Dear Speaker Damon,

We have continuously supported our law enforcement services by working to protect them during the past pandemic year and advocating for increased services and funding at the federal level. We appreciate the Navajo Nation Council's support for the Criminal Investigation section of the Public Safety Department. We are all aware of the funding needs of our overall public safety services and the need for more patrol officers, criminal investigators, detention officers, dispatchers, emergency medical services, and support staff.

The Navajo Nation has assumed the public safety services from the federal government and along with those services comes the funds to support such services. We can all agree the federal funding is not adequate to support the full needs of our public safety services. There is an opportunity to address this matter through the anticipated American Rescue Plan Act funds. In addition to the anticipated funds we can work together with the Navajo Nation Council to continue advocating for proper funding to support law enforcement for the Navajo Nation.

We will support additional funding for law enforcement using Navajo general funds, but we need to continue to press the federal government to adequately fund Navajo law enforcement services. We sign CAP-22-21 into law.

## RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL 24<sup>th</sup> NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - THIRD YEAR, 2021

### AN ACT

RELATING TO LAW AND ORDER, BUDGET AND FINANCE, AND NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEES, AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,244,913.00 FOR THE NAVAJO DEPARTMENT OF CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS TO CONTINUE PROVIDING EFFECTIVE SERVICES FOR THE NAVAJO NATION; WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820 (E), (F), AND (J)

### BE IT ENACTED:

### SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Navajo Nation established the Law and Order Committee ("LOC") as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee, and as such gave LOC oversight over all departments within the Navajo Division of Public Safety. 2 N.N.C. §§ 600(A), 600(C)(5).
- B. The Navajo Nation established the Budget and Finance Committee ("BFC") as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee, and as such empowered BFC to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. §§ 300(A), and 301(B)(2).
- C. The Navajo Nation Council established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation standing committee, and proposed legislation requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164(A)(9) and 700(A).
- D. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation, with the authority to approve supplemental appropriations. 2 N.N.C. § 102(A), 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
- E. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(L), "[t]he Navajo Nation Council may adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in excess of the reserve amount set forth at § 820(J)."
- F. The Title 12 Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:

- 1. All requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for budget impact analysis. 12 N.N.C. § 820(M).
- 2. When the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental appropriations may be approved by the Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
- 3. Supplemental Appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall only be made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at § 820(F). The Controller of the Navajo Nation shall be responsible for the designation of recurring and non-recurring revenues. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
- 4. The Nation shall budget all recurring operating expenses, including capital maintenance, from recurring revenues. Long term debt shall not be used to finance recurring operating expenses. 12 N.N.C. § 820(E).
- 5. The Navajo Nation Code provides, "[t]he Nation shall restrict non-recurring revenues to budget non-recurring expenditures. In addition, non-recurring revenues will be budgeted only after an examination by the Controller to determine whether or not the revenues are subsidizing an imbalance between recurring revenues and expenditures, and expenditures may be authorized only if a long-term (three-five year) forecast shows that the operating deficit will not continue. Otherwise, non-recurring revenues will be added to the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund balance. This provision may be amended or waived by a two-thirds vote of the full Navajo Nation Council." 12 N.N.C. § 820(F).

## SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

A. This request for supplemental funding seeks the amount of \$1,244,913.00 out of the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance, to assist the Navajo Department of Criminal Investigations ("NDCI") in continuing to provide its daily services in an efficient and effective manner, while complying with required COVID-19 protocols. NDCI reports that its FY2021 base funding allocation is insufficient to meet NDCI's operational demands at all districts, due to increased financial burdens resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, with NDCI having to ensure proper safety protocols for its staff and community members according to CDC and Navajo Nation guidelines.

- B. The supplemental funding proposal, budget forms and related documents, including Appendix K "Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary," for NDCI are attached as **Exhibit A**.
- C. The Office of the Controller issued a memorandum dated March 17, 2021, to satisfy the requirements in 12 N.N.C. § 820(L), attached as **Exhibit B**. The Controller has identified the NDCI expenditures as RECURRING and therefore a waiver of 12 N.N.C. § 820(E), (F), and (J) is required.
- D. The Office of Management and Budget issued a memorandum dated March 24, 2021, to satisfy the requirements in 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), attached as **Exhibit C**.

## SECTION THREE. APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves \$1,244,913.00 in supplemental funding from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance for the Navajo Department of Criminal Investigations.
- B. This supplemental appropriation of \$1,244,913.00 shall be from that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance as determined by the Office of the Controller.

## SECTION FOUR. WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(E), (F), AND (J)

The Navajo Nation Council hereby waives 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(E), (F) and (J) in order to allow funds out of the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance to be used for recurring expenditures and government operations.

## SECTION FIVE. REIMBURSEMENT TO THE NAVAJO NATION UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE

The Navajo Nation Council approves any future funding to the Navajo Nation from the United States Treasury, whether through congressional appropriation, or other designation, including the American Rescue Plan Act, for the purpose of COVID-19 relief and recovery to reimburse the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance of the General Fund up to the full amount approved in this Resolution, to the extent allowed by federal and Navajo Nation law. The Navajo Nation Council shall authorize and approve reimbursement to the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance of the General Fund as the initial priority in any future Expenditure Plan Resolutions for COVID-19 relief and recovery.

### SECTION SIX. SAVING CLAUSE

Should any provision(s) of this Act be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation, without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the remainder of the Act shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.

## SECTION SEVEN. EFFECTIVE DATE

The provisions of this Act shall become effective in accordance with 2 N.N.C. § 221(B).

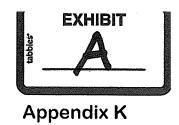

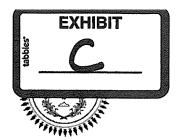
The Office of the Controller has reviewed the above referenced document.

amount of \$1,244,913 from the Undesignated, Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB).

Pursuant to 12 NNC 820 (M) OMB reviewed the subject document and provides the following information. This budget request was forwarded by the Office of Legislative Counsel.

- 1. Because of the limited availability of funds, OMB advises the Branch Chiefs to prioritize all supplemental funding proposals pursuant to the FY 2021 Budget Instructions Manual (Section XII, D), and the Appropriations Act. This activity should be completed by the branches to determine priorities.
- 2. OMB recommends compliance with the Navajo Nation Appropriations Act regarding Supplemental Appropriations (Section 820, L). This has not been done. Compliance includes:
  - a. Branch Chief's concurrence of the supplemental request (NN President).
- 3. Per the FY21 BIM (Section XII, D) states the appropriate Branch Chief shall review and provide recommendations. In this case, because the Department of Criminal Investigations is organizationally located in the Division of Public Safety, which is under the Executive Branch, the Branch Chief is the President.
- 4. Further, the signators of the Budget Forms are acknowledged to be the manager/supervisor of the program and business unit as well as the Division or Branch Chief. In this case, it would be the Corrections Director and Public Safety Division Director. Instead, Navajo Nation Council Delegates are the signators.
- 5. The figure for the 6910 object code is not sufficiently explained/justified.
