TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE, AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL YEAR 2021 COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET; WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) AND 860, 12 N.N.C. §§ 2001 et seq., AND 12 N.N.C. § 840(B)

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to approve Navajo Nation Comprehensive Budget for Fiscal Year 2021.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

27	Section Two. Adopting Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2021 Budget	
28	The Navajo Nation hereby adopts the Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2021 Comprehensive	
29	Budget as follows:

- A. The Navajo Nation approves the appropriation of 12% of the Fiscal Year 2021 revenue in the amount of \$19,011,000 to the Navajo Nation Permanent Fund; 4% of Fiscal Year 2021 revenue in the amount of \$6,337,000 to the Navajo Veterans Trust Fund; 2% of Fiscal Year 2021 revenue in the amount of \$3,168,000 to the Navajo Nation Land Acquisition Trust Fund; \$2,000,000 of Fiscal Year 2021 revenue to the Capital Outlay Match Funding Special Revenue Fund; \$2,000,000 of Fiscal Year 2021 revenue to the Water Rights Claim Fund; and \$12,400,000 of Fiscal Year 2021 revenue to the Diné Higher Education Grant Fund.
- B. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the appropriation of \$1,244,353,093 as the Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2021 Operating Budget, as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, which constitutes \$167,142,583 of General Funds, \$22,500,000 Indirect Cost Credit; \$12,400,000 in Higher Education set aside funds; \$ 0 Personnel Savings; \$86,500,386 Proprietary Fund; \$81,875,155 Fiduciary Funds; \$40,376,371 Special Revenue Internal Funds; \$3,800,000 External Cash Match Funds (General Funds); \$ 3,000,000 Capital Outlay Match Funds; and \$826,758,598 Special Revenue External Funds, summarized as follows:
 - Legislative Branch: \$16,410,204 as the Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2021 Operating Budget, as set forth in the attached Exhibit B, which includes \$15,335,322 General Fund Revenue; \$1,072,882 Indirect Cost Credit; \$2,000 Proprietary Funds; \$0 Personnel Savings Fund; \$0 Fiduciary Funds, \$0 Special Revenue Internal Funds; \$0 Special Revenue External Funds, for the Navajo Nation Council, various Standing Committees, boards, commissions, offices, programs, and activities within the Legislative Branch.
 - 2. Judicial Branch: \$19,923,325 as the Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2021 Operating Budget, as set forth in the attached Exhibit C, which includes \$16,624,653 of General Funds; \$130,107 Indirect Cost Credit; \$ 0 Proprietary Funds; \$ 0 Fiduciary Funds; \$ 0 Special Revenue Internal Funds and \$ 3,168,565 Special Revenue External Funds, for the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, district courts, family courts, various offices, programs and activities within the Judicial Branch.

- 3. Executive Branch: \$1,181,834,512 as the Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2021 Operating Budget, as set forth in the attached Exhibit D, which includes \$119,367,464 of General Funds; \$13,927,103 Indirect Cost Credit; \$12,400,000 Higher Education Set Aside Funds; \$0 Personnel Savings Fund; \$86,498,386 Proprietary Funds; \$81,875,155 Fiduciary Funds; \$3,800,000 External Fund Cash Match; \$40,376,371 Special Revenue Internal Funds; and, \$823,590,033 Special Revenue External Funds; for the various divisions, departments, programs and offices within the Executive Branch.
- Fixed Costs: \$23,185,052 which includes \$15,815,144 General Funds, \$7,369,908
 Indirect Cost Credit; and \$0 Personnel Savings Fund as set forth in the attached
 Exhibit E.
- 5. Capital Improvement Funds which includes \$3,000,000 Capital Outlay Match, to be used at the Chapter's discretion, with the exception that these funds are not to be used for recurring expenses, as set forth in the attached **Exhibit F**.
- Chapter Non-Administrative Costs: \$11,998,969 for non-administrative costs. This
 does not include chapter official's stipends, permanent personnel costs, and travel
 expenses of chapter officials and chapter staff.
- External Funds Cash Match: \$3,800,000 for external funds cash match obligations for grant agreements and contracts.

