OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

24TH NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - Fourth Year, 2022

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT, AND BUDGET AND
FINANCE COMMITTEES; APPROVING A CHANGE TO CAP-35-18, EXHIBIT D,
FOR THE CAMERON CHAPTER BY REALLOCATING \$733,334.66 IN SÍHASIN
FUNDS TO THE NEW CHAPTER BUILDING PROJECT AND CHANGING THE
FUNDING YEAR FOR THE CHAPTER'S DEMONSTRATION FARM PROJECT

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation is empowered to exercise oversight authority over chapter activities. 2 N.N.C. § 500(C).
- B. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation, investment and management of all funds and to coordinate and review all fiscal, financial and investment activities of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 301(B)(2) and § 301(B)(5).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The Navajo Nation Council approved Resolution No. CAP-35-18, entitled, "Adopting the Síhasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan Pursuant to CD-68-14, as Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, as Amended; Waiving 12 N.N.C. §§ 810(F), 820(I), and (M) And 860(C) Relating to the Capital Improvement Budget and the Capital Improvement Process." CAP-35-18 is incorporated herein by this reference.
- B. Section 4(C) of CAP-35-18 allows an approved Chapter project to be changed, by changing the year funded, by adding to the project, or by changing the project entirely, with the concurrence of the Council Delegate representing the Council

District and the approvals of the Resources and Development Committee and Budget and Finance Committee, as long as such project has been certified as construction-ready and the total Síhasin Funding for the District does not exceed \$4,166,666.67.

- C. The amount of \$633,333 for the Cameron Chapter's Cultural Center project was approved in Exhibit D of CAP-35-18. The CAP-35-18 Exhibit D showing the Cameron Project No. D-117 is attached hereto as **EXHIBIT 1**.
- D. The Cameron Chapter desires to delete the Cultural Center Project No. D-117 and reallocate the approved funds to the Chapter's newly planned project, titled: "Plan, Design, Demolition, & Construct New Chapter Building." The Division of Community Development - Capital Projects Management Department ("CPMD") has submitted, on behalf of the Crystal Chapter, a Síhasin Project Amendment Certification Form for the Chapter Building Project, **EXHIBIT 2**. The CPMD Amendment Certification Form shows the signature of the Navajo Nation Council Delegate for the Cameron Chapter, as required by CAP-35-18 Section 4(C).
- E. The Cameron Chapter has passed Resolution No. CA-OB-143-222#4 and Resolution No. CA-OB-143-222#3, wherein the Chapter supports the reallocation of the \$633,333 in approved Síhasin funds to the Cameron Chapter Building Project. **EXHIBIT 3**.
- F. As required by CAP-35-18 Section 4(C), the proposed new Project has been certified by CPMD as construction-ready and the total Síhasin funding for the Council District will not exceed \$4,166,666.67. In fact, the original Síhasin funding amount of \$633,333 for the Cameron Chapter, as approved in CAP-35-18, will remain unchanged.
- G. The Cameron Chapter also requests to move the approved \$100,001.66 in Síhasin funding for its Demonstration Farm Project from Funding Year 1 to Funding Year 3. This Project was approved in CAP-35-18. **EXHIBIT 4**.
- H. CPMD has submitted, on behalf of the Cameron Chapter, a Síhasin Project Amendment Certification Form for its requested change in Funding Years. **EXHIBIT 5**. This Form shows the signature of the Navajo Nation Council Delegate for the Cameron Chapter, as required by CAP-35-18 Section 4(C). There is no change in the approved Project and the original Síhasin funding amount for the Project is unchanged.

- I. The Síhasin Fund shall be reimbursed the \$733,334.66 reallocated herein, from funds available to the Navajo Nation from any and all state and federal sources, including Congressional appropriations under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 or other COVID-19 related relief, so long as the expenditures described herein are deemed eligible under such COVID-19 related or other funding sources.

SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

The Navajo Nation Council hereby approves a change to Resolution No. CAP-35-18, Exhibit D, Project No. D-117, for the Cameron Chapter by deleting the Cultural Center Project and adding the Chapter Building Project, as shown in the attached **EXHIBIT 2**. Further, the Navajo Nation Council hereby approves a change to Resolution No. CAP-35-18, Exhibit D, Project No. D-118, for the Cameron Chapter by deleting the Demonstration Farm Project in Funding Year 1 and adding this Project to Fund Year 3.

SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Legislation shall become effective pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 2505.

SECTION FIVE. SAVINGS CLAUSE

If any provision of this Legislation is determined invalid by the Supreme Court of the Navajo Nation, or by a Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the provision(s) not determined invalid shall remain as Navajo Nation law.

CERTIFICATION

I, hereby, certify that the foregoing resolution was duly considered by the Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council at a duly called meeting held by teleconference at which a quorum was present and that the same was passed by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 opposed, this 26th day of April 2022.




