LINE PROJECT WITHIN DENNEHOTSO CHAPTER; WAIVING 12 N.N.C. § 820(I)  
AND 860(C) RELATING TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS

BE IT ENACTED:

**Section One. Authority**

- A. The Navajo Nation established the Resources and Development Committee as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such gave the Committee oversight over Navajo Nation Chapters. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 500 (A), 501 (C)(1).
- B. The Navajo Nation established the Budget and Finance Committee (BFC) as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such empowered BFC to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 300 (A), 301 (B)(2).

1 C. The Navajo Nation Council established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a  
2 Navajo Nation standing committee and as such proposed legislation that  
3 requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the  
4 Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 700 (A).

5 D. The Title 12 Appropriations Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements  
6 include:

- 7 1. When the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above  
8 and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental  
9 appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council. 12  
10 N.N.C. § 820(L).
- 11 2. Supplemental appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall  
12 only be made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at  
13 § 820(F). The Controller of the Navajo Nation shall be responsible for  
14 designating recurring and non-recurring revenues. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
- 15 3. All requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be  
16 submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for budget  
17 impact analysis. 12 N.N.C. § 820(M).

18 E. The Title 12 Capital Improvement Process includes:

- 19 1. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 810(F), "Capital Improvement" means a major  
20 project undertaken by the Navajo Nation that is generally not recurring on  
21 an annual basis and which fits within one or more of the following  
22 categories:
  - 23 i. All projects requiring debt obligation or borrowing;
  - 24 ii. Any acquisition or lease of land;
  - 25 iii. Purchase of major equipment or vehicles, with a life expectancy of  
26 five years or more, valued in excess of an amount to be established  
27 by the Controller;
  - 28 iv. Major building improvements that are not routine maintenance  
29 expenses and that substantially enhance the value or extend the  
30 useful life of a structure;

- 1 v. Construction of new buildings or facilities including engineering,  
2 design, and other pre-construction costs with an estimated cost in  
3 excess of an amount to be determined by the Controller; and/or  
4 vi. Major equipment or furnishing required to furnish new buildings  
5 or other projects, the cost of which is above a certain amount to be  
6 established by the Controller.

7 2. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (I), the “[d]evelopment of the Capital Budget  
8 shall be coordinated with development of the Operating Budget. All  
9 budget requests for capital improvements shall be in compliance with an  
10 adopted Capital Improvement Plan and shall not be approved unless in  
11 compliance with the Plan.”

12 3. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 860 (C)(2) “[t]he appropriation portion of the  
13 Capital Improvement Plan is subject to approval of the Navajo Nation  
14 Council upon recommendation of the Budget and Finance Committee.  
15 Any modification or amendment affecting the approved Capital  
16 Improvement Plan is subject to review and concurrence by the Resources  
17 and Development Committee prior to consideration by the Navajo Nation  
18 Council.”

19  
20 **Section Two. Findings**

- 21 A. This is a funding request for the construction of the Dennehotso Scattered  
22 Power Line Project within the Dennehotso Chapter. The supplemental  
23 funding request forms are attached as Exhibit A.
- 24 B. The Office of Management and Budget has provided a memorandum satisfying  
25 the requirements of 12 N.N.C. § 820(M) and is attached as Exhibit B.
- 26 C. The Office of the Controller has provided a memorandum dated September 8,  
27 2017 indicating the balance in the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance as  
28 of September 8, 2017 is \$31,258,307. This memorandum is provided to meet  
29 the requirements of 12 N.N.C. 820 (L), however the Controller of the Navajo  
30

1 Nation has not designated the funds at recurring or non-recurring. This  
2 memorandum is attached as Exhibit C.

3 D. The request for funds for construction of the Dennehotso Scattered Power  
4 Line Project within Dennehotso Chapter is not included in the Title 12 Capital  
5 Improvement Plan because the Plan was rescinded by Navajo Nation Council.  
6 CAP-23-17

7 E. Any modification or amendment affecting the approved Capital Improvement  
8 Plan is subject to review and concurrence by the Resources and Development  
9 Committee prior to consideration by the Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C.  
10 § 860.

