### LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY SHEET

TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; AMENDING 2 N.N.C. § 285 TO CLARIFY THE SPEAKERS VOTING RESTRICTION WHEN ANY TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE IS REQUIRED

**PURPOSE:** If approved, this resolution will amend 2 N.N.C § 285 by explicitly stating that the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council is restricted from voting in any two-thirds vote situation.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

17	Section One. Authorities
18	A. The Law and Order Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation
19	Council and is empowered with the authority to review and make recommendations
20	to the Navajo Nation Council on amendments to and enactments in the Navajo
21	Nation Code. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(1), 600 (A), and 601(B)(14).
22	B. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council, pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §
23	164 (A)(9), reviews proposed legislation which requires final action by the Navajo
24	Nation Council.

A.	On October 16, 2012 the Navajo Nation Council passed CO-45-12, Adopting the
	"Navajo Nation Title 2 Reform Act of 2012" Amending Certain Sections of the
	Navajo Nation Code at Title 2, Sections 104, 106, 107, 110, 162, 163, 164, 169,
	181, 183, 184, 187, 189, 192, 285, 300, 301, 201, 401, 403, 501, 503, 601, 603, 700,
	701 (sic); the Resolution was vetoed by the Navajo Nation President on November
	15, 2012, subsequently the Navajo Nation Council passed Resolution No. CJA 03-
	13, Overriding the Navajo Nation President's Veto of Navajo Nation Council
	Resolution No. CO-45-12.

- B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §285 (B)(4), the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council may only vote in the event of a tie.
- C. Several provisions within the Navajo Nation Code require the Navajo Nation Council to pass legislation with a two-thirds vote of the "full membership" "the Navajo Nation Council" or "Council." As the Speaker is limited to vote only in the event of a tie, the two-thirds vote requirement will never result in the need for the Speaker to make a tie-breaking vote.
- D. In the interest of clarity, efficiency and precedence, 2 N.N.C. §285 should explicitly state that the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council shall not vote for the passage of legislation which requires a two-thirds vote of the "full membership" "the Navajo Nation Council" "Council" or any other reference to the Navajo Nation Council as a whole.

## Section Three. Amending 2 N.N.C. § 285

Navajo Nation Council hereby amends 2 N.N.C. § 285 as follows:

NAVAJO NATION CODE ANNOTATED
TITLE 2. NAVAJO NATION GOVERNMENT
CHAPTER 3. LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

SUBCHAPTER 2. NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL MEETINGS

\*\*\*

- A. The Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council shall exercise all powers and authorities which are delegated to the Office by law or may from time to time be delegated to such Office by the Navajo Nation Council.
- B. The Speaker's powers and duties shall include the following:
- 1. Preside at all Navajo Nation Council and Naabik'íyáti' Committee meetings;
- 2. Direct and supervise the personnel and programs under the Legislative Branch as provided by law;
- 3. Appoint a Speaker Pro Tem to allow the Speaker to participate in debate and sponsor resolution(s) before the Navajo Nation Council and, in the sole discretion of the Speaker, to carry out the administrative duties of the Office of Speaker when the Speaker is unavailable and absent due to travel, illness, or for any other reason deemed sufficient by the Speaker;
- 4. Vote only in the event of a tie vote.
- 5. The Speaker shall not vote when any two-thirds vote is required insofar as a two-thirds vote will never require a tie-breaking vote by the Speaker;
- 5. 6. Call a special session of the Navajo Nation Council pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 162;
- 6. 7. Recommend to the Budget and Finance Committee an annual operating budget or amendments thereof for the Legislative Branch and advise the Navajo Nation Council on the annual budget recommended by the Budget and Finance Committee; and
- 7. <u>8.</u> Issue official Certificates of Condolence, Congratulations, Appreciation, Recognition or Achievement and other similar expressions of sentiment signed by the Speaker on behalf of the Navajo Nation Council at the written request of any Council Delegate as provided herein:
- a. Certificates of Condolence shall be reserved exclusively for former members of the Navajo Nation Council, Chairmen, Vice Chairmen, Presidents and Vice Presidents of the Navajo Nation.

b. Uniform Procedures for the Issuance of Certificates shall be developed by the Office of the Speaker subject to final approval by resolution of the Intergovernmental Relations Committee of the Navajo Nation Council.

#### Section Four, Effective Date

The Navajo Nation Code amendment enacted herein shall be effective pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 221(B).

### **Section Five. Codification**

The provisions of this Act which amend or adopt new sections of the Navajo Nation Code shall be codified by the Office of Legislative Counsel. The Office of Legislative Counsel shall incorporate such amended provisions in the next codification of the Navajo Nation Code.

### Section Six. Saving Clause

Should any provisions of this ordinance be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation, without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those portions of this ordinance which are not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.

Nevertheless, "the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council shall introduce [the proposed resolution] into the legislative process by assigning it to the respective oversight committee(s) of the Navajo Nation Council having authority over the matters for proper consideration. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(5).

Please review the proposed resolution to ensure it is drafted to your satisfaction. If you approve, please sign as "Primary Sponsor" and submit it to the Office of Legislative Services where the proposed resolution will be given a tracking number and referred to the Office of the Speaker.
