RESOLUTION OF THE LAW AND ORDER COMMITTEE 23RD NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - Third Year, 2017

AN ACTION

RELATING TO LAW AND ORDER; RECOMMENDING TO THE NAVAJO NATION PRESIDENT THE PROBATIONARY APPOINTMENT OF RHONDA L. TUNI AS NAVAJO NATION DISTRICT COURT JUDGE

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Law and Order Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 600(A).
- B. The Law and Order Committee determines the qualifications of all applicants for Navajo Nation District Court judge appointment and makes recommendations for such appointments to the Navajo Nation President. 2 N.N.C. § 601(B)(7) and 7 N.N.C. § 355(A).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. Ms. Rhonda L. Tuni, an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation, is an applicant for appointment as District Court Judge. Ms. Tuni's application has been reviewed and interviewed by the Law and Order Committee.
- B. The Law and Order Committee determined that Ms. Rhonda L. Tuni meets all the qualifications for appointment as Navajo Nation District Court Judge, pursuant to 7 N.N.C. § 354.

SECTION THREE. RECOMMENDATION FOR APPOINTMENT

The Law and Order Committee hereby recommends to the Navajo Nation President the probationary appointment of Ms. Rhonda L. Tuni as Navajo Nation District Court Judge, subject to confirmation by the Navajo Nation Council.

SECTION FOUR. DIRECTIVE

The Office of Human Resources, the Administrative Office of the Judicial Branch of the Navajo Nation, shall immediately submit to the Navajo Nation President all documents provided by the applicant recommended for appointment. Confidential information within application documents shall remain protected except upon authorized disclosure by the applicant. 2 N.N.C. § 81 et seq.
