21	A. Recon Oil Company has submitted a request for the removal of approximately	
22	5,000 cubic yards of sand and gravel material from Section 17 T29N, R27E in	
23	Apache County. See attached Exhibit "A."	
24	B. Exhibit "A" contains an aerial photograph of the proposed site from which the	
25	sand and gravel will be obtained.	
26	C. A letter dated October 16, 2015 from Hubert Dazie addressed to Nazlini Chapter	
27	asking to "utilize the dirt dug out by the s[e]wer pond for fill dirt that is need[ed]	
28	around the Navajo Nation." At the end of the letter the words "Nazlini Chapter	
29	Approval" are typed with a signature line which is signed by "Judy Donaldson,	
30	10-16-15." This letter is attached as attached in Exhibit "B."

A memorandum dated November 13, 2015 from Howard Draper, Program/Project Specialist, Navajo Land Department Project Review Section to Mr. Akhtar Zaman, Program Director, Minerals Department in reference to the location of the site of the proposed sand and gravel site is attached as Exhibit "C."
- E. The Terms and Conditions for Utilization of Sand and Gravel Material for Recon Oil Company from the Vicinity of a Sewer Lagoon in Nazlini Chapter, Arizona ("Terms and Conditions") is attached as Exhibit "D." The Terms and Conditions, Exhibit "D" does not contain a legal description of the proposed site; however the site is described in the heading of the Terms and Conditions as "FROM THE VICINITY OF A SEWER LAGOON IN NAZLINI CHAPTER, ARIZONA."

Section Three. Approval

- A. 

Our office received 164 Document Number 005016 dated 11/10/2015 during the week of November 9, 2015 and sponsor from Mr. Ram S. Das, Mining Engineer, with the Navajo Nation Minerals Department. There is no survey map or legal description attached to the Doc. No. 5016 package except an aerial photo labeled "Chinle" and entitled "Township & Range for Nazilini." In addition there are written descriptions for a stock pile [130' feet long x 40' wide x 18' high."], but no survey map or drawn sketch showing the stock pile in relation to the (existing?) Chapter sewer lagoon.

There is mention of "...take some dirt around the Nazlini Chapter sewer lagoon. ..." (see Recon letter dated 11/04/2015) and "...utilize the dirt dug out by the sewer pond for fill dirt that is need around the Navajo Nation. .." (see Recon letter dated October 16, 2015). Due to the aerial scale of the attached photo labeled "Township & Range for Nazilini" I cannot determine if the dirt (pile?) is actually located within the Nazlini Chapter sewer lagoon *tract boundary*.

More detailed clarification of whether the existing dirt (pile?) described as 130' feet long x 40' wide x 18' high is actually inside the existing (valid?) Nazlini sewer lagoon tract boundary (map would be very helpful) would help our office/program to make a more accurate and definitive decision of sufficient or insufficient.

Mr. Bruce Nickelson (Recon company?) hand-carried several photographs showing more detailed of the affected areas including the fence and dirt pile on 11/12/15. The photographs show an existing dirt pile (extracted material) which I assume is the material to be used. It appears to be in the immediate vicinity of the fenced Nazlini Chapter sewer lagoon tract but I cannot definitively determine if it is inside the fenced Nazlini Chapter sewer lagoon tract boundary.

The decision to sign will be up to Mr. W. Mike Halona, Department Manager III, with Navajo Land Department (NLD) but this Doc. No. 5016 can be forward to other departments in the meantime. TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR UTILIZATION OF SAND AND GRAVEL MATERIAL FOR RECON OIL COMPANY (RECON) FROM THE VICINITY OF A SEWER LAGOON IN NAZLINI CHAPTER, ARIZONA

