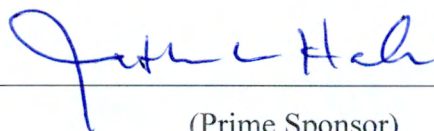

BE IT ENACTED:

**Section One. Authority**

- A. The Navajo Nation established the Health, Education and Human Services Committee as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such gave the Committee oversight to oversee all health and social services related activities of the Navajo Nation and its tribal organizations, enterprises, relating to the delivery of health, environmental health and social services including research, planning and prevention. 2 N.N.C. §§ 400(A), 401(C)(2).
- B. The Navajo Nation established the Budget and Finance Committee (BFC) as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such empowered BFC to

1 review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting and  
2 management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. §§ 300 (A), 301 (B)(2).

3 C. The Navajo Nation Council established the Naabik`íyáti` Committee as a Navajo  
4 Nation standing committee and as such proposed legislation that requires final  
5 action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik`íyáti`  
6 Committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 700 (A).

7 D. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §  
8 102 (A).

9 E. The Title 12 Appropriations Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:

- 10 1. When the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and  
11 beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental  
12 appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. §  
13 820(L).
- 14 2. Supplemental appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall only be  
15 made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at § 820(F). The  
16 Controller of the Navajo Nation shall be responsible for designating recurring  
17 and non-recurring revenues. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
- 18 3. All requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be  
19 submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for budget impact  
20 analysis. 12 N.N.C. § 820(M).

## 21 22 **Section Two. Findings**

23 A. Ama Doo Alchini Bighan, Inc. (ADABI) is a private, non-profit, community  
24 based domestic violence and sexual assault crisis intervention, advocacy,  
25 prevention, and safe home network program. ADABI serves victims of intimate  
26 partner violence in the Chinle Agency of the Navajo Nation. [www.azdhs.gov](http://www.azdhs.gov)

27 B. This is a funding request will allow ADABI to increase safety provisions for  
28 victims by providing shelter/safe home and crisis intervention of domestic  
29 violence and sexual assault rape victims in the Chinle area.

30 C. The supplemental funding request forms are attached as **Exhibit A**.

- 1 D. The Office of Management and Budget is aware of the supplemental funding request  
2 and has been asked to provide a budget impact analysis pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §  
3 820(M).
- 4 E. The Office of the Controller is aware of the supplemental funding request and has  
5 been asked to provide a memorandum indicating the balance in the Unreserved,  
6 Undesignated Fund Balance as of December, 2018. This memorandum will meet the  
7 requirements of 12 N.N.C, 820 (L); however, the Controller of the Navajo Nation  
8 should designate the funds at recurring or non-recurring.
- 9 F. The request for funds must meet the grant budget requirements of 1) an approved  
10 plan of operation, 2) budget request must be part of a recommended division or  
11 branch budget, 3) the respective oversight [committee] of the division or branch  
12 must recommend the request; in addition the request shall be submitted to the  
13 Office of Management and Budget on appropriate budget forms. See Fiscal Year  
14 2019 Budget Instruction Manual, Section XI(B).
- 15 G. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest of the Navajo citizens who are in  
16 need of shelter and safe homes as a result of domestic violence and sexual assault  
17 situations to approve this supplemental appropriation request.

18  
19 **Section Three. Approving the Supplemental Appropriation from the Unreserved,**  
20 **Undesignated Fund Balance in the Amount of \$313,190 for Ama Doo Alchini**  
21 **Bighan, Inc.**

- 22 A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the supplemental appropriation from the  
23 Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance to Ama Doo Alchini Bighan, Inc.,  
24 Business Unit #NEW for \$313,190 to continue to provide shelter and safe homes  
25 for domestic violence and sexual assault victims.
- 26 B. This supplemental appropriation of \$313,190 shall be from that amount of funds  
27 that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund  
28 Balance as determined by the Office of the Controller and to Ama Doo Alchini  
29 Bighan, Inc., Business Unit #NEW.

2 The provisions of this Act shall become effective in accord with 2 N.N.C. § 221(B).
