


## 23<sup>rd</sup> NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL LEGISLATION SPONSORSHIP WITHDRAWAL

TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACT RELATING TO THE LAW AND ORDER, HEALTH, EDUCATION AND HUMAN SERVICES, BUDGET AND FINANCE, AND NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEES, AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; ENACTING THE "NAVAJO NATION PUBLIC SAFETY SYSTEM FUND ACT OF 2017," AMENDING TITLE 12 OF THE NAVAJO NATION CODE AND ESTABLISHING THE "NAVAJO NATION PUBLIC SAFETY SYSTEM FUND" TO INCLUDE MONEYS RECEIVED FROM THE UNITED STATES THROUGH SETTLEMENT OF *RAMAH NAVAJO CHAPTER, ET AL. V. JEWEL* 

**PURPOSE:** This resolution, if approved, will establish the Navajo Nation Public Safety System Fund Act of 2017 to be funded with settlement funds from the *Ramah Navajo Chapter, et al. v. Jewel* lawsuit, and will amend Title 12 of the Navajo Nation Code setting up the Public Safety System Fund.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committee. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each committee member to review the proposed resolution in detail.

	22	Section One. Authority	
	23	A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2	
	24	N.N.C. § 102 (A).	
	25	B. The Naabik'iyati' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to	
	26	review all proposed legislation which requires final action by the Navajo Nation	
	27	Council. 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(9).	
	28	C. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered	
	29	to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting,	
	30	appropriation, investment, and management of all funds and to coordinate and	

review all fiscal, financial and investment activities of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §§ 301 (B) (2) and (5).

D. The Health Education and Human Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to provide legislative oversight on matters involving health and social services and to oversee Navajo Nation policies and priorities to optimize the delivery of social services and health services to the Navajo people and to review and recommend resolutions relating to social services and health. See 2 N.N.C. §§400 (C)(1) and (4) and 401 (B)(6)(a).

E. The Law and Order Committee has oversight of courts, criminal defense, legal defense of the indigent, juvenile justice, corrections, law enforcement, emergency management for the purpose of establishing and developing the Navajo Nation justice system infrastructure including justice system facilities and to promote institutional planning and coordination among and between justice-system-related entities. 2 N.N.C. §600(C)(3).

### Section Two. Findings

- A. The *Ramah Navajo Chapter et al. v. Jewell* (No. 1:90-cv-957-JAP-KPM) is a class action lawsuit against the U.S. Department of Interior for under-payment of contract support costs by the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA"). Two earlier settlements in the case generally dealt with unpaid contract support costs between the years 1989 and 1993. In 2008 a third settlement made adjustments to the system for negotiating indirect cost rates. Earlier settlements left unresolved claims for unpaid contract support costs from 1994 to the present.
- B. Since 1994, Congress has capped the maximum appropriation the BIA could spend on contract support cost payments. As a result, the BIA asserted it could not be held liable for any resulting underpayments.
- C. In 2012, the United States Supreme Court in Salazar v. Ramah Navajo Chapter,
  132 U.S. S. Ct. 2181 (2012), held that capped "not to exceed" agency appropriations in and after 1994 did not relieve the government of its contractual

obligation to pay full contract support costs to Indian Self-Determination Act contractors.

D. Congress wanted tribes to be able to control and operate their own programs and services under contract without diminishing the quantity or quality of the services. Contract support costs ensure that tribes and their organizations contracting under the Indian Self- Determination Act can operate their programs and services on parity with those operated by the Federal Government.

- E. In direct response to the *Ramah* decision, Congress has appropriated enough to pay full contract support costs. For fiscal years 2014, 2015 and 2016, the increased appropriations for the Department of the Interior and the Department of Health and Human Services for contract support cost payments to Tribes have totaled approximately \$740 million.
- F. The Final Settlement Agreement was filed with the Court on September 16, 2015 ("Ramah Settlement") and the Unopposed Motion for Matters including Payment Accounts for Class Members was filed on August 15, 2016. The Ramah Settlement provides the Navajo Nation with a settlement amount of \$58,413,809.36 as found in Exhibit "A" (Claim Form Amounts for Class Members), page 10, attached hereto.
- G. It is the intent of the Navajo Nation that the total amount of these moneys, \$58,413,809.36 plus any accrued interest or added amounts, be invested in a Public Safety System Fund and the income earned from that principal be used to supplement the improvement and expansion of the protections offered by the Navajo Nation's criminal justice system, including those services provided by the Navajo Nation Department of Public Safety, the Office of Navajo Public Defender, Judicial Branch offices, programs and courts, the Office of the Prosecutor, the Navajo Department of Health, and the Navajo Nation Division of Social Services, collectively referred to hereafter as the "Navajo Nation Public Safety System." It is also the intent of the Navajo Nation that a certain amount of the fund principal be made available for the Nation's response to events that constitute an emergency or a major disaster.

H. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 2501(A), Establishing the Navajo Nation Síhasin Fund, it states, "Additional deposits, when duly designated, may be made to the Fund from the net proceeds of settlement or judgment awards of other litigation brought against the United States concerning its failure to ensure that the Navajo Nation received all funds due and owing under the United States' trust obligations and fiduciary duties."

- I. The Navajo Nation Council hereby determines that the Ramah Settlement award to the Navajo Nation meets the criteria of 12 N.N.C. § 2501; however, the net proceeds from such settlement are eligible for deposit as designated as additional revenue to be deposited in the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund balance unless otherwise designated by the Navajo Nation Council pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(K).
- J. The following amendments to the Navajo Nation Code are in the best interest of the Nation and are consistent with the collective wishes expressed by members of the Navajo Nation. These amendments are intended to ensure that the proceeds from the Ramah Settlement are used to supplement the operating and capital budgets of the Navajo Nation Public Safety System as identified above.

### Section Three. Establishing the Navajo Nation Public Safety System Fund Act of 2016

- A. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(K), this Act clarifies and designates that the net proceeds received from the settlement of *Ramah Navajo Chapter et.al v. Jewell* (No. 1:90-CV-957-JAP/KBM) are additional revenues that shall not be deposited into the Nation's General Fund or Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB). The Navajo Nation designates the Ramah Settlement funds shall be deposited into the Navajo Nation Public Safety System Fund, as established, and managed and invested to provide for the support of the Navajo Nation Public Safety System and for the betterment and protection of the Navajo Nation and the Navajo People.
- B. Title 12 of the Navajo Nation Code is hereby amended as follows:

6	There is hereby established the "Navajo Nation Public Safety System Fund"
7	(hereinafter "Fund").
8	A. The Navajo Nation Council hereby designates the net proceeds and earning
9	received by the Navajo Nation through the settlement captioned Ramah Navajo
10	Chapter et.al v. Jewell (No. 1:90-CV-957-JAP/KBM) shall be deposited into the
11	Fund. Additional deposits, when duly designated, may be made to the Fund
12	from any future settlements in the Ramah Navajo Chapter et.al v. Jewell
13	litigation.
14	B. The Navajo Nation Council may make additional appropriations to the Fund
15	from any other sources of revenue that may become available to the Navajo
16	Nation.
17	C. Any money deposited in or appropriated to the Fund, regardless of source,
18	including Fund Income (defined below), shall be used only as provided in this
19	Chapter.
20	D. The fund shall be a continuing account and shall not lapse on an annual basis
21	pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(N).
22	E. Appropriations of Fund Interest Income made pursuant to an Expenditure Plan
23	shall continue and shall not lapse on an annual basis pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §
24	<u>820(N).</u>
25	<u>§ 2602. Purpose</u>
26	The purpose of this Fund is to provide a supplemental source of funds dedicated
27	<u>to:</u>
28	A. The operating and capital expenditures of the "Navajo Nation Public Safety
29	System" (defined to include the Navajo Nation Department of Public Safety; the
30	Office of Navajo Public Defender, Judicial Branch offices, programs and courts,

the Office of the Prosecutor, the Navajo Department of Health, and the Navajo 1 Nation Division of Social Services) in the areas of both recurring and non-2 recurring costs that will improve and expand the delivery of public safety 3 4 services focused on criminal justice to the Navajo People. B. Providing up to \$1.5 million of Fund Principal so that Navajo Nation Chapters, 5 Divisions, and Departments may begin immediate response and relief efforts 6 7 when affected by a major disaster or an emergency. Up to \$1.5 million of Fund Principal will be provided per occurrence and any expenditure of the \$1.5 8 9 million shall be reimbursed to the Fund Principal upon approval and receipt of Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") assistance. 10 C. The leveraging of the Fund by providing a source of repayment for bonds, 11 security for binds, loan guarantees, match funding, partial direct funding, and 12 other weighted uses of the Fund for purposes consistent with § 2602(A) of this 13 chapter. Proposed leveraged uses of the Fund shall be granted preference over 14 15 proposed direct funding uses. § 2603. Investment of the Fund 16 All moneys deposited in the Fund shall be invested as soon as practical in 17 accordance with the degree of care exercised by reasonable and prudent managers of 18 investments intended to produce maximum growth of the investments with a high 19 degree of safety; such investments shall be made under the direction of the Navajo 20 Nation Investment Committee. 21 § 2604. Definition of Fund Principal and Income 22 A. "Fund Principal" shall consist of the following: 23 1. All deposits made to the Fund pursuant to § 2601 of this Chapter. 24 2. Annual deposits of one-quarter (1/4) of the Fund Income from the preceding 25 fiscal year as calculated and reported pursuant to § 2606 of this chapter; such 26 deposits shall be made no later than 120 days after the end of each fiscal year. 27 B. "Fund Income" shall consist of all earnings (interest, dividends, etc.) generated 28 and realized by the Fund Principal in a given fiscal year. 29 30

