AN ACTION

RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE; CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF MR. BOBBY BEGAYE TO THE NAVAJO NATION TELECOMMUNICATIONS REGULATORY COMMISSION

Section One. Authority

- A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has oversight authority with respect to communications and utilities. 2 N.N.C. § 500(C).
- B. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §501(B)(9), is empowered to "grant final confirmation of appointments to enterprise boards; Navajo Nation Water Rights Commission; and entities under the authority of the Committee requiring appointments."

Section Two. Findings

- A. The Navajo Telecommunications Regulatory Commission (Commission) is established under 2 N.N.C. §§ 3451-3455.
- B. The Commission consists of seven Commissioners appointed by the President of the Navajo Nation and confirmed by the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. §3454(A)
- C. The appointment to the Commission shall be for a period of four (4) years. 2 N.N.C. §3454(B).
- D. The President of the Navajo Nation has appointed Mr. Bobby Begaye to the Navajo Nation Telecommunications Regulatory Commission for a period beginning September 7, 2015 and ending September 7, 2019. Appointment letter attached as Exhibit A, letter of interest as Exhibit B and resume as Exhibit C.

E. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest of the Navajo Nation to confirm the appointment of Mr. Bobby Begaye to the Navajo Nation Telecommunications Regulatory Commission for a period beginning September 7, 2015 and ending September 7, 2019.

Section Three. Approval

The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby confirms the appointment of Mr. Bobby Begaye to the Navajo Nation Telecommunications Regulatory Commission for a period beginning September 7, 2015 and ending September 7, 2019.