11 F. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest to waive 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I)  
12 and 860 (C) regarding the Capital Improvement for the Dennehotso Scattered  
13 Power Line Project.

14 G. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest of the Navajo people to approve  
15 this supplemental appropriation request.  
16

17 **Section Three. Waiving 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) 1 And 860 (C) Regarding Funding for**  
18 **the Dennehotso Scattered Power Line Project.**

19 The Navajo Nation Council hereby waives 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) and 860(C) with regard  
20 to the Dennehotso Scattered Power Line Project.  
21

22 **Section Four. Approving the Supplemental Appropriation from the Unreserved,**  
23 **Undesignated Fund Balance in the Amount of \$410,250.00 for the construction of**  
24 **the Dennehotso Scattered Power Line Project within the Dennehotso Chapter.**

25 A. This supplemental appropriation of \$410,250.00 shall be from that amount  
26 of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the Unreserved,  
27 Undesignated Fund Balance as determined by the Office of the Controller  
28 and to *New Number*.

29 B. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the supplemental appropriation from  
30 the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance to the Dennehotso Chapter for

1 the Dennehotso Scattered Power Line Project, Business Unit Number, *New*  
2 *Number* for \$410,250.00.

3 **Section Five. Effective Date**

4 The provisions of this Act shall become effective in accord with 2 N.N.C. § 221(B).

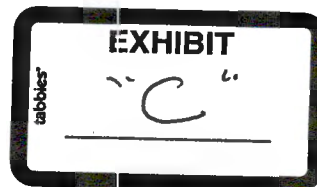



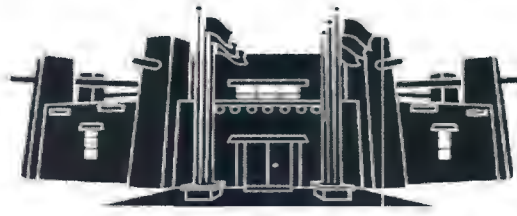
Subject: Financial Update-(General Fund Revenue, Expenditures, UUFB)

The gross General Fund Revenues, (see Exhibit "A"), as of August 31, 2017 is \$203,053,235, (see Footnote 1). The total General Fund set asides is \$ \$51,749,599 (Footnote 2). The Net Revenue for the General Fund is \$151,303,727 (see Footnote 3). The permanent fund income transfer is \$24,411,000 (Footnote 4). The reserve taken for the permanent fund income transfer is \$2,885,000 (Footnote 5). The grand total revenue for the General Fund is \$172,829,727 (see Footnote 6) which is 98.78% of the projection.

Next, are the total expenditures by Branch, (see Exhibit "B"), as of August 31, 2017, the Legislative Branch has expenditures of \$14,836,331 (see Footnote 1a); encumbrances of \$822,493 (see Footnote 1b) with a remaining budget of \$3,307,669 (see Footnote 1c). The Executive Branch expenditures are \$162,500,722 (see Footnote 2a); encumbrances are \$7,206,122 (see Footnote 2b) with a remaining budget of \$37,797,219 (see Footnote 2c). The Judicial Branch expenditures are \$11,718,156 (see Footnote 3a); with encumbrances of \$73,692 (see Footnote 3b) and remaining budget of \$2,356,349 (see Footnote 3c). Total General Fund expenditures are \$189,055,209 (see Footnote 4a); total encumbrances are \$8,102,307 (see Footnote 4b) with an overall remaining budget of \$43,461,236 (see Footnote 4c).


The updated Undesignated Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB). (see Exhibit "C") as of September 8, 2017 is \$31,258,217. The Fiscal Year 2016 audited numbers were approved via CJY-51-17 and an amount of \$11, 728,198 that was previously reserved for debt service for capital projects was returned back to the UUFB with the approval of CJY-50-17. These two amounts have been incorporated into this new schedule.