### § 2605. Expenditure of the Fund

- A. The Fund Principal may be expended to cure default on a borrowing approved in the same manner as an Expenditure Plan for which the Fund Principal was pledged as security to fund a purpose consistent with § 2602 of this Chapter.
- B. Fund Interest shall be utilized to cover recurring expenditures. Fund Principal 5 shall be utilized to cover non-recurring expenditures pursuant to an Expenditure 6 Plan duly approved for purposes consistent with those set forth in § 2602 of this 7 Chapter. Provided, however, the total amount of expenditures authorized from 8 the combined Fund Interest and Fund Principal in any given fiscal year shall not 9 exceed three-quarters (3/4) of the Fund Interest earned in the preceding fiscal 10 year.
  - C. Expenditure Plans shall be adopted by a majority vote of the full Navajo Nation Council and signature of the President of the Navajo Nation before becoming effective. Expenditure Plans may extend over multiple years provided they do not exceed the expenditure limitations set forth in § 2605(B).
    - D. In the event a balance of Fund Income is not dedicated to an Expenditure Plan by the end of a fiscal year in which the Fund Income balance is available for appropriation, the undedicated Fund Income balance shall be added to the Fund Principal.
    - E. The Fund Principal shall be expended pursuant to § 2602(B) if authorized under emergency legislation of the Navajo Nation Council.

### **§2606.** Annual Audited Report

The Fund shall be audited annually as part of the Navajo Nation annual audit process, and the Controller will present a special report to the Budget and Finance Committee and Navajo Nation Council that will include an unaudited version of financial statements, including the Management Discussion and Analysis report and an investment report for the Fund by no later than December 31 of each fiscal year.

### §2607. Expenses

All expenses directly associated with the administration and management of the Fund shall be paid from the Fund Income as approved by the Naabik'íyáti'

Committee. Such expenses shall include investment advisory and management fees, audit costs and other related expenses; all pursuant to duly approved contracts for such services.

### §2608. Amendments

Any section(s) herein may be amended by a ninety-percent (90%) vote of the full membership of the Navajo Nation Council and signature of the President of the Navajo Nation.

### Section 3. Effective Date

This Act is effective upon its approval pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §221(B).

### Section 4. Codification

The provisions of this Act that amend or adopt new sections of the Navajo Nation Code shall be codified by the Office of Legislative Counsel. The Office of Legislative Counsel shall incorporate such amended provisions in the next codification of the Navajo Nation Code.

### Section 5. Saving Clause

Should any provisions of this Act be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation, without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those portions of this Act that are not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to Navajo Tribal Council Resolution CJ-20-55, the Ramah Navajo Chapter is a subdivision of the Navajo Nation and the Chapter Is uniquely situated as satellite community of the Navajo Nation; and
- 2. By Resolution CAP-34-98, the Navajo Nation Council enacted the Navajo Nation Local Governance Act codified as 26 NNC establishing a new title exclusively for political subdivisions of the Navajo Nation to address the governmental function of chapters that improves the governmental structure and provides the opportunity for local chapters to make decisions over local matters; and allowing communities to excel and flourish, enable Navajo leaders to lead toward a prosperous future and improve the strength and sovereignty of the Navajo Nation, including custom and tradition; and
- The Ramah Navajo Chapter et al. v. Jewell (No. 1:90-cv-957-JAP-KPM) is a class action Lawsuit against the U.S. Department for the under-payment of Contract Support Cost by the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA); and
- 4. In 2012, the United States Supreme Court in Salazar v, Ramah Navajo Chapter, 132 U.S. S. Ct.2181 (2010) held that capped "not to exceed" agency appropriations in and after 1994 did not relieve the government of its contractual obligation to pay full contract support costs to Indian Self-Determination Act contractor; and
- 5. The Final Settlement Agreement was filed with the Court on September 166, 2015 (Ramah Navajo Settlement) and the Unopposed Motion for Matters including Payment Accounts for Class Members was filed on August 15, 2016. The Ramah Settlement provides the Navajo Nation with a settlement amount of \$58,413,809.356; and
- 6. The purpose of the Fund is to provide a supplemental source of funds dedicated to the operating and capital expenditure of the "Navajo Nation Public Safety System"; the Office of Navajo Public Defender, Judicial Branch (offices, programs and courts); the Office of the Prosecutor, the Navajo Department of Health and the Navajo Division of Social Services) in the areas of Both recurring and nonrecurring cost that will improve and expand the delivery of public safety services focused on criminal justice to the Navajo People: and
  - The Navajo Nation has continued to recognize and support the Ramah Navajo Chapter as a unique satellite community with its own historical sub-governmental system and separate direct government relationship with the Department of the Interior, Southwest Region of the Bureau of Indian affairs and Indian Health Services with the Albuquerque Area and will be included in the purpose of the Funds: and

