DIRECTIVE INCLUDED IN COUNCIL RESOLUTION CD-72-17

The Navajo Nation Council approved Resolution CD-72-17 on December 22, 2017, to appropriate approximately \$2.4 million from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance to fund stipends for District Grazing Committees, Farm Boards, and the Eastern Navajo Land Board.

Also included was a directive issued by the Council to the Office of the Controller and the Office of Management and Budget to expedite the processing of the stipend payments and to issue retroactive stipends for the officials dating back to the start of Fiscal Year 2018, pending consideration of the resolution by the President.

Upon approval of the resolution, I respectfully ask your offices to adhere to the directive and begin processing the stipend payments immediately, both current and retroactive. RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

23RD NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL -- Third Year, 2017

AN ACTION

RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE, BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,452,257.00 FOR STIPENDS FOR DISTRICT GRAZING COMMITTEE, EASTERN NAVAJO LAND BOARD, MAJOR IRRIGATION FARM BOARD

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITIES

- A. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), "[t]he Navajo Nation Council may adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in excess of the reserve amount set forth at § 820(J)."
- B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(9), a proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee before it is heard by the Navajo Nation Council.
- C. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 300 (C)(1)(3) and (4) the Budget and Finance Committee is authorized to recommend adoption of resolutions related to the expenditure of the Nation's financial resources.
- D. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 501 (C)(1), the Resources and Development Committee is the oversight committee for District Grazing Officers, Eastern Navajo Land Board, and Farm Boards.

SECTION TWO. TITLE 12 FINANCE ACT SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION PROCESS

- A. The Title 12 Finance Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:
 - Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(L), when the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections,

- supplemental appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council.
- 2. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), "Supplemental appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall only be made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at § 820 (F). The Controller of the Navajo Nation shall be responsible for designating recurring and non-recurring revenues and purposes."
- 3. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), all requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for budget impact analysis.

SECTION THREE. FINDINGS

- A. A request for supplemental funding has been submitted for the District Grazing Committee, the Eastern Navajo Land Board, and the Major Irrigation Farm Board totaling of \$2,452,257.00
- B. The Office of Management and Budget memorandum, with regard to this supplemental request for appropriation dated October 26, 2017, is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- C. The Office of the Controller has identified the additional revenues. See attached memorandum, **Exhibit B**, dated September 8, 2017.
- D. The Office of the Controller has not designated whether this legislation concerns "recurring and non-recurring revenues and purposes," pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L).
- E. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest to approve a Supplemental Appropriation for \$2,452,257.00 for stipends for the District Grazing Committee, Eastern Navajo Land Board, and Major Irrigation Farm Board.

APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE SECTION FOUR. AMOUNT OF UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE \$2,452,257.00 FOR STIPENDS FOR THE DISTRICT GRAZING COMMITTEE, EASTERN NAVAJO LAND BOARD AND MAJOR IRRIGATION FARM BOARD

A. The Navajo Nation Council, having received certification by the Office of the Controller of the availability of certain funds from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB) for supplemental appropriation, hereby approves the supplemental appropriation of \$2,452,257.00 for stipends for the Division of Natural Resources, District Grazing Committee, Eastern Navajo Land Board, and Major Irrigation

Farm Board as further described in budget documents attached as **Exhibit C**.

B. This supplemental appropriation of \$2,452,257.00 shall be from that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the UUFB, shall be effective October 1, 2017 for FY 2018.

Review of CORRECTED Budgets for Elected Officials (District Grazing Committee, Farm

Board, and Land Board) in the total amount of \$2,452,257 from the UUFB.

1. Per your request, OMB re-reviewed the attached corrected budgets and our comments follow.

2. The proposals seek funds from the Undesignated, Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB) as follows:

- a. Business Unit no. 115002, District Grazing Committee for \$1,712,214.
- b. Business Unit no. 115005, Eastern Navajo Land Board for \$482,992.
- c. Business Unit no. 115007, Major Irrigation Farm Board for \$257,051.
- 3. The budgets were corrected to reflect compliance with the 2011 IRS agreement, in consultation with the Department of Justice and Office of the Controller. However, DOJ and OOC should be given the opportunity to review this supplemental package in accordance with the Executive Branch Executive Order No. 07-2013; Executive Branch 164 review process. This is the proper protocol.
- 4. A completed Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary form, shown in Appendix K, of the FY 2018 Budget Instructions Manual, is still not included. This form needs to be completed and included with each budget package.
- 5. OMB is aware legislation no. 0430-17 was recently introduced, and \$1,250,000 is being requested for the DNR elected officials through this legislation. No budget has been submitted to OMB to date for review. The two competing proposals should be coordinated by the sponsors.
- 6. The Navajo Nation approved the Fiscal Year 2018 budget legislation, CS-53-17, and directed the Branch Chiefs of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches to prioritize the unmet needs of their respective branches and to prepare appropriate budgets for such prioritized needs for potential consideration of supplemental appropriations in Fiscal Year 2018 in accordance with 12 NNC Section 820 (L). Only the Judicial Branch has done so with the prioritized list attached as Exhibit L to the budget legislation.
- 7. Further, by now there are about 50 proposals totaling more than \$50 million. Priorities must be set to guide appropriations.

SUBJECT: Review of Budgets for Elected Officials (District Grazing Committee, Farm Board, and Land

Board) in the total amount of \$2,362,409.00 from the UUFB.

1. Per your request, OMB reviewed the attached budgets and our comments follow. However this is not a Budget Impact Analysis as required by the Appropriations Act at 12 NNC Section 820 (B).