The FY 2020 External Fund Cash Match, BU# 118024, unexpended fund balance shall be carried over to FY 2021 to maintain a fund balance for cash match needs during the 2021 Fiscal Year.

C. The Navajo Nation Resolution, CF-07-11, titled, "Establishing and Designating the Personnel Accounts Savings as Restricted Carryover Funds to be Used for Administering and Maintaining the Classification and Pay Plans by the Department of Personnel Management and Further, Implementing a Moratorium on Any Future Proposed Budget Revisions and/or Re-Allocations From the General Fund Personnel Accounts Saving", established a moratorium on any future proposed Budget Revisions and/or Reallocations from the General Funds Personnel Accounts Savings and required those Savings go to an annual General Wage Adjustment, step increase and other salary

adjustments to the Pay Plan; in addition, that any excess or surplus funds shall be deposited to the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB).

The Navajo Nation Controller projects the Personnel Lapse amount is \$ 13,083,541. The Navajo Nation adopts a General Wage Adjustment, **Exhibit G**, and waives the requirement of excess and surplus funds deposit to the UUFB and hereby approves funding from the Fiscal Year 2021 Personnel Savings Fund as follows:

- 1. General Wage Adjustment 3% (Exhibit G) \$ 3,846,992
- D. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the carryover of excess Indirect Cost Credit, if any, from Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2020 into Fiscal Year 2021.
- E. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the carryover of unexpended Capital Improvement Project Funds from Fiscal Year 2020 to Fiscal Year 2021.
- F. The Navajo Nation Council and its standing committees, through its oversight authorities, are responsible to the Navajo Nation to ensure that the Navajo Nation Divisions, Departments and Programs provide timely, professional, updated, appropriate services to the Navajo People. One very pragmatic, effective method to assure quality services is to prompt the Divisions, Departments and Programs through the use of Conditions of Appropriations. Condition of Appropriation means a condition placed on an appropriation or expenditure by the Navajo Nation Council at the time the appropriation or expenditure is made, which requires performance of a specific task by a program within a specific time period within the fiscal year. The condition requires the performance of specific tasks within the time period set out by the Navajo Nation Council. Failure to perform within the specified time period may result in restrictions on future expenditure of the funds until the condition is met. 12 N.N.C. §810(I), amended by CS-52-17.
 - The Navajo Nation Council has included Conditions of Appropriation in the 2021 Comprehensive Budget. The Navajo Nation Council hereby adopts the Conditions of Appropriation identified in **Exhibit H.**
- G. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the Legislative Concerns for Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2021, as set forth in the attached **Exhibit I.**

- H. The Navajo Nation hereby acknowledges that all federal, state, and local government funds addressed in the Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2021 Comprehensive Budget are provided primarily for information purposes, as directed in the Budget Instructions Manual, and should not be deemed to limit the expenditure authority for any program, provided additional funds are accepted pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §164(B), 2 N.N.C. §301(B)(15), and 2 N.N.C. §701(A)(10).
- I. The Navajo Nation hereby authorizes monthly drawdowns of all funds deposited into BIA Account, PL7341701, Navajo Tribe, Arizona/New Mexico, which are considered Navajo Nation General Funds as part of the overall revenue projection for support of the operations of the Navajo Nation Government.
- J. The Navajo Nation hereby authorizes the Office of Management and Budget to carry-over available budget amounts to cover any prior year open contracts carried into Fiscal Year 2021 by the Office of the Controller. Further, the Office of the Controller shall ensure that the budgeted funds carried over are used specifically, and only for, those open encumbrances. The Office of the Controller shall also inform the Office of Management and Budget, in writing, of any cancelled or reduced prior year open encumbrances so that the Office of Management and Budget can make the appropriate budget adjustments.
- K. The Navajo Nation hereby waives 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) and 860 for the purpose of passing a comprehensive budget because the Capital Improvement Plan is not available.
- L. The Navajo Nation hereby waives 12 N.N.C. §§ 2001 *et seq.* in order to allow chapters to use Capital Outlay Match Funds as described in paragraph B.5, above.
- M. The Navajo Nation waives the provision in 12 NNC. § 840(B) that requires the Navajo Nation Council to adopt the comprehensive budget no less than twenty (20) days prior to the expiration of each fiscal year.
- N. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget Detail, included as Exhibit J.

