TITLE OF RESOLUTION: PROPOSED NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL RESOLUTION; AN ACTION RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE, BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$43,766.00 FOR TRANSPORT AND SET UP OF MODULAR BUILDING INCLUDING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FOUNDATION, BATHROOM FACILITIES, AND INSTALLATION OF PLUMBING AND ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT FOR TSAYATOH CHAPTER; WAIVING 12 N.N.C. § 820(I) AND 860(C) RELATING TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS

**PURPOSE:** This resolution, if approved, will approve supplemental funding from the unreserved, undesignated fund balance (UUFB) in the amount of \$43,766.00 for the transport and set up of a modular building including the construction of a foundation, bathroom facilities, and installation of plumbing and electrical equipment for the Tsayatoh Chapter and waiving 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) and 860(C). The modular building is a former Church Rock Elementary School portable classroom and the modular building will be used for the Tsayatoh Chapter Veterans Organization and a community computer laboratory building.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committee. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each committee member to review the proposed resolution in detail.

22	SECTION 1. FINDINGS
23	A. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), "[t]he Navajo Nation Council may adopt and
24	approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during
25	the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current
26	fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and
27	beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in
28	excess of the reserve amount set forth at § 820(J)."

- B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(9), a proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee before it is heard by the Navajo Nation Council.
- C. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 300 (C)(1)(3) and (4) the Budget and Finance Committee is authorized to recommend adoption of resolutions related to the expenditure of the Nation's financial resources.
- D. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 501 (C)(1), the Resources and Development Committee is the oversight committee for Chapters.
- E. The Title 12 Finance Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:
  - 1. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), all requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for budget impact analysis. On December 1, 2015, the Office of Management and Budget presented its memorandum with regard to this supplemental request for appropriation. The memorandum is attached as **Exhibit A**.
  - 2. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(L), when the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council. The attached memorandum, Exhibit B, dated December 29, 2015 from the Office of the Controller has identified the additional revenues.
- F. The Title 12 Capital Improvement Process includes:
  - 1. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 810(F), "Capital Improvement" means a major project undertaken by the Navajo Nation that is generally not recurring on an annual basis and which fits within one or more of the following categories:
    - (1) All projects requiring debt obligation or borrowing;
    - (2) Any acquisition or lease of land;

- (3) Purchase of major equipment or vehicles, with a life expectancy of five years or more, valued in excess of an amount to be established by the Controller;
- (4) Major building improvements that are not routine maintenance expenses and that substantially enhance the value or extend the useful life of a structure;
- (5) Construction of new buildings or facilities including engineering, design, and other pre-construction costs with an estimated cost in excess of an amount to be determined by the Controller; and/or
- (6) Major equipment or furnishing required to furnish new buildings or other projects, the cost of which is above a certain amount to be established by the Controller.
- 2. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (I), the "[d]evelopment of the Capital Budget shall be coordinated with development of the Operating Budget. All budget requests for capital improvements shall be in compliance with an adopted Capital Improvement Plan and shall not be approved unless in compliance with the Plan."
- 3. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (M), the Office of Management and Budget shall coordinate the overall preparation, adoption and implementation of both the annual operating and capital budgets of the Navajo Nation. All requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget for budget impact analysis and other appropriate action.
- 4. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 501 (B)(4)(c), the Resources and Development Committee is to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council through the appropriate process supplemental appropriations to the capital improvement projects annual budget to fund necessary additional capital improvement projects.
- 5. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 860 (C)(2) "[t]he appropriation portion of the Capital Improvement Plan is subject to approval of the Navajo Nation

Council upon recommendation of the Budget and Finance Committee. Any modification or amendment affecting the approved Capital Improvement Plan is subject to review and concurrence by the Resources and Development Committee prior to consideration by the Navajo Nation Council."

- G. A Statement Requesting Supplemental Funding for Transport and Set Up of Modular Building has been submitted by the Tsayatoh Chapter. The modular building is a former Church Rock Elementary School portable classroom. The modular building will be used for the Tsayatoh Chapter Veterans Organization and a community computer laboratory building. A copy of the Statement of Request is attached as **Exhibit C** and includes an Executive Summary, Proposed Overall Budget, Supporting Resolutions, and the Gallup McKinley County School Release Document. The Navajo Nation Program Budget Summary, Program Performance Criteria and Detailed Line Item Budget and Justification are attached as **Exhibit D**.
- H. The transport and set up of a modular building including the construction of a foundation, bathroom facilities, and installation of plumbing and electrical equipment for the Tsayatoh Chapter is not included in the Title 12 Capital Improvement Plan as approved by Navajo Nation Council Resolution CAP-18-14.
- I. Any modification or amendment affecting the approved Capital Improvement Plan is subject to review and concurrence by the Resources and Development Committee prior to consideration by the Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. § 860.
- J. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest to waive 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) and 860 (C) regarding the Capital Improvement for the transport and set up of a modular building including the construction of a foundation, bathroom facilities, and installation of plumbing and electrical equipment for the Tsayatoh Chapter.
- K. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest to approve Supplemental Appropriation for the Tsayatoh Chapter Modular Building Transportation and Set Up Project.