2. The proposals would seek funds from the Undesignated, Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB) as follows:

- a. Business Unit no. 115002, District Grazing Committee for \$1,654,007.
- b. Business Unit no. 115005, Eastern Navajo Land Board for \$464,187.
- c. Business Unit no. 115007, Major Irrigation Farm Board for \$244,215.
- 3. OMB consulted with the Department of Justice and Office of the Controller and in order to comply with the 2011 IRS agreement, all stipends are to be budgeted under the 2001 object code series, personnel expenses. Further, in accordance with the IRS agreement, all stipends (payments) will be assessed taxes using fringe rate of 9.95%. As a result, the budgets need to be re-done to include additional cost for fringe on all stipends. See attached marked up budgets, and worksheet comparing the initial amounts to the corrected amounts.
- 4. The division and program have been contacted to submit corrected budgets. However, corrected budgets have not been submitted to-date. The budgets should be corrected prior to introduction of legislation to fund the proposal.
- 5. The referenced elected officials are under the Executive Branch/Division of Natural Resources and therefore should follow Executive Order No. 07-2013; the Executive Branch 164 review process.
- 6. A completed Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary form, shown in Appendix K, of the FY 2018 Budget Instructions Manual, is not included. This form needs to be completed and included with each budget package.
- 7. The Navajo Nation approved the Fiscal Year 2018 budget legislation, CS-53-17, and directed the Branch Chiefs of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches to prioritize the unmet needs of their respective branches and to prepare appropriate budgets for such prioritized needs for potential consideration of supplemental appropriations in Fiscal Year 2018 in accordance with 12 NNC Section 820 (L). Only the Judicial Branch has done so with the prioritized list attached as Exhibit L to the budget legislation.

Subject:

Financial Update-(General Fund Revenue, Expenditures, UUFB)

The gross General Fund Revenues, (see Exhibit "A"), as of August 31, 2017 is \$203,053,235, (see Footnote 1). The total General Fund set asides is \$ \$51,749,599 (Footnote 2). The Net Revenue for the General Fund is \$151,303,727 (see Footnote 3). The permanent fund income transfer is \$24,411,000 (Footnote 4). The reserve taken for the permanent fund income transfer is \$2,885,000 (Footnote 5). The grand total revenue for the General Fund is \$172,829,727 (see Footnote 6) which is 98.78% of the projection.

Next, are the total expenditures by Branch, (see Exhibit "B"), as of August 31, 2017, the Legislative Branch has expenditures of \$14,836,331 (see Footnote 1a); encumbrances of \$822,493 (see Footnote 1b) with a remaining budget of \$3,307,669 (see Footnote 1c). The Executive Branch expenditures are \$162,500,722 (see Footnote 2a); encumbrances are \$7,206,122 (see Footnote 2b) with a remaining budget of \$37,797,219 (see Footnote 2c). The Judicial Branch expenditures are \$11,718,156 (see Footnote 3a); with encumbrances of \$73,692 (see Footnote 3b) and remaining budget of \$2,356,349 (see Footnote 3c). Total General Fund expenditures are \$189,055,209 (see Footnote 4a); total encumbrances are \$8,102,307 (see Footnote 4b) with an overall remaining budget of \$43,461,236 (see Footnote 4c).

The updated Undesignated Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB), (see Exhibit "C") as of September 8, 2017 is \$31,258,217. The Fiscal Year 2016 audited numbers were approved via CJY-51-17 and an amount of \$11, 728,198 that was previously reserved for debt service for capital projects was returned back to the UUFB with the approval of CJY-50-17. These two amounts have been incorporated into this new schedule.

SUPPORTING THEIR REQUEST FOR A BUDGET INCREASE FROM THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL, THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT AND THE NAA'BIK'YATI COMMITTEE AND RECOMMENDS THER APPROVAL TO INCREASE FUNDING FOR SEVENTY-EIGHT DISTRICT GRAZING COMMITTEES, FOURTY-THREE FARM BOARDS, AND EASTERN LAND BOARD FROM APPROPRIATE FUNDS ACCORDING TO THE LAWS OF THE NAVAJO NATION AND BE IT RETRO OCTOBER 1, 2016.

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 3 N.N.C., §871884, the District Grazing Committee have authority to oversee grazing activities on the Navajo Nation and protect Grazing Permit Holders' Customary Use Rights, including Range Management Units, forage and its natural habitats; and
- 2. The District Grazing Committee supports their constituents and chapter membership to pursue business/economic development opportunities in creating an established business & sign homesite lease with caution for our expanding community; and
- 3. The District Grazing Committee acknowledges and support the Farm Board and Eastern Land Board do not get adequate funding for travel allowances, supplies, and lack of enforcement which has had an adverse effect on the Navajo Nation elected officials to provide direct services to the grass root/Navajo people: and
- 4. The District Grazing Committee and Farm Board get added responsibility without funds attached and do request your support and approval for these funds to be in compliance with their Tour of Duties, and
- 5. The District Grazing Committee, Farm Board and Land Board weren't funded for the month of October 2016 due to a Dept. of Agriculture's letter/legislation mishap jump started FY2016 from November and the Officials Retro for that month for services rendered; and
- 6. The District Grazing Committee, Farm Board, Eastern Land Board, after careful consideration and discussion has determine that it's in the best interest of the membership to request increased funding to efficiently performs their duties for direct services to its constituents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The District Grazing Committee hereby recommends the support of the Navajo Nation Council, The Office of the President and Vice President and the Naa'bik'yati committee in approving increased funding for Seventy-Eight District Grazing Committees, Forty-Three Farm Boards, and Land Board to execute direct services to their constituents in meetings from appropriate funding source according to the laws of the Navajo Nation and be it retro October 1, 2016.
