BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Navajo Nation Council established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation standing committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 700 (A).
- B. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee approves the Navajo Nation Speaker's appointments to the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission. 2 N.N.C. § 852 (A).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The Navajo Nation Council established the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission within the Legislative Branch. 2 N.N.C. § 851 (A).
- B. The Navajo-Hopi Land Commission's purpose is to "[m]onitor, collect, and update information on any and all land use conflicts between the Navajo Nation and the Hopi Tribe, and any claimants in and to lands within the area described in the Act of June 14, 1934 (48 Stat. 960) [and to] [s]peak and act for the Navajo Nation with respect to the land selection and land exchange provisions of P.L. 96-305." 2 N.N.C. § 851 (B).

- 1 C. The Speaker shall appoint nine Navajo Nation Council voting members who
2 represent areas affected by the Navajo-Hopi Land Dispute. 2 N.N.C. § 852 (A).
3 D. The Speaker's memorandum appointing nine members to the Navajo-Hopi Land
4 Commission is attached as **Exhibit A**.
5 E. The Navajo-Hopi Land Commission members shall serve at the pleasure of the
6 Naabik'iyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. § 852 (B) (2).
7 F. The Navajo-Hopi Land Commission members shall serve a term coinciding with their
8 term as Navajo Nation Council Delegates and until their successors are appointed. 2
9 N.N.C. § 852 (D).

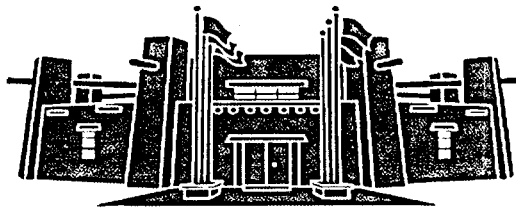
SUBJECT: Appointment Navajo Hopi Land Commission

Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 852 (A) and (B)(12), nine members of the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission shall be appointed by the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council with the approval of the Naabik'iyati Committee. Also, 2 N.N.C. § 852 (B)(1) cites the requirements that the membership shall consist of voting members of the Navajo Nation Council representing the areas affected by the Navajo-Hopi Land Dispute.

It is my pleasure to appoint you as a member of the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission. This memorandum shall serve as notification of the appointment to the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission, the appointment will be effective on the approval of the Naabik'iyati Committee. Your appointment will be concurrent with your term as a Council Delegate.

The purpose and authorities of the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission is found at 2 N.N.C. §§ 851 and 853.



Nevertheless, "the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council shall introduce [the proposed resolution] into the legislative process by assigning it to the respective oversight committee(s) of the Navajo Nation Council having authority over the matters for proper consideration." 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(5).

Please ensure that his particular resolution request is precisely what you want. You are encouraged to review the proposed resolution to ensure that it is drafted to your satisfaction.
