PURPOSE: The purpose of this legislation is to approve funding from the Síhasin Fund for the construction of phase 2 of the Dilkon Justice Center.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate review the proposed resolution in detail.

19	A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C.	
20	§ 102 (A).	
21	B. The Naabik'iyati' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review	
22	all proposed legislation which requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council. 2	
23	N.N.C. §164(A)(9).	
24	C. The Law and Order Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to serve	
25	as the oversight authority for the Division of Public Safety and the Judicial Branch	
26	Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §§ 600 (C)(6).	
27	D. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to	
28	review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation,	
29	investment, and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. § 301 (B) (2).

1	E. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee established the Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund
2	Subcommittee to recommend to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee and Navajo Nation
3	Council financial support and/or financing plan(s) for the purposes designated in the
4	Síhasin Fund. NABIAP-20-15. However, approval by the Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin
5	Fund Subcommittee is not a requirement for legislation.
6	F. The Navajo Nation Code provides the purpose of the Navajo Nation Síhasin Fund
7	("Síhasin Fund") is as follows:
8	§ 2502 Purpose
9	A. The purposes of this Fund are to provide financial support and/or
10	financing for:
11	1. The planning and development of economic development
12	and regional infrastructure supporting economic development
13	and community development, including such infrastructure
14	as, but not limited to, housing, commercial and government
15	buildings, waterline, solid waste management development,
16	powerline projects, and transportation and communication
17	systems, within the Navajo Nation; and
18	2. Education opportunities for members of the Navajo

20	B. For the Purpose in § 2502(A)(1), Fund expenditures for
21	infrastructure shall not be limited by 12 NNC § 1310(F) or

23	C. Leveraging the Fund by way of guaranteeing loans, match
24	funding, direct funding in part, and other weighted uses of the
25	Fund, including loan financing from the Fund, for the purposes
26	in § 2502(A)(1), shall be favored over direct funding in whole.

28	G. The Síhasin Fund provides that "Fund Principal" shall consist of all deposits made
29	to the Síhasin Fund and that "Fund Income" shall consist of all earnings (interest,
30	dividends, etc.) generated and realized by the Fund Principal, and that Fund

1	Income shall be deposited in and added to Fund Principal until such time as a
2	Fund Expenditure Plan is duly adopted. 12 N.N.C. §§ 2504 and 2505 (C).

4	Section Two. Findings
5	A. The Dilkon Justice Center Plan is detailed in Exhibits A and B.
6	B. As set forth in Exhibit A, 10 acres of land was set aside for a medium district
7	public safety center. Phase one of the Dilkon Justice Center was completed in
8	2009. Phase 2 of the Dilkon Justice Center will include a police station and
9	corrections facility.
10	C. A budget summary and detailed budget and justification are provided in Exhibit
11	В.
12	
13	Section Three. Approval and Adoption of Expenditure Plan
14	A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves and adopts the Dilkon Justice Center
15	Expenditure Plan, attached and incorporated herein as Exhibits A and B.
16	B. The Navajo Nation hereby approves and adopts funding to Dilkon Chapter for
17	thirty-two million, nine hundred eighty-two thousand, thirty dollars
1 8	(\$32,982,030.00).
1 9	C. The Síhasin Funds allocated for the Dilkon Justice Center Expenditure Plan may be
20	further leveraged by bond or loan financing pursuant to the Navajo Nation Bond
21	Financing Act, 12 N.N.C. § 1300 et seq., as amended, using Síhasin Fund earnings
22	for repayment and financing costs upon the recommendation of the Budget and
23	Finance Committee and approval by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members of the
24	Navajo Nation Council.

26	Section Four. Approval and Adoption of Expenditure Plan Administration
27	The Navajo Nation hereby approves administration of the Dilkon Justice Center
28	Expenditure Plan as follows:

1	1. The Navajo Nation Controller shall determine whether the source of the annual
2	allocations from the total allocation of \$32,982,030.00 will be Síhasin Fund
3	Principal or Income or a combination of both;
4	2. The funding for the Dilkon Justice Center shall be distributed by the end of the
5	first quarter of the Navajo Nation Fiscal Year;
6	3. The funds allocated for the Dilkon Justice Center Expenditure Plan shall be
7	used solely to design, plan, and construct the Dilkon Justice Center described in
8	Exhibits A and B. Any and all cost-savings shall be returned to the to the
9	Síhasin Fund once the Dilkon Justice Center is completed; and
10	4. The funds allocated for the Dilkon Justice Center Expenditure Plan shall not
11	lapse on an annual basis pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820 (N), however, any funds
12	not spent or encumbered within twenty-four (24) months of the date funds are
13	made available to Dilkon Chapter shall revert to the Síhasin Fund principal,
14	unless recommended otherwise by the Resources and Development Committee
15	and approved by the Naabik'íyáti' Committee.

17	Section Five. Effective Date
18	The Dilkon Justice Center Expenditure Plan, as set forth above, shall become effective
19	pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 2505.

21	Section Six. Directives
22	Dilkon Chapter and Department of Public Safety shall report the status of the Dilkon
23	Justice Center to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee on a quarterly basis.




The Navajo Nation is in the process of expanding Public Safety Facilities throughout the Nation. In about 2008, the Nation commissioned a District Judicial / Public Safety Facilities Master Plan that identified the need for Police Stations, Courts, Peacemaking, Detention and Corrections Facilities. That Master Plan identified a need for Large, Medium and Small District Judicial / Public Safety Centers throughout the Nation. A new Master Plan is currently underway.

Histery

- The Dilkon District is identified as a Medium District Judicial / Public Safety Center according to the Master Plan.
- In 2008, the Judicial Branch was able to secure funding for the Phase 1-Dilkon District Court Facility, which was designed, constructed and began operations in 2009. The 10-acre site dedicated for the Dilkon Judicial / Public Safety Center is the site of the District Court and was planned so that the Police Station and Corrections Facilities can become the envisioned Medium District Judicial / Public Safety Center.






New Dilkom Justice Center, Phase 2. Existing Dilk Court Buil Phase 1