# SECTION 2. WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) 1 AND 860 (C) REGARDING THE TSAYATOH CHAPTER MODULAR BUILDING TRANSPORTATION AND SET UP PROJECT

The Navajo Nation Council hereby waives 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) and 860(C) with regard to the transport and set up of a modular building including the construction of a foundation, bathroom facilities, and installation of plumbing and electrical equipment for the Tsayatoh Chapter.

SECTION 3. APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$43,766.00 FOR TRANSPORT AND SET UP OF A MODULAR BUILDING INCLUDING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FOUNDATION, BATHROOM FACILITIES, AND INSTALLATION OF PLUMBING AND ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT FOR TSAYATOH CHAPTER

- A. The Navajo Nation Council, having received certification by the Office of the Controller of the availability of certain funds from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB) for supplemental appropriation hereby approves the supplemental appropriation of \$43,766.00 for the transport and set up of a modular building including the construction of a foundation, bathroom facilities, and installation of plumbing and electrical equipment for the Tsayatoh Chapter as further described in budget documents attached as **Exhibit D**.
- B. This supplemental appropriation of \$43,766.00 shall be to a new Business Unit Number and from that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the UUFB.

Proposal

The Office of Management and Budget has reviewed the above referenced document. Upon review of the proposed supplemental funding proposal, OMB notes the following:

- 1. The Tsayatoh Chapter is requesting \$43,765.81 from the UUFB for a modular building transport and set-up. The total cost is \$48,765.81 with \$5,000 being contributed by the Chapter.
- 2. The Office of the Controller says the UUFB has an amount of \$14,400,000 available. OMB recently compiled the Fiscal Year 2015 unmet needs list which was submitted by the oversight committees but Tsayatoh Chapter is not on the list. There were over a \$100,000,000 in unmet needs request which need to be considered for funding from the UUFB or other sources. All the oversight committees submitted unmet needs. Those should be considered before other requests.

OMB recommends that the above mentioned findings be addressed before final approval of the budget. If you have any questions, contact Raquel Tenille, Senior Budget Analyst at (928) 871-6575.

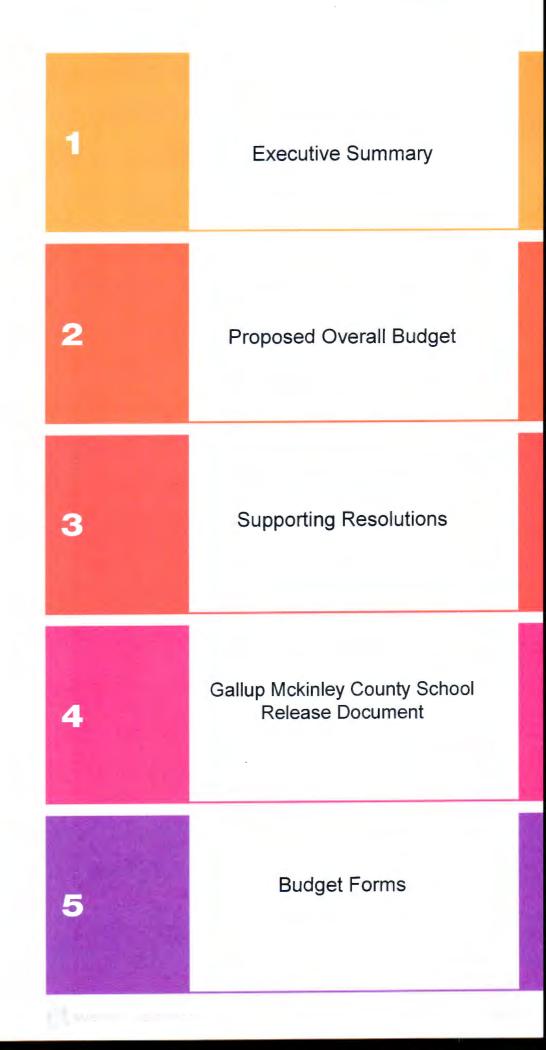

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The Objective of the Tsayatoh Chapter Veterans Organization and Tsayatoh Community Youth are substantial and pursue the common initiative to share innovative solutions to age old issues. These issues are the absence of a perpetual location to address the necessities of the Veterans Organization operation and community youth opportunities to access technology. The Tsayatoh Community supports establishing the Tsayatoh Veterans Center as a flexible multiple use building that brings together office, civic, and technology with a primary focus on Veterans Administrative activities. A Veterans Administrative Building will established the "heart" and focal point, and when considered as a whole, will provide a venue unique to meeting the Administrative needs to the Veterans and Technical experience of technology access for the youth in the community.