To develop the Navajo Nation Capital improvement plan in accordance with the plans capital improvement plans submitted by each chapter by the end of the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2021.

Section Five. Effective Date

The Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2021 Comprehensive Budget enacted herein shall be effective pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §§ 164(A)(17) and 221(B).

The Office of the Controller has compiled the above referenced document (Exhibit A).

1. As of September 4, 2020 the projected Personnel Lapse amount is \$13,083,541.

The Assumptions in which this schedule takes into account are as follows:

a. This schedule is based upon the assumption that the vacant positions will continue to stay vacant until 09/30/20.

- This schedule assumes that all the Department of Youth temporary employees will utilize all the dollars currently budgeted in their programs.
- c. This schedule also assumes that all the overtime, and special duty pay currently budgeted will be utilized fully.
- d. This schedule reserves the remaining budget available for the Headstart supplemental. There are a number of permanent positions within this business unit.
- e. Also, this schedule is taking into consideration any judgments or settlements related to payroll that General Fund programs may incur before the end of the year.
- f. Any budgeted amount within the Merit pay or bonus pay or step increase line items are also considered to be fully utilized before the end of the year.
- 2. In addition with discussions with the Office of Management and Budget and Department of Personnel Management there are three general wage adjustment (GWA)options available. The attached Exhibit B there are the three options for consideration for Fiscal Year 2021. The option we recommend is option # 2 which is the 2.5% GWA.

FY 2021 CONDITION OF APPROPRIATIONS

Condition of Appropriation means a condition placed on an appropriation or expenditure by the Navajo Nation Council at the time the appropriation or expenditure is made, which requires performance of a specific task by a program within a specific time period within the fiscal year. The condition may require that failure to perform the specific tasks within the time period set out by the Navajo Nation Council will result in restrictions on future expenditure of the funds until the condition is met. 12 N.N.C. §810(I), Amended by CS-52-17.

RESULT for noncompliance with the following Conditions of Appropriations (COA):

- Based on the quarterly COA Status Report, the Office of Management & Budget (OMB)
 will immediately report a program's non-compliance to the respective Division Director,
 appropriate Branch Chief, appropriate oversight Committee and the Budget and Finance
 Committee;
- 2. The OMB will notify the Budget and Finance Committee of any non-compliance. After consultation with the program director, the Office of the Controller, the OMB, and on recommendation of the appropriate oversight Committee, the Budget and Finance Committee may, by resolution, vote to:
 - (1) implement a freeze on the program's expenditure of travel funds, or withhold up to 10 percent of the program director's gross salary,
 - (2) extend the time period for the program to fulfill the condition, or
 - (3) vacate the condition if it is infeasible for the program to fulfill.
- 3. The Controller shall immediately freeze the program's travel funds or, withhold 10% of the gross salary of the program director of the responsible program after 10 working days of the Budget and Finance Committee's action provided that there has been no filing with the Office of Hearings and Appeals.
- 4. Prior to the approval of a COA in the comprehensive budget resolution, per 12 N.N.C. § 820 (R)(4), the Navajo Nation Council shall consult with the director of the program required to fulfill the condition, as well as the Office of the Controller, and the Office of Management and Budget. The consultation shall include a discussion of the feasibility of

the program fulfilling the condition within the time frame proposed by Council, and any possible alternatives to the proposed condition.