**Section One. Authority**

A. The Navajo Nation established the Resources and Development Committee as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such gave the Committee oversight over Navajo Nation Chapters. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 500 (A), 501 (C)(1).

B. The Navajo Nation established the Budget and Finance Committee (BFC) as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such empowered BFC to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 300 (A), 301 (B)(2).

- 1 C. The Navajo Nation Council established the Naabik'iyáti' Committee as a  
2 Navajo Nation standing committee and as such proposed legislation that  
3 requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the  
4 Naabik'iyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 700 (A).
- 5 D. The Title 12 Appropriations Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements  
6 include:
- 7 1. When the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above  
8 and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental  
9 appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council. 12  
10 N.N.C. § 820(L).
  - 11 2. Supplemental appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall  
12 only be made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at

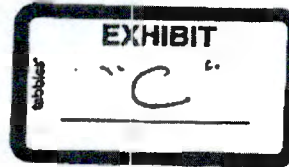

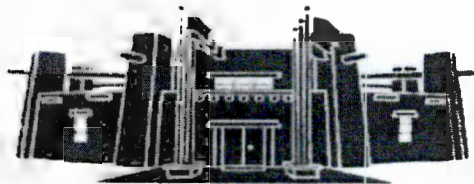
Subject: Financial Update-(General Fund Revenue Expenditures, UUFB)

The gross General Fund Revenues, (see Exhibit "A"), as of August 31, 2017 is \$203,053,235. (see Footnote 1). The total General Fund set asides is \$ \$51,749,599 (Footnote 2). The Net Revenue for the General Fund is \$151,303,727 (see Footnote 3). The permanent fund income transfer is \$24,411,000 (Footnote 4). The reserve taken for the permanent fund income transfer is \$2,885,000 (Footnote 5). The grand total revenue for the General Fund is \$172,829,727 (see Footnote 6) which is 98.78% of the projection.

Next, are the total expenditures by Branch, (see Exhibit "B"), as of August 31, 2017, the Legislative Branch has expenditures of \$14,836,331 (see Footnote 1a), encumbrances of \$822,493 (see Footnote 1b) with a remaining budget of \$3,307,669 (see Footnote 1c). The Executive Branch expenditures are \$162,500,722 (see Footnote 2a); encumbrances are \$7,206,122 (see Footnote 2b) with a remaining budget of \$37,797,219 (see Footnote 2c). The Judicial Branch expenditures are \$11,716,156 (see Footnote 3a); with encumbrances of \$73,692 (see Footnote 3b) and remaining budget of \$2,356,349 (see Footnote 3c). Total General Fund expenditures are \$189,055,209 (see Footnote 4a); total encumbrances are \$8,102,307 (see Footnote 4b) with an overall remaining budget of \$43,461,236 (see Footnote 4c).


The updated Undesignated Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB), (see Exhibit "C") as of September 8, 2017 is \$31,258,217. The Fiscal Year 2016 audited numbers were approved via CJY-51-17 and an amount of \$11,728,198 that was previously reserved for debt service for capital projects was returned back to the UUFB with the approval of CJY-50-17. These two amounts have been incorporated into this new schedule.

3. Notice of funding for right-of-way acquisition must be received before NTUA can commence with the archaeological clearance, environmental assessment, and legal surveys; and final engineering and design. This amount is shown on the attached estimate and contributes to the total project cost.
4. The Navajo Tribal Utility Authority will budget \$1,500.00 per customer provided their house is wired and ready for hook up prior to construction.

**NOTE:** If all homes are not wired, the NTUA Contribution will be adjusted downward to reflect the actual number of homes wired at the time of construction. This will result in an increase in contribution required by the Dennehotso Chapter.

