BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee serves as the oversight committee for the Office of Legislative Services. 2 N.N.C. §701(A)(5).
- B. The Budget Instruction Manual defines a budget reallocation as "the reallocation of funds between business units which requires oversight approval. Navajo Nation Budget Instruction Manual, FY 2020 XI.C.2.
- C. A standing committee may reallocate funds appropriated by the Navajo Nation Council to a division or program over which the committee has oversight. 2 N.N.C. §185(A).
- D. A reallocation of funds must be approved "by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the full membership of the committee, board or commission." 2 N.N.C. §185(A).

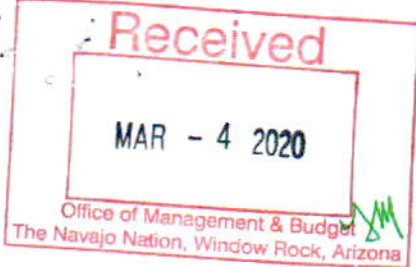
SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

3 101011. The Budget Revision Request is attached as **Exhibit A**.

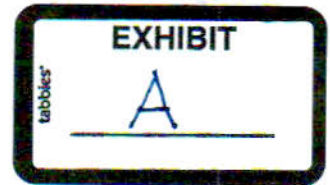
4 B. The budget reallocation is requested to provide additional travel funds for Navajo

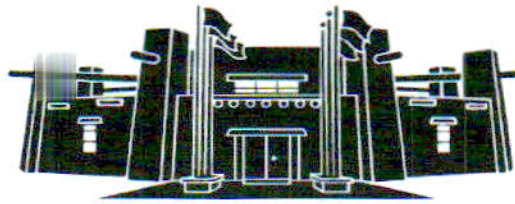