The Tsayatoh Veterans Organization is focused on delivering sustainable solutions to provide services or activities which may include, but not limited to program/project development, community/economic development, housing, training and employment opportunities, leveraging or matching funds as Veteran Support Services become available.

The Tsayatoh Chapter Veterans Organization believe in the power of connections and understand that vastly different organization's share goals and visions that lead to successful partnerships. The Veterans Organization is creating opportunities for the community of Tsayatoh to share their effective practices, promising ideas, and solutions to the toughest challenges. There is a need for extending a better understand the role of the youth in the community development process. If youth are included in programs to meet needs and empower communities, they can become lifelong participants and take on a sense of ownership in Chapter improvements and development efforts.

One of the solutions is the recognition the youth of Tsayatoh community are viewed as valued resource and partners in the community. Our youth respond to their respected status by acknowledgement from Community Leaders and Community Organizations which allow our children to devoting their tremendous energy and focus to the pursuit of social and economic justice.

The Tsayatoh Veterans acknowledge the investment in their youth, therefore; the Veterans have express the need for an Administrative Meeting location which they have categorized implementation of a joint use Modular Building designed to accommodate a community Youth Computer Lab. The establishment of the Tsayatoh Chapter Veterans Organization and Youth Computer Lab are based on the Support & the Need identified by the Tsayatoh Community during a Regular Chapter Meeting Resolution No. TSA 2015-06-04.

Among the leading obstacles is not being asked or not being assigned to an identifiable role to the extent to which youth can contribute to the decision making process of organizations and play an active role in the Chapter program development.

An understanding of youth motivations and efficiency to this kind of engagement are important. Allowing the Technical capacity of Internet to our youth can maximize these valuable resources leading to skill enhancement, confidence building, and ownership that prepare them as they navigate toward adulthood.

This initiative unleashed the potential of the Tsayatoh Youth and Adults to engage together in creating a just and equitable society. An environment that will build new relationships and guide youth and adults to work effectively as equal partners to share discoveries and new practices in a more holistic approach to achieve program goals.

Increasing overall resources. The more resources the Tsayatoh Community has, the more power to getting the Modular Administrative Building occupancy accomplished. It is essential in requesting the Legislative and Executive Branches of the Navajo Nation Supplemental Funding assistance in the amount of \$43,766.00, obviously, a major resource which allows access to what we need in moving closer to meeting the goals to put our plan in motion.

To help build community support, the Tsayatoh Veterans Organization worked in partnership with the Gallup McKinley County Schools to secure the Module Building for a total cost of \$1.00, a partnership that will grow stronger and more of a stake in seeing the Tsayatoh Community succeed. We are not only getting good will in the bargain, but also develop new allies for future projects.

In planning an Administrative Building, our Veterans Organization has also acquired the support of Tsayatoh Chapter. As in any request for supplemental funding from public funders that may require matching funds from the community, the Tsayatoh Chapter sources in the amount of \$5,000.00 to be invested into the Veterans Administrative Building. In this way, both Navajo Nation supplemental resources and overall community support can grow.

In conclusion, the Tsayatoh Veterans Organization is in need of a meeting conference room and acknowledge the lack of affording the Youth of the Tsayatoh Community technological services. These Issues can be addressed by implementing the Veterans Administrative Building facility joint use as a Youth Computer Lab will achieve these goals & objectives.

We have Strength entrusted to implement this business plan to unleash the potential and encourage youth civil engagement at the Chapter Administrative level. As our communities moves in the 21 century we are on a quest for a solution to the existing outdated facilities, but implementing the future technological systems as well. The Interaction between our Chapter Officials, Chapter Committee Representatives and our youth promotes awareness of needs and helps identify a variety of motivations that shape civic behavior.

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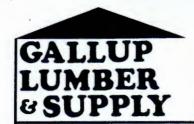

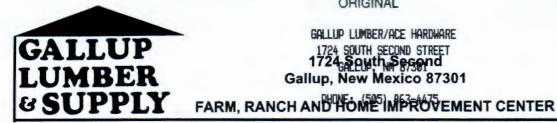
