Dear Honorable 24th NNC:

We write on behalf of Tonalea Chapter a certified chapter, whereas, respectfully asking support for Legislation No. 0262-19 proposal for funding from the Si'hasin Funds for the Tonalea Chapter's replacement initiative for a Community Building. We strongly support the funding request and the project is 100% shovel ready.

The Navajo Nation Office Division of Health, Office of Environmental Health / Code Enforcement ordered the closure of the Tonalea Chapter House Building on May 20, 2013, hence the Tonalea Community has been without a chapter house for the past six (6) years primarily due to the unsafe conditions of the old Chapter House.

Consequently, without a chapter facility, the chapter's administrative day to day functions of administering the chapters' program to address the needs of the community according to 26 NNC; the chapter is 80% complaint to adhering to the certified chapter's 'five management system'. Chapter administration has been moving from place to place, if you will, with no place to call "home". We at one point occupied the "blue warehouse" which was never intended for occupancy, only storage. We again were shut down due to unsafe conditions. We currently reside in the Tonalea Senior Center, we occupy a 10x10 Laundry Room within their building to carrying out the chapter's scope of work. The limited space of the laundry room limits our productivity and ability to effectively provide services to our community. Our chapter meetings are held in the Senior Center dining area, with a maximum occupancy of 54 persons, this again limits our ability to provide a safe and healthy environment to our community members wishing to attend the local chapter meetings.


We are in dire need of a new building to provide a safe and healthy environment for our community members and chapter administration to effectively provide services to our community.






