Dear Speaker Tso,

We appreciate the work of the Navajo Nation Council, the Committees and the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development (DCD) in addressing this matter. Pursuant to the authority vested in the Navajo Nation President, I am signing CD-57-22 into law.

Approving a limited waiver of sovereign immunity should not be taken lightly and used sparingly. The waiver will allow much needed grant funding to be drawn down for DCD's Community Housing Infrastructure Department to continue project implementation and address the housing needs of the Navajo people as intended by the Grant. Waiving the Nation's sovereign immunity is also an expression of the Nation's authority and we make this decision in the best interest of the Navajo people.

# RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL 24th NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - FOURTH YEAR, 2022

#### AN ACTION

RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT AND NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEES AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING A LIMITED WAIVER OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY ALLOWING THE NAVAJO NATION TO BE SUED IN FEDERAL DISTRICT COURT REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT IN CARRYING OUT GRANTS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE NAVAJO NATION OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE NAVAJO NATION DIVISION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO SIGN HUD FORM 7015.15 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2027

#### BE IT ENACTED:

#### SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Resources and Development Committee is the oversight committee for the Navajo Division of Community Development. 2 N.N.C. § 501(C)(1).
- B. A proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee before it is heard by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(9).
- C. The Navajo Nation Code provides, "[c]ontracts shall not waive the sovereign immunity of the Navajo Nation or its entities unless approved by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the full membership of the Navajo Nation Council." 2 N.N.C. § 223(C).
- D. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing of body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 102(A).

#### SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

A. The Navajo Nation Division of Community Development for purposes of administering Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG) funds is required to have a tribal official sign and execute HUD Form 7015.15- "Request for Release of Funds and Certification" in which the Navajo Nation consents to be sued in Federal district court regarding compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act in carrying out the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) grants.

- B. Pursuant to 24 CFR Part 58, HUD Form 7015.15 as signed by an authorized tribal official is required as part of the HUD Environmental Review.
- C. In order for the Navajo Nation to draw down funds needed to implement projects an authorized tribal official must execute HUD Form 7015.15.
- D. The Navajo Nation Council approved Council Resolutions CO-58-17, CJA-04-13, CO-32-09, CAP-21-05 authorizing a limited waiver of sovereign immunity thereby permitting the President of the Navajo Nation or the Executive Director of the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development to sign HUD Form 7015.15 through Fiscal Year 2022. Resolution CO-58-17 is attached as Exhibit A.
- E. The Southwest Office of Native American Programs (HUD), in a letter dated October 18, 2017, indicated the current Navajo Nation Council limited waiver of sovereign immunity will expire on September 30, 2022. Letter is attached as Exhibit B.
- F. The Navajo Nation Division of Community Development Indian Community Development Block Grant (CBDG) Program requests a five-year authorization period, through fiscal year 2027, for the President of the Navajo Nation and the Executive Director of the Division of Community Development to sign HUD Form 7015.15. The five-year timeframe will have a favorable impact on the ability to carry out approved HUD projects and to apply for new Indian Community Development Block Grants. The Nation competes with other tribes for these grants. These grants provide needed infrastructure service to improve quality of life.
- G. The request for this limited waiver of sovereign immunity has been reviewed under the Section 164 Review Process, attached as Exhibit C.
- H. It is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation that a limited waiver of sovereign immunity be approved by the Navajo Nation Council and that the President of the Navajo Nation or the Executive Director of the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development be authorized to sign HUD Form 1715.15 allowing the Navajo Nation to be sued in Federal District Court regarding compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act in carrying out HUD grants through Fiscal Year 2027.

#### SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

- A. The Navajo Nation Council hereby approves a limited waiver of sovereign immunity through Fiscal Year 2027 allowing the Navajo Nation to be sued in Federal District Court regarding compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act in carrying out HUD grants.
- B. The Navajo Nation Council hereby authorizes the President of the Navajo Nation and the Executive Director of the Division of Community Development to sign HUD Form 7015.15 through Fiscal Year 2027.

### RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

#### 23RD NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - THIRD YEAR, 2017

#### AN ACTION

RELATING TO AN EMERGENCY AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING A LIMITED WAIVER OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY ALLOWING THE NAVAJO NATION TO BE SUED IN FEDERAL DISTRICT COURT REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT IN CARRYING OUT GRANTS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE NAVAJO NATION OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE NAVAJO NATION DIVISION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO SIGN HUD FORM 7015.15

#### BE IT ENACTED:

#### SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. Matters constituting an emergency shall be limited to the cessation of law enforcement services, and disaster relief services, fire protection services or other direct services required as an entitlement under Navajo Nation or Federal law, or which directly threaten the sovereignty of the Navajo Nation. Such an emergency matter must arise due to the pressing public need for such resolution(s) and must be a matter requiring final action by the Council. 2 N.N.C § 164(16).
- B. Enactments of positive law must be reviewed and approved by resolution by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A); CO-45-12.

#### SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. This matter constitutes an emergency because of the direct services required as an entitlement under Federal law and directly threatens the sovereignty of the Navajo Nation and requires final action by the Council.
- B. The Navajo Nation Division of Community Development for purposes of administering Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG) funds is required to have a tribal official sign and execute HUD Form 7015.15- "Request for Release of Funds and Certification" in which the Navajo Nation consents to be sued in Federal district court regarding compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act in carrying out the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) grants.

- C. Pursuant to 24 CFR Part 58, HUD Form 7015.15 as signed by an authorized tribal official is required as part of the HUD Environmental Review.
- D. In order for the Navajo Nation to draw down funds needed to implement projects an authorized tribal official must execute HUD Form 7015.15.
- E. Pursuant to the Navajo Nation Sovereign Immunity Act neither the President nor any other Navajo Nation official has the authority to waive the sovereign immunity of the Navajo Nation without the expressed authorization of the Navajo Nation Council. 1 N.N.C. §554.
- F. The Navajo Nation Council approved Council Resolution CJA-04-13 on January 31, 2013 which authorized a limited waiver of sovereign immunity in order that the President of the Navajo Nation or the Executive Director of the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development may sign HUD Form 7015.15 through Fiscal Year 2017. Resolution CJA-04-13 is attached as Exhibit A.
- G. The Southwest Office of Native American Programs (HUD), in a letter dated May 10, 2017, indicated the current Navajo Nation Council limited waiver of sovereign immunity will expire on September 30, 2017. Letter is attached as **Exhibit B**.
- H. The request for this limited waiver of sovereign immunity has been reviewed under the Section 164 Review Process and found sufficient, attached as **Exhibit C.**
- I. It is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation that a limited waiver of sovereign immunity be approved by the Navajo Nation Council and that the President of the Navajo Nation or the Executive Director of the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development be authorized to sign HUD Form 1705.15 allowing the Navajo Nation to be sued in Federal District Court regarding compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act in carrying out HUD grants through Fiscal Year 2022.

#### SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

- A. The Navajo Nation Council hereby approves a limited waiver of sovereign immunity through Fiscal Year 2022 allowing the Navajo Nation to be sued in Federal District Court regarding compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act in carrying out HUD grants.
- B. The Navajo Nation Council hereby authorizes the President of the Navajo Nation and the Executive Director of the Division

of Community Development to sign HUD Form 7015.15 through Fiscal Year 2022.