- 1. The term of this permit is valid for six (6) months from the date approval of the permit by the Navajo Nation.
- 2. The maximum quality of material that can be removed shall not exceed 5,000 cubic yards.
- 3. A lump sum payment of \$7,284.00 shall be made to the Navajo Nation within ten (10) days of approval of the permit by the Navajo Nation.
- 4. Recon shall not damage the sewer lagoon by its activities in the vicinity of the lagoon.
- 5. No excavation of sand and gravel is allowed by this permit. The activities shall be limited to the removal of material from the stockpile.
- 6. Recon shall ensure that the air quality of the Navajo Nation is not unduly degraded during operations by violating federal and Nation's applicable laws and regulations.
- 7. Recon shall obtain prior written permission to cross an existing permit or lease areas, if any, from the appropriate parties.
- 8. Recon shall be responsible for and promptly pay all damages when they are sustained, from actions the Lessee causes.
- 9. Recon shall indemnify and hold harmless the Navajo Nation and the Secretary of the Interior and their respective authorized agents, employees, land users and occupants against any liability for loss of life, personal injury and property damages arising from the development, use or occupancy or use of area from where the material is removed.
- 10. Any action or proceeding brought by Recon against the Navajo Nation in connection with or arising out of the terms and conditions of the permit shall be brought only in the Courts of the Navajo Nation, and no such action or proceeding shall be brought by Recon against the Navajo Nation in any court of any state.

- 11. Nothing contained herein shall be interpreted as constituting a waiver, express or implied, of the sovereign immunity of the Navajo Nation.
- 12. The Navajo Nation shall govern the performance and enforcement of the terms and conditions contained herein.

Navajo Nation Environmental Protection Agency (NNEPA) reviewed and recommends conditional approval for the proposed stockpile removal.


The proposed action is required to meet the following and attain each required permit before commencing any operation activities.


- 1. Navajo Nation Air Pollution Prevention and Control Act:





After presentation of by the Sponsor, Agent and Mineral Department, Pro Temp Chairperson stated after learning from the presenters that the Recon Oil Company has used Navajo Nation natural resource (gravel) without receiving approval from the Resources and Development Committee, the Committee finds itself in an awkward situation with respect to this legislation. He stated that he doesn't appreciate the arrogance and disrespect of tribal laws by the company and that such activities need to stop.

The Committee issued directives: (1) for NNDOJ and OLC to provide an update report on the sensitive issues discussed in the executive session; (2) To receive reports from the Rose Construction Company (which allegedly said that Recon Oil Company had given its permission to haul away gravel from the Nazlini Sewer Lagoon), NNDOJ, the Minerals Department relating to the removal of materials without proper permits and recommendations to be considered by the Committee, NNDOJ and The Minerals Department if in fact this occurred; (3) For the Division of Economic Development to provide a report on when the Recon Oil Company was certified as a General Contractor to conduct road construction.

Thereafter, the Committee **TABLED** the legislation for two weeks.

Litigation Status of NN Div. of Natural Res. v. Recon Oil Co., Inc.

(No. OHA-DNR-001-16)

On April 15, 2016, the Navajo Nation Division of Natural Resources issued a Notice of Trespass and Order to Comply to Recon Oil Co., Inc. ("Recon") pursuant to the Navajo

Nation Civil Trespass Act.¹ On April 22, 2016, the Navajo Nation Division of Natural Resources issued a Civil Trespass Assessment to Recon for the trespass violation in the amount of \$50,000. Recon subsequently appealed the Notice of Trespass to the Office of Hearings and Appeals ("OHA").

A central issue of the litigation is the Executive Order issued by former President Ben Shelly on May 7, 2015 (the "Executive Order"), which purported to authorize Recon access to material at the site in question. OHA held an expedited hearing on the validity of the Executive Order, which resulted in OHA declaring the Executive Order invalid.

At this time, the litigation is still pending and the associated civil assessment has not been paid. In addition to litigation the parties have been involved in settlement negotiations. Included in the settlement discussions are terms and conditions to a sand and gravel lease.

The site at issue in the trespass litigation is the same site identified in proposed Resources and Development Committee Resolution No. 0194-16. As mentioned above, the settlement negotiations address both the trespass, and the appropriate terms and conditions for a lease for future extraction of sand and gravel. The Division of Natural Resources has determined that it is not prudent to release terms and conditions at this time due to the ongoing settlement negotiations that address this issue. Please note that whatever terms and conditions are agreed to as part of the settlement will be brought to RDC for approval.