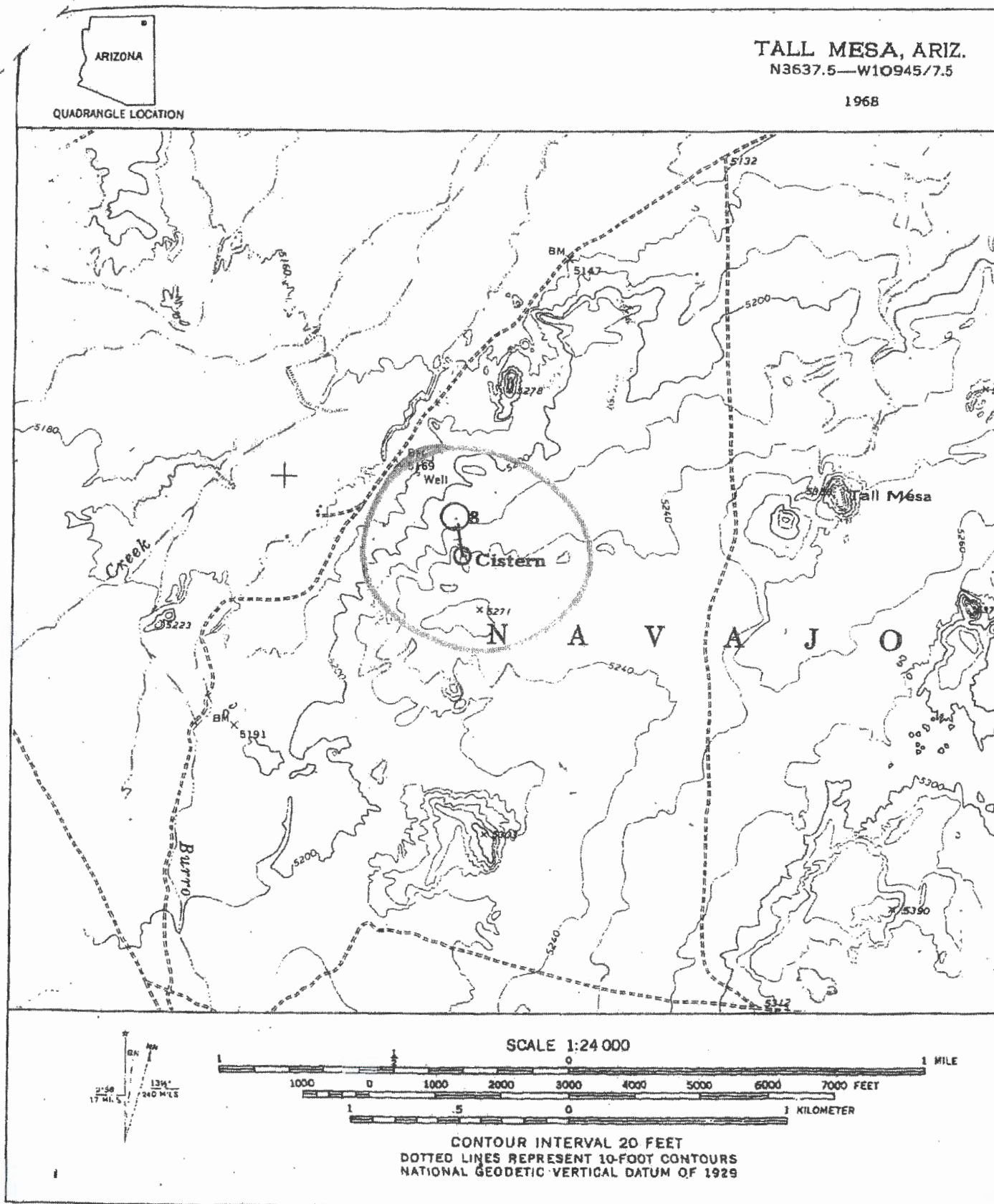


Figure 9. Location map, Homesite No. 8, gravity cistern, and cistern waterline.

