policies, the Chapter may reimburse such account with the amount appropriated from this legislation. Before the reimbursement to such account, the Division of Community Development shall verify whether the use of such account was allowed to be used previously.

# Section Four. Waiving 12 N.N.C. § 820 (F)

With the Controller's designation of this appropriation as a recurring cost, the Navajo Nation waives 12 N.N.C. § 820 (F) regarding the restriction on non-recurring costs. This provision may be waived by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the full Council.

## Section Five. Effective Date

The provisions of this Act shall become effective in accordance with 2 N.N.C. \$ 221(B).

I am pleased to present to you the following information related to General Fund financial data up to April 30, 2018

# The General Fund Financial data is as follows:

The gross General Fund Revenues (see Exhibit "A") as of April 30, 2018 is \$156,811,921 and the total set asides total \$43,426,146. The Net Revenue for the General Fund is \$113,385,775, which is 76.19% of the projection.

The total expenditures by branch are shown on Exhibit "B".

- The Legislative Branch has expenditures of \$8,444,720, encumbrances of \$552,041 with a remaining budget of \$9,831,455.
- The Executive Branch expenditures are \$104,593,344 encumbrances are \$11,530,480 with a remaining budget of \$91,000,419.
- The Judicial Branch expenditures are \$7,073,183 encumbrances are \$5,903 with a remaining budget of \$6,768,836.
- Total General Fund expenditures are \$120,111,247; total encumbrances are \$12,088,424 with an overall remaining budget of \$107,600,710.

The updated UUFB as of May 9, 2018 is \$3,378,986 (see Exhibit "C"). There have been twenty one supplemental appropriations during Fiscal Year 2018 in the total amount of \$27,446,724.