Condition of Appropriation 1

The Veterans Administration Executive Director, BU #103015, shall submit a plan as to how Chapter Veterans Organizations can maintain involvement in the distribution of funds to HEHSC by the end of the 1st quarter of FY 2021.

If this Condition of Appropriation is not complied with by the end of the stated quarter, the Office of the Controller and Office of Management and Budget, by oversight Committee Resolution, shall freeze the Responsible Entity's travel funds. If this Condition of Appropriation is not complied with by the end of the stated quarter the withholding will be forfeited.

Responsible Entity: Veterans Administration Executive Director

Condition of Appropriation 2

The Veterans Administration Executive Director, BU #103015, shall submit an updated Veterans count for each agency and chapter by the end of the 1st quarter of FY 2021.

If this Condition of Appropriation is not complied with by the end of the stated quarter, the Office of the Controller and Office of Management and Budget, by oversight Committee Resolution, shall freeze the Responsible Entity's travel funds. If this Condition of Appropriation is not complied with by the end of the stated quarter the withholding will be forfeited.

Responsible Entity: Veterans Administration Executive Director

FISCAL YEAR 2021 LEGISLATIVE CONCERNS

Legislative Concern means a comment, directive or recommendation made by the Navajo Nation Council, by virtue of it legislative oversight authority and pursuant to its authority as the governing body of the Navajo Nation, raising an issue of concern with respect to the internal functioning of the three Branches. Such concerns are advisory in nature, and do not create legal conditions precedent to the expenditure of appropriated funds. In order for a particular legislative concern to be appended to a budget resolution, it must be voted upon and adopted by a majority of the Navajo Nation Council. Legislative concerns which are not voted upon, will not be appended to the budget resolution, but will be referred to the appropriate Branch Chief in memorandum form by the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. § 810(M).

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 1

Division of Community Development

Administrative Service Centers

The Administrative Service Centers are to provide technical assistance to the chapter staff. The Department Manager and Division Director shall the prepare a plan and provide a report, in writing and orally, to both the Resources and Development Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee at the end of the first and second quarters. The Resources and Development Committee and the Budget and Finance committee may choose to have a joint work session on this matter at the committees' discretion.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 2

Office of the Auditor General

The Auditor General shall prepare a plan on how to expand the number of audits to include more chapters and programs into its annual work plan. In the plan, the Office of the Auditor General shall emphasize chapters and programs that have not been audited in more than three (3) years. The Office of Auditor General shall provide its plan, in writing and orally, to the Budget and Finance Committee by the end of the first quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 3

Division of Human Resources

Department of Personnel Management

The Department of Personnel Management is to provide a report on the total dollar amount of vacant positions to the Budget and Finance Committee by the end of the first quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 4

Division of Human Resources

Department of Personnel Management

The Department of Personnel Management shall examine its Policies and Procedures for hiring regarding the classification of positions and report to the Health, Education and Human Services Committee by the end of the first quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 5

Division of Public Safety

The Division of Public Safety is to station an officer at the Newlands sub-office and at To'hajiilee by the end to the first quarter of FY 2021 in accordance with the 638 contract for public safety services.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 6

Division of Public Safety

The Division of Public Safety shall fully implement the Enhanced 911 service throughout the Navajo Nation by the end of the first quarter of FY2021. The Division of Public Safety shall submit a written report to the Law and Order and Budget and Finance Committees when this has been completed.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 7

Division of Public Safety

The Division of Public Safety shall provide a written and oral report on establishing a Missing Persons Unit within the Division of Public Safety to the Law and Order and Budget and Finance Committees by the end of the first quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 8

Division of Public Safety

The Division of Public Safety shall establish a Medical Examiner position in accordance with LOCD- 20-18, within the Department of Criminal Investigations by the end of the first quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 9

Division of Public Safety

The Division of Public Safety shall develop a plan to attract and recruit high school students within the Navajo Nation into the Police Officer training program. This plan shall be presented in writing and orally to the Law and Order Committee by the end of the first quarter.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 10

