Section One. Authority

- A. The Resources and Development Committee has oversight of the Division of Natural Resources. 2 N.N.C. § 500(C)(1).
- B. The Budget and Finance Committee is empowered to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation, investment and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. § 301 (B)(2).
- C. A proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9).

- 1 D. The Navajo Nation council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2
3 N.N.C. § 102(A).
4 E. The Title 12 Appropriations Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements
5 include:
6 1. When the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above
7 and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental
8 appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council. 12
9 N.N.C. § 820(L).
10 2. Supplemental appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall
11 only be made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at
12 § 820(F). The Controller of the Navajo Nation shall be responsible for

PART II. REASON FOR REQUEST AND STATEMENT OF NEED:

This request is to fund events and activities to commemorate and educate our Dine People on the 150th Anniversary of the Navajo Long Walk and return to Dine'tah. The events scheduled will be May 31, 2018 to June 3, 2018 to commemorate the return of the 1868 Treaty to the Navajo Nation to the Navajo Nation Museum, these events will be a teaching tool to educate our youth on our history and provide a forum for which our elders can voice their struggles and healing process throughout the 150 years since our return. Many of our youth are not aware of what our heritage and cultural importance to keep alive and pass on to their children. With the decline of the Dine Language we can use this time to understand where we came from and establish a foundation for identity. Events scheduled will be May 31, 2018 will be an opening Gala at the Museum as an opening ceremony of all events June 1, 2018 will be a parade from NDOT to Fort Defiance ; June 2-3, 2018 will be a Senior Rodeo, Pow Wow, Song & Dance, other cultural events These events will be community events, no revenue will be generated. A new business unit will need to be established for this one-time event

PART III. CONTINGENCY PLAN IF REQUEST IS NOT FUNDED:

The events will be greatly limited depending on funding levels, in order to carry out the events to properly secure and have facilities readily available we will need adequate funding to complete the 150th Year Navajo Long Walk Anniversary.

PART IV. ALTERNATIVE FUNDING SOURCES BEING PURSUED:

Currently the Fair Office has two other events we currently host and we do not have the budget available to contribute to this event. Division of Natural Resources is not able to contribute to the events, Office of the President and Vice President has been instrumental in planning and implementation. OPVP has requested for in-kind assistance from divisions and departments but no funding has been identified.

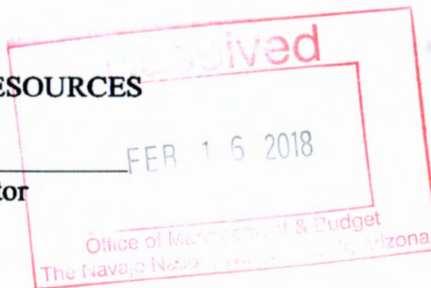



Pursuant to Executive Order No. 07-2013, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) reviewed the proposed document and provides the following:

1. Budget Forms were corrected by the program. The Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary form will need to be reviewed and approved by President Begaye.
2. The source of funds is the Undesignated, Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFb). According to the Controller's memo, the UUFb is \$27,717,798 as of February 14, 2018. The requests from the UUFb has grown over \$66 million.
3. The Navajo Nation approved the Fiscal Year 2018 budget legislation, CS-53-17, and directed the Branch Chiefs of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches to prioritize the unmet needs of their respective branches and to prepare appropriate budgets for such prioritized needs for potential consideration of supplemental appropriations in Fiscal Year 2018 in accordance with 12 NNC Section 820 (L). Only the Judicial Branch has done so with the prioritized list attached as Exhibit L to the budget legislation.
4. Controller will need to determine the non-recurring/recurring revenue and expenses in accordance with 12 NNC Section 820 (E) and (F).
5. There is also a request for supplemental funding for \$350,000 from the Navajo Nation Museum that is also for the 150th Anniversary of the Treaty. See Legislation no. 0027-18.

The Office of the Controller has reviewed the above referenced document.

1. The balance of the UUFB is \$15,075,206 as of March 6, 2018; there are a number of other supplemental requests that will be considered by the Navajo Nation Council in the near future. This supplemental request is for \$300,000 for a new business unit for the 150 Year Anniversary of the Treaty of 1868 festivities.
2. The costs for this project we determined are NON-RECURRING costs. The fair office would be responsible for this account. Activities would be from May 31 to June 3 and include opening gala, a senior rodeo, a pow wow and song and dance and other cultural events. The Fair Office does have the 4th of July Celebration also the following month that they will need to attend to.
3. Important Note: Our office is currently monitoring the Nation's actual minerals revenue to-date versus the projected revenues for FY 2018. Additionally, our office has started the revenue projection task for the upcoming 2019 operating budgets. Being that minerals revenue levels are decreasing, we recommend the Nation spend the UUFB in a prudent and conservative manner for these reasons The Navajo Nation actual minerals revenue to date vs. the projection for FY 2018 is a real concern going forward as well as for the upcoming Fiscal 2019 therefore is this type of spending prudent as there may be possible shortfall in revenue in the near future which would affect the UUFB.

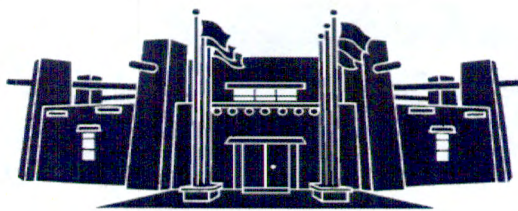
As you are aware, CJA-01-18, *Amending 2 N.N.C. § 164(B) Agreements Not Requiring Committee or Council Approval*, was signed on February 9, 2018. CJA-01-18 reads:

Prior to final execution as provided in 2 N.N.C. § 222, documents not requiring approval by resolution of the Navajo Nation Council or its committees shall be reviewed and signed by the President of the Navajo Nation within ten (10) calendar days after the document(s) is logged in at the Office of the President; and, upon notice to the Speaker and Chairperson of the oversight committee for an extension, an additional ten (10) days shall be allowed.

While CJA-01-18 will ensure that all contracts, grants, agreements and other documents are reviewed in an expedient manner, the Begaye-Nez Administration believes that a collaborative effort between essential Navajo Nation Divisions is needed to create a beneficial review system for all under CJA-01-18. A 164(B) Task Force will be assembled to ensure that all pertinent divisions are consulted in the creation of a uniformed review process immediately.

Therefore, I hereby direct that Executive Order No. 07-2013, *The 164 Review and Signature Process*, shall remain in effect until March 16, 2018.
