## RESOLUTION OF THE BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

24<sup>TH</sup> NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - Fourth Year, 2022

## AN ACT

RELATING TO THE RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT, AND BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEES; APPROVING A CHANGE IN EXHIBIT E TO CAP-35-18 FOR THE CHINLE CHAPTER BY DELETING THE "WATERLINE - SPIDERROCK PHASE 2.5" PROJECT AND ADDING THE "WATERLINE AND SEWER - SPIDERROCK PHASE 2.5" PROJECT, BY CHANGING THE FUNDING YEAR PERIODS, AND BY DESIGNATING THE WATER MANAGEMENT BRANCH AS THE AGENCY THAT WILL ADMINISTER THE ADDED PROJECT

## BE IT ENACTED:

## SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to exercise oversight authority over Chapter activities. 2 N.N.C. § 500(C).
- B. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation, investment and management of all funds, and to coordinate and review all fiscal, financial and investment activities of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 301(B)(2) and § 301(B)(5).

### SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The Navajo Nation Council approved Resolution No. CAP-35-18, entitled, "Adopting the Sihasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan Pursuant to CD-68-14, as Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, as Amended; Waiving 12 N.N.C. §§ 810(F), 820(I) and (M) And 860(C) Relating to the Capital Improvement Budget and the Capital Improvement Process." CAP-35-18 is incorporated herein by reference.
- B. Section 4(C) of CAP-35-18 provides: "A chapter project, powerline, or waterline project may be changed, including the

year funded, or added to Exhibits A through E with the concurrence of the Delegate representing the chapter's Council District and the approvals of the Resources and Development Committee and Budget and Finance Committee, as long as such project has been certified as construction-ready by CPMD or NTUA and the total Síhasin Funding for the District does not exceed \$4,166,666.67.

- C. The amount of \$1,429,636 for the Chinle Chapter "Waterline-SpiderRock Phase 2.5" project was approved in Exhibit E to CAP-35-18. The CAP-35-18 Exhibit E showing the Chinle Chapter Project No. E-7 is attached here to as **EXHIBIT 1**.
- D. The Chinle Chapter desires to delete Project No. E-7 in the Year 1 and Year 3 funding periods and to add the "Waterline and Sewer SpiderRock Phase 2.5" project in the Year 2 and Year 3 funding periods. The Chapter also desires to have the Navajo Nation Water Management Branch administer the project and the \$1,429,636 in approved Sihasin funds.
- E. The Division of Community Development Capital Projects Management Department ("CPMD") has submitted, on behalf of the Chinle Chapter, a Síhasin Project Amendment Certification Form, attached as EXHIBIT 2, explaining that the original project parameters did not include a sewer line and did not provide for the administration of the project by the Water Management Branch. The Síhasin Project Amendment Certification Form shows the signature of the Navajo Nation Council Delegate for the Chinle Chapter, in accordance with CAPO35-18 Section 4(C).
- F. As required by CA-35-18 Section 4(C), the new project activities (sewer line project) to be added have been certified by CPMD as construction-ready and the total Síhasin Funding for the Council District will not exceed \$4,166,666.67. In fact, the original Síhasin funding amount of \$1,429,636 for the Chinle Chapter, as approved in CAP-35-18, will remain unchanged.

## SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

A. The Navajo Nation Council hereby approves a change to Resolution No. CAP-35-18, Exhibit E, Project No. E-7, by deleting the "Waterline - SpiderRock Phase 2.5" project in the Year 1 and Year 3 funding periods and adding the

"Waterline and Sewer - SpiderRock Phase 2.5" project in the Year 2 and Year 3 funding periods, as showing EXHIBIT 2.

- B. The Navajo Nation hereby designates the Navajo Nation Water Management Branch as the agency that will implement and manage the "Waterline and Sewer SpiderRock Phase 2.5" project and administer the allocated Sihasin funds.
- C. Pursuant to Section Four (B) of CAP-35-18, CPMD shall enter into a partnership agreement with the Water Management Branch providing for the Water Management Branch to implement and manage the added project and administer the \$1,429,636 in Sihasin funds.
- D. The Sihasin Fund shall be reimbursed the \$1,429,636 reallocated herein, from funds available to the Navajo Nation from any and all state and federal sources, including Congressional appropriations under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 or other COVID-19-related relief, so long as the expenditures for the Chinle Chapter's project are deemed eligible under such COVID-19-related or other funding sources.

## SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Legislation shall become effective pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 2505.

## SECTION FIVE. SAVINGS CLAUSE

If any provision of this Legislation is determined invalid by the Supreme Court of the Navajo Nation, or by a Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the provision(s) not determined invalid shall remain as Navajo Nation law.

## CERTIFICATION
