SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 102(A).
- B. A proposed resolution requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyátí Committee. 2 N.N.C. \$501(C)(1).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The Navajo Nation President recommends Garret Silversmith as the Division Director of the Navajo Division of Transportation. The appointed Division Director is confirmed by the Navajo Nation Council. See CAP-13-13 (2013).
- B. The appointed Navajo Division of Transportation Division Director serves at the pleasure of the Navajo Nation President. CAP-13-13 (2013).
- C. The Navajo Nation President appoints Garret Silversmith as the Division Director for the Navajo Division of Transportation. Mr. Silversmith's appointment letter and résumé are attached as Exhibit A.
