BE IT ENACTED;

SECTION ONE - FINDING

- A. The Navajo Nation Council gave their Law and Order and Committee oversight over the Navajo Nation Division of Public Safety, 2 N.N.C. § 601 (C) (I).
- B. The Navajo Nation Council gave their Law and Order and Committee power "(to review, amend, recommend and submit:" the Navajo Nation Division of Public Safety' Fiscal Year 2016 annual budget to the Budget and Finance Committee and the Navajo Nation Council 2 N.N.C. § 601 (B) (15), 2 N.N.C. § (840) (A).
- C. The Navajo Nation President recommended the proposed Navajo Nation Division of Public Safety' Fiscal Year 2016 Budget to the Law and Order Committee which is provided on the Fund Type Budget Summary, EXHIBIT A. 12 N.N.C. § 830 (I).
- D. The Law and Order Committee held a budget hearing and took budget testimony regarding the Navajo Nation Division of Public Safety' Fiscal Year 2016 Budget. 12 N.N.C. § 840 (A).

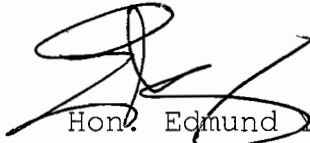
SECTION TWO - APPROVING AND RECOMMENDING

- D. The Law and Order Committee adopted an amendment to recommend to the Budget and Finance Committee to fully consider and support Navajo Nation Division of Public Safety Unmet Needs request (Attached Form E).

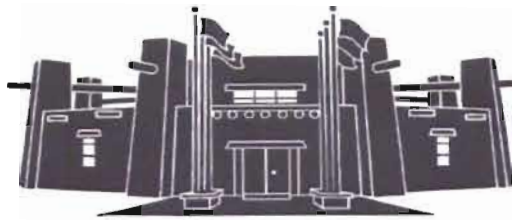