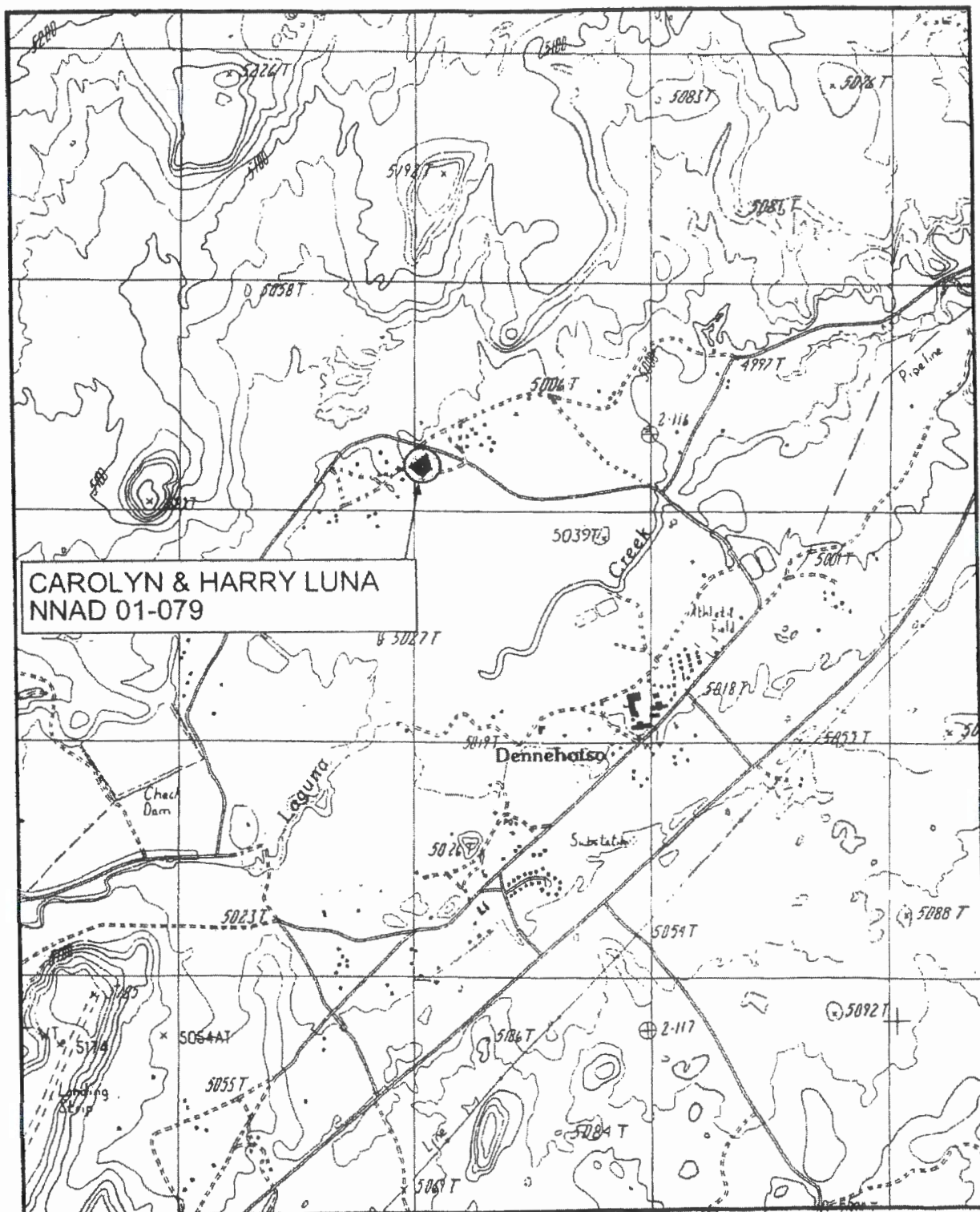


Figure 2. Specific Location of NNAD-01-079: A Cultural Resources Inventory of a Homesite for Carolyn and Harry Luna in Dennehotso, Apache County, Arizona. USGS 7.5' map is Dennehotso, Arizona Quad 1988.

