2. On page 2, starting at line 15, add the following:

SECTION FOUR. RECOMMENDING A WAIVER OF RESOLUTION NO. CF-07-11

The Budget and Finance Committee hereby recommends to the Navajo Nation Council a waiver of Resolution No. CF-07-11, which established a moratorium on any future proposed Budget Revisions and/or Reallocations from the General Funds Personnel Accounts Savings (now known as "Personnel Lapse Fund") and required those Savings go to an annual General Wage Adjustment, step increase and other salary adjustments to the Pay Plan; in addition, that any excess or surplus funds shall be deposited to the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB). The Budget and Finance Committee further recommends that the Navajo Nation Council allow use of the Personnel Lapse Fund Savings for purposes other than those identified in CF-07-11.
