SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. On April 17, 2018, the Navajo Nation Council adopted Council Resolution No. CAP-35-18, "Adopting the Sihasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan Pursuant to CD-68-14, as Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, as Amended; Waiving 12 N.N.C. §§ 810 (F), 820 (I) and (M) and 860 (C) Relating to the Capital Budget and Capital Improvement Process." Resolution No. CAP-35-18 is incorporated herein by reference.
- B. A "Cemetery Pre-Design" Project is listed in Resolution No. CAP-35-18 at Exhibit
 D, Project No. 143. The relevant page of Exhibit D of CAP-35-18 is attached as Exhibit 1.
- C. The Lupton Chapter has submitted a "Síhasin Project Amendment Certification" form attached as Exhibit 2, requesting a change to the description for Project No. 143 from "Cemetery Pre-Design" to "Plan, Design, Construct and Equipment" for the Cemetery Project. No change in Síhasin funding for the Project is requested, and the amount of allocated funding will remain at \$100,000.
- D. The Sihasin Project Amendment Certification form has been signed by the Navajo Nation Council Delegate representing the Lupton Chapter's council district, as required by CAP-35-18, Section 4, Paragraph C.
- E. The Capital Projects Management Department, through its signature in Section IV of Exhibit 2, has indicated the Project is construction ready, and the total Sihasín Funding for the Lupton Council District will not exceed \$4,166,666.67.
- F. The Lupton Chapter has passed Resolution No. TSA-2019-04-020, dated April 16, 2019, explaining the need for the change in language in Exhibit D to CAP-35-18, to include construction and land planning/pre-design work for the Cemetery Project. Resolution No. TSA-2019-04-020 is attached as Exhibit 3.

SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

The Navajo Nation hereby approves the change in Project description, as requested by the Lupton Chapter in accordance with the attached **Exhibit 2**.


