17	A. The Navajo Nation Council established the Law and Order Committee (LOC) as a	
18	Navajo Nation standing committee and, as such, empowered LOC to review and	
19	make recommendations to the Navajo Nation Council on proposed Navajo Nation	
20	Code amendments and enactments. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 600 (A), 601 (B)(14)

22	B. The Navajo Nation Council established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a Navajo	
23	Nation standing committee and as such proposed legislation that requires final action	
24	by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2

12	Section Two. Amending Navajo Nation Code Title 2
13	The Navajo Nation Council amends 2 N.N.C. §182 as follows:

27	The provisions of this Act which amend or adopt new sections of the Navajo Nation
28	Code shall be codified by the Office of Legislative Counsel. The Office of Legislative
29	Counsel shall incorporate such amended provisions into the next codification or
30	supplement of the Navajo Nation Code

Section Four. Savings Clause

Should any provision of this Act be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation, without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the remainder of the Act shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.

Section Five. Effective Date

The provisions of this Act shall become effective in accord with 2 N.N.C. § 221(C).