- It is in the best interest of the Ramah Navajos to support the overall intent of Navajo Nation Share of the Ramah Navajo Settlement Funds and recognizing the need for better protection of all Public Safety service providers that faces unknown situations across the Navajo Nation daily: and
- The Ramah Navajo Chapter acknowledges the same needs within the Ramah Navajo Community and supports 9 this much needed supplemental funds of the Ramah Navajo Settlement to be invested for the Navajo Nation Public Safety which also will benefit the Ramah Navajos Public Safety.

Dear Honorable Council Delegates:

We write to you to express our strong support for the establishment of a Public Safety System Fund with the balance of the \$58,413,809.36 Ramah Settlement Funds received by the Nation as part of the settlement' of Ramah Navajo Chapter et al. v. Jewell (No. 1:90-cv-As you are well aware, crime levels on the Nation 957-JAP-KPM). continue to rise, particularly in the area of violent crime. For example, over the Christmas holiday, there were two double homicides on the Navajo Nation in Tuba City and Shiprock. This level of violence at a time of year centered around family and festivities is absolutely but sadly has become the norm for our communities. shocking, Unfortunately our Public Safety System does not have the resources to adequately protect our Navajo People from the growing levels and occurrences of violence in our communities. Our officers, prosecutors, public defenders, courts, behavioral health providers, and victim services providers are desperately struggling to stretch their understaffed and under-funded teams to meet the tremendous needs of our community, but we simply do not have adequate manpower or resources. Meanwhile, violent offenders know the limitations of our system and commit their crimes ever more boldly knowing they likely will not be arrested, detained, prosecuted, or punished.

Indeed, the Nation currently faces a public safety crisis wherein our Public Safety System is unable to take on the most vicious monsters that plague our people: violence and substance abuse. While our ability to defend our people from those monsters is hindered, we are left with almost no capacity to address other important monsters, like For example, it has become a common occurrence for our elderly theft. to be robbed of their family heirloom jewelry collections, and for

family sheep, cattle, and horse herds to be stolen. Property crimes are the bane of economic development. For good reason, businesses are loathe to set up shop in an environment where property crimes go unenforced or unprosecuted. Additionally, business owners are unwilling to bring their families to or raise their families in an environment where they feel their families will be exposed to high levels of violence and disorder.

Given all of the above, we believe the Nation should take extraordinary measures to aggressively chip away at our Public Safety challenges. The situation will only get worse if we do not do something now. The *Ramah* Settlement funds provide a unique opportunity for the Navajo Nation Council to dedicate significant funds towards taking on the monsters that plague the safety and security of our people, and that hinder or scare away the economic development that we as a Nation, and our people as aspiring home-owners and job holders, so greatly need.

The other thing to keep in mind is that funding reductions to our already fragile Public Safety System are imminent from the impending closure of NGS and the soon-to-come policies of a federal administration intent on reducing the federal deficit and tax burdens. Unfortunately spending in Indian country is not an entitlement, so our Public Safety System is likely to be hit hard with spending reductions. It is thus critical that the Nation take bold steps to shield its Public Safety System from the effects of those imminent funding reductions. The establishment of a Public Safety System Fund will do just that.

As funding streams to our System deplete, this Fund will allow System participants-such as Navajo Division of Public Safety, Office of the Prosecutor, Office of the Public Defender, Judicial Branch, Department of Behavioral Health Services, and Division of Social Services-to tap into the Fund Income to cover shortfalls. Additionally, the Fund Income will allow surges of resources when System participants believe those surges are needed, such as the quick creation of new positions in Law Enforcement or the Prosecutor's Office. This will allow the Nation to fill gaps in our System that make us vulnerable to attack by the monsters we seek to destroy before they destroy us. It will also allow us to respond dynamically to shifts in crime levels. Principal will be available for much-needed one-time The Fund expenditures, such as bullet-proof vests, fire trucks, and other equipment. It is also possible that we can fund the staff housing that
