YEAR 2016 NAVAJO NATION TRIBAL TRANSPORTATION  
IMPROVEMENT PLAN**

**BE IT ENACTED:**

Section One. The Navajo Nation finds the following:

- A. 2 N.N.C. §501(C)(1) provides the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Council with oversight authority of the Division of Transportation.
- B. 2 N.N.C. § 501(B)(2)(b) provides the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council the power to grant final approval for Road and Transportation Plan prioritizing list for road and transportation projects.
- C. Pursuant to 25 C.F.R Part 170, Subpart D of the Tribal Transportation Program, the Navajo Division of Transportation is charged with performing the critical functions in collaboration with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, local, state and federal agencies to develop a tribal transportation priority listing.
- D. The Navajo Division of Transportation prepared the FY2016 Navajo Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP) which includes projects for preliminary study which are cultural, environmental impact studies, rights-of-way, centerline surveys and design, construction engineering funds for construction administration and construction funds to construct roadway improvements, see Exhibit A.
- E. The Navajo Division of Transportation's TTIP also includes funds programmed under the Tribal Transportation Program for safety projects, planning, and operation and maintenance.
- F. Approving the FY2016 Navajo Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Program is in the Navajo Nation's best interest.

**Section Two. Approval**

- A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby approves the FY2016 Navajo Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Program for the projects listed in the five (5) year plan.

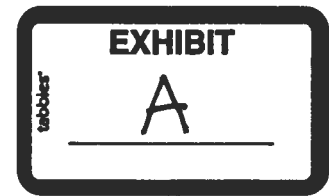

## **Tribal Transportation Improvement Program**

### **Executive Summary**

Guided by the 25 Coded Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 170 Subpart D under the Tribal Transportation Program (TTP) for the *Transportation Planning, Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP), Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) development, annual update of the Tribal Transportation Facility Inventory and Public Hearings*, the Navajo Division of Transportation is charged to performed the critical functions in collaboration with the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), local, state and federal agencies to develop a tribal transportation priority listing. Projects listed on the 5 year TTIP have funds programmed for preliminary studies which are cultural, environmental impact studies, rights of way, centerlines surveys and design; construction engineering funds are for construction administration; and the construction funds to construct the roadway improvements. In addition, there are other funds programmed under the TTP for safety projects, planning, operation and maintenance. Safety projects may include enhancements on some of the paved roads throughout the Navajo Nation. The TTIP must be financially constrained, in the road inventory, and adhere to all relevant provisions found in the current transportation bill, Moving Ahead for Progress (MAP-21).

The 2% Planning funds are used to provide technical services and guidance to the chapters, regions and communities in the area of transportation planning, mapping, roadway data collection for road maintenance activities, possible improvements, prioritization, road inventory of public roads, public involvements and participation in addressing their transportation needs, and long range transportation plans.

Annually, the Navajo Nation TTIP priority is updated with projects that are most critical to the communities and the Navajo Nation based on the prioritization criteria and submitted to the Resources and Development Committee (RDC) for review and approval. The RDC-approved TTIP is submitted to Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for final approval and will be included in the national transportation improvement program by FHWA.

Construction of six (6) projects listed on the FY2015 NNTTIP were completed and removed from the FY2016 NNTIP. These six (6) projects constructed 17.6 miles of new pavement and three (3) bridges at a total cost of \$39,958,980. These projects are listed below:

**1. N39(1-1)(2)1,2,4 – Kinlichee, AZ (Fort Defiance Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the BIA DOT Navajo Region, replaced an existing wooden bridge with a new single-span bridge and constructed 0.2 miles of roadway approaches at a cost of \$2,835,431.

**2. N21(3)2,4 – Tonalea, Kaibeto, AZ (Western Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the BIA DOT Navajo Region, constructed 4.5 miles of grade and drainage work, placement of new pavement, and miscellaneous construction work at a cost of \$11,405,560.

**3. N7057(1)1,2,3 – White Rock, NM (Eastern Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the BIA DOT Navajo Region, replaced an existing military-type bridge with a new single-span bridge and constructed 0.1 miles of roadway approaches at a cost of \$1,671,394.

**4. N35(9)2/N35(9-1)4 – Sweetwater, AZ (Northern Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the BIA DOT Navajo Region, constructed 4.5 miles of grade and drainage work, placement of new pavement, and miscellaneous construction work at a cost of \$6,857,517.

**5. N55(2)1,2,4 – Alamo, NM (Eastern Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the BIA DOT Navajo Region, constructed 8.1 miles of grade and drainage work, placement of new pavement, and miscellaneous construction work at a cost of \$14,639,078.

**6. N7150(1)1,2,3 – Huerfano, NM (Eastern Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with San Juan County, NM and the NMDOT, replaced an existing 350-foot long military-type bridge with a new three-span bridge and constructed 0.2 miles of roadway approaches at a cost of \$2,550,000. The Navajo Nation contributed TTP funds of \$1,500,000, San Juan County, NM contributed \$401,520, and the FHWA National Highway Performance Program (NHPP) funds administered by NMDOT contributed \$648,480 for a total of \$2,550,000.

### Ongoing Construction Projects FY2015

Seven (7) projects listed on the FY2015 NNTTIP are under construction and listed in the FY2016 NNTIP. These seven (7) projects will construct 37.6 miles of new pavement and three (3) bridges at a total cost of \$82,829,539. These projects are listed below:

**1. N16(6)/N162(1)/N164(4)2,4 – Navajo Mountain, UT (Western Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the BIA DOT Navajo Region, will construct 5.7 miles of grade and drainage work, placement of new pavement, and miscellaneous construction work at a cost of \$21,393,563.

**2. N31(4)1,2,4 – Navajo, NM (Fort Defiance Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the BIA DOT Navajo Region, will construct 5.5 miles of grade and drainage work, placement of new pavement, new bridge, and miscellaneous construction work at a cost of \$17,500,000.

**3. N55(3)1,2,4 – Alamo, NM (Eastern Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the BIA DOT Navajo Region, will construct 8.7 miles of grade and drainage work, placement of new pavement, and miscellaneous construction work at a cost of \$20,800,000.

**4. N6461(1)1,2,3 – Dennehotso, AZ (Western Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the FHWA Federal Lands Highway, will replace an existing military-type bridge with a new single span bridge and construct 0.1 miles of roadway approaches at a cost of \$887,350.

**5. N251(5-1)1,2,3 – Tselani/Cottonwood, AZ (Chinle Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the BIA DOT Navajo Region, will construct 14.5 miles of grade and drainage work, placement of treated gravel surface, and miscellaneous construction work at a cost of \$10,846,578.

**6. N9345(2)2,4 – Wide Ruins, AZ (Fort Defiance Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the BIA DOT Navajo Region, will construct 1.9 miles of grade and drainage work, placement of new pavement, and miscellaneous construction work at a cost of \$6,326,400.

**7. N8008(1)1,2,3 – Round Rock, AZ (Northern Agency)**

The Navajo Nation, in partnership with the BIA DOT Navajo Region, will construct a new bridge and 1.2 miles of roadway approaches at a cost of \$5,075,648.