Division of Public Safety

The Division of Public Safety shall re-establish the Drug and Gang Task Force. This task force is to be re-established by the end of the first quarter.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 11

Division of Public Safety

The Division of Public Safety shall develop a plan for all Navajo Nation Police Officers, Rangers, Forestry, and Fish and Wildlife Officers to be Navajo Nation certified in the Police Officer Standards Training program by the end of the second quarter of FY 2021. The Division of Public Safety shall provide an update to the Law and Order Committee on its progress by the end of the first quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 12

Office of Legislative Counsel

The Office of Legislative Counsel shall prepare a work plan to update the Navajo Nation Code by the end of the second quarter of FY 2021. This work plan shall include a proposal for remaining current with amendments to the Navajo Nation Code.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 13

Navajo Hopi Land Commission Office

The Navajo Hopi Land Commission Office shall coordinate with the Office of Navajo Hopi Indian Relocation to remediate the dilapidated homes and buildings in East Mills, Little Silversmith area of New Lands, Hard Rock area, and the Coalmine Mesa Chapter House. The Navajo Hopi Land Commission Office shall provide its report to the Navajo Hopi Land Commission by the end of the second quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN NO. 14

Navajo Hopi Land Commission Office

The Navajo Hopi Land Commission Office shall coordinate with the Office of Navajo Hopi Indian Relocation to repair Road 8031 in the Hard Rock area. The Navajo Hopi Land Commission Office shall provide its report to the Navajo Hopi Land Commission by the end of the second quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN 15

Office of the Speaker

The Office of the Speaker shall present a draft version of a policies and procedures for the Office of the Speaker, as well as recommended amendments to its enabling legislation, and present a report on such to NABI by the end of the second quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN 16

Division of Social Services

The Division of Social Services Executive Director shall develop a comprehensive plan to address the increase in domestic violence within and around the Navajo Nation. Such plan shall include, but not be limited to, preventive, as well as protective measures. The Executive Director shall present the comprehensive plan to the Health, Education and Human Services Committee by the end of the second quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN 17

The Division of Social Services Executive Director shall evaluate whether there are duplicate services being provided by Work Force Development and Department of Self-Reliance and report such duplicate services to the Health, Education and Human Services Committee by the end of the second quarter of FY 2021. The Executive Director shall further provide a plan to eliminate the duplicate services, if any, to the Health, Education and Human Services Committee by the end of the third quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN 18

The Department of Family Services shall provide training to agency staff to enhance the provision of direct services through evidence-based practices. The Department of Family Services shall report quarterly to the Health, Education and Human Services Committee on the number, as well as the content of such trainings, provided to agency staff each quarter.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN 19

The Division of General Services and Navajo Air Transportation Department shall perform a cost-benefits analysis on the existing air transportation program versus alternatives, including but not limited to, air charter services to determine the most effective way for the Nation to provide air transportation. The Division of General Services and Navajo Air Transportation Department shall report, in both written and oral formats, the findings of their analysis to the Health, Education and Human Services Committee by the end of the second quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN 20

Department of Dine Education

The Navajo Nation Board of Education shall provide enabling legislation a revised Plan of Operation to the Health, Education and Human Services Committee by the end of the second quarter of FY 2021.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN 21

Office of Management and Budget

The Office of Management and Budget shall provide an update to the Budget and Finance Committee on the progress of the Budget Policies Manual by the end of the first quarter of FY2021. The Office of Management and Budget shall present this report orally and in writing.

LEGISLATIVE CONCERN 22

Department of Health

Department of Aging and Long Term Care Services

The Department Manager shall provide a report and a plan on the repairs and maintenance needs of existing facilities and capital improvement needs by the end of the third quarter of FY 2021. The program is encouraged to work with all potential funds from various resources. This report shall be present to the Health, Education and Human Services Committee, both orally and in writing.