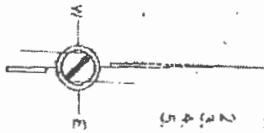

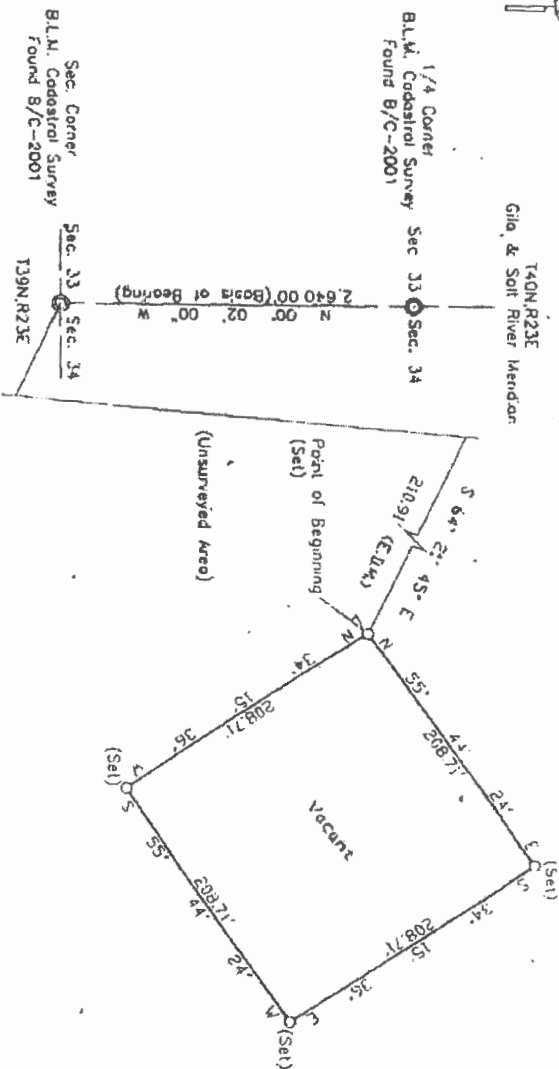

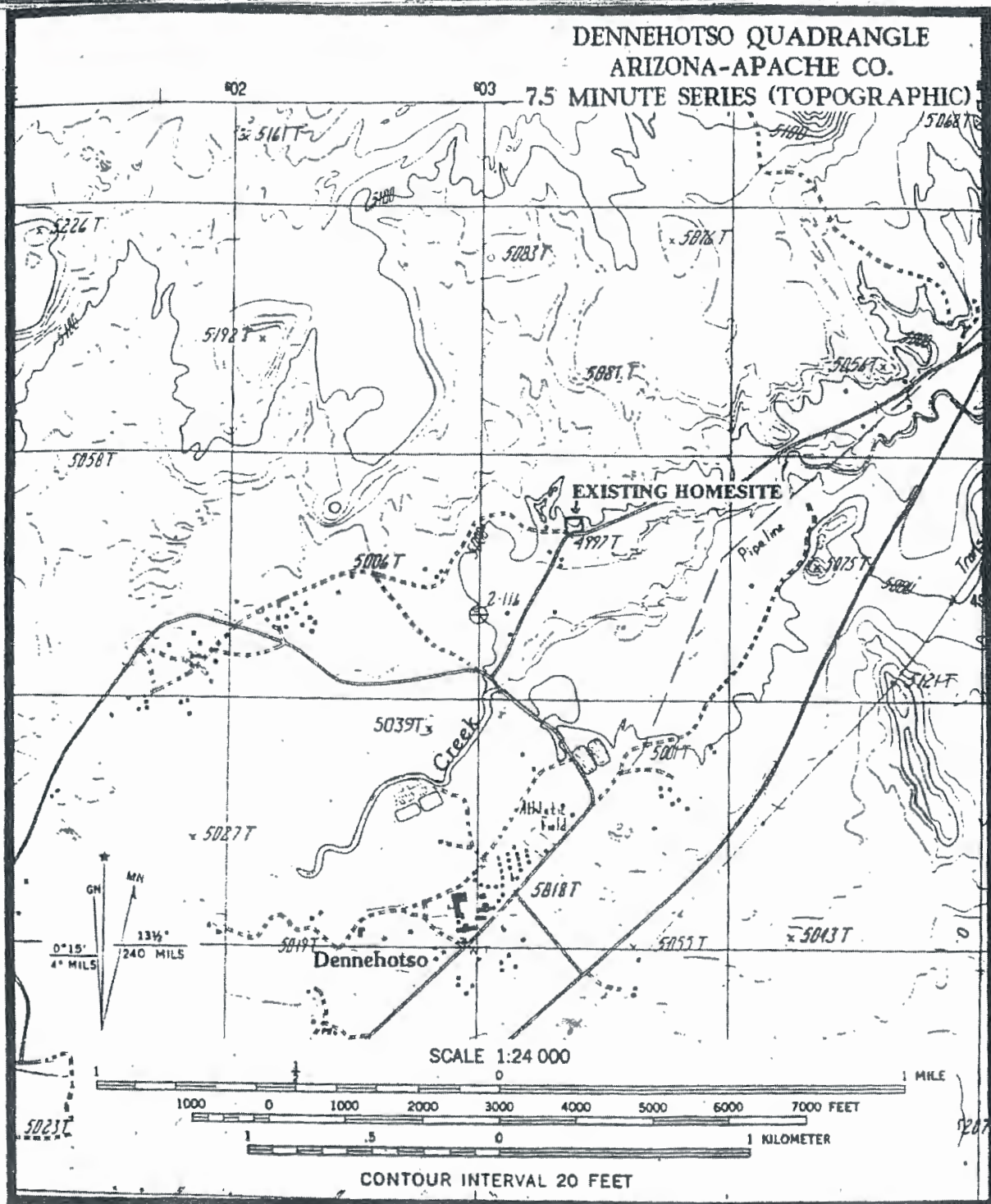


Figure 2. Project area plotted on USGS Dennehotso Quadrangle, 7.5 minute series, Navajo County, Arizona.





Subject: Proposed Legislation 0374-17 for UUFB Funding in the Amount of \$410,250 for the Dennehotso Chapter Scattered Powerline Project

The Office of Management and Budget reviewed again the above subject document and finds the following:

1. This review finds the attached project budget forms with a funding request amount of \$419,250 which is different from the amount shown on the proposed legislation of \$410,250. OMB understands the Budget and Finance Committee made an amendment to correct this on 10/12/17. The revised project budget forms are still incomplete as follows:
  - a. Project Form 1: Project Manager needs to be identified in Part IV of the form.
  - b. Project Form 2: The timeline for the project in Part II needs to be revised to agree with the Project End Date on Project Form 1, Part IV.
  - c. A completed Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary form, shown in Appendix K, of the FY 2018 Budget Instructions Manual, is not included. This form needs to be completed and included with the project budget package.
2. The Appropriations Act, at 12 NNC Section 820 (I), requires that capital budgets comply with an adopted Capital Plan. Currently, there is no approved plan.
3. The Navajo Nation Council in the approved Fiscal Year 2018 budget legislation, CS-53-17, directed the Branch Chiefs of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches to prioritize the unmet needs of their respective branches and to prepare appropriate budgets for such prioritized needs for potential consideration of supplemental appropriations in Fiscal Year 2018 in accordance with 12 NNC Section 820 (L). Only the Judicial Branch has done so with the prioritized list attached as Exhibit L to the budget legislation.
4. The exhibits are not organized in accordance with the exhibit sequence mentioned in the proposed legislation. These exhibits should be organized as stated in the proposed legislation.
5. Without any written documentation by the Division of Community Development-Capital Projects Management Department, the proposal appears to not have been reviewed as

required by NNC 12, Section 860 (A) 2. Certain criteria regarding the project proposal are to be met as approved by the Division of Community Development's oversight committee.
