RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

23RD NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL -- Second Year, 2016

AN ACT

RELATING TO LAW AND ORDER, BUDGET AND FINANCE, NAA'BIK'ÍYÁTI', AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000) FOR THE NAVAJO NATION SUPREME COURT AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS MODULAR BUILDING CONSTRUCTION

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS

- A. The Navajo Nation established the Law and Order Committee as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such empowered the Law and Order Committee to serve as legislative oversight over the Navajo Nation Judiciary Branch. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 600 (A), 601 (C)(1) (2012) see also CJA-03-13.
- B. The Navajo Nation established the Budget and Finance Committee (B&F) as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such empowered B&F to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 300 (A), 301 (B)(2) (2012) see also CJA-03-13 and 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L) (2009).
- C. The Navajo Nation Council established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation standing committee and as such proposed legislation that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 700 (A) (2012) see also CO-45-12.
- D. "The Navajo Nation Council may adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year." 12 N.N.C. § 820(L) (2009).

- E. At the recommendation of the Law and Order Committee, the Budget and Finance Committee may recommend supplemental appropriations to the Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L) (2009).
- F. The Law and Order Committee shall use Nitsáhákees, Nahat'á, Iiná, and Siihásin in exercising legislative oversight over the Judiciary Branch to establish and develop the Navajo Nation justice system infrastructure, including but not limited to, the justice system facilities. 2 N.N.C. § 600 (C)(3)(2012).
- G. One way for the Navajo Nation to establish and develop judicial infrastructure is to assist with completing the Navajo Nation Supreme Court/Administrative Office of the Courts modular project.
- H. The Supplemental Funding will be deposited with the Navajo Nation Supreme Court/AOC Modular Completion; the Program Budget Summary. EXHIBIT A.
- I. The Navajo Nation received certification by the Office of the Controller that as of September 21, 2015 the balance in the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance is \$4,306,679. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L) (2009). EXHIBIT B.
- J. The Navajo Nation received certification by the Office of Management and Budget that the supplemental funding request had a budget impact analysis and other appropriate action. 12 N.N.C. § 820(M) (2009). EXHIBIT C.
- K. The Navajo Nation finds approving this supplemental funding request in the best interest of the Navajo People.

SECTION 2. ADOPTING AND APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000) FOR NAVAJO NATION SUPREME COURT AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS, BUSINESS UNIT NUMBER NEW

The Navajo Nation adopts and approves supplemental funding from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance in the amount of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the Navajo Nation Supreme Court and Administrative Office of the Courts, Business Unit Number NEW, to fund the modular building completion.




Figure 3 Window Rock Site - Foundations




Figure 4 Window Rock Site Modular arrive

The Judicial Branch is requesting supplemental funding in the amount of of \$300,000 from the FY2015 Navajo Nation Undesignated Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB) to finish construction of new modular buildings that will house the Navajo Nation Supreme Court and Administrative Office of the Courts.

The Navajo Nation Supreme Court and Administrative Office of the Court have been in dire need of office space for the last 8+ years. With the recent forced relocation from the Damon Professional Building, our offices have been scattered throughout Window Rock. This modular project began in August 2014 but will be forced to stop on October 9, 2015, due to lack of funding to finish the project. \$300,000 is needed to complete the construction of the structures; this includes exterior and interior work, connection of all utilities, and access to the site.

Further detailed information is provided in the attachments. I am requesting a supporting resolution by the honorable committee so it can move forward to the Navajo Nation Budget and Finance Committee for consideration.

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

The Judicial Branch is requesting supplemental funding in the amount of \$300,000 from the Undesignated Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB) to finish construction of the Navajo Nation Supreme Court and Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) modular buildings that are currently under construction. The modular buildings for the Supreme Court and AOC are two of four buildings that the Judicial Branch purchased from Walden Structures. The contractor, Rock Gap Engineering, has completed the installation of the Pueblo Pintado court house and the Shiprock Probation/Peacemaking modular buildings earlier this year.

Due to unforeseen changes of the Window Rock site location, the project had an added cost of \$300,000. The added cost incurred is due to redesign of the electrical system required for the site, installation of new waterline at site, added concrete for site access and curbing, additional asphalt for an access road, and a limited space parking lot.

- 1. The balance in the available UUFB as of December 7, 2015 is \$14,080,043. The initial FY 2016 UUFB was \$18,131,940 but it has been reduced by three(3) appropriations since.
- The 5-Year Capital Plan, resolution CAP-18-14, lists a Judicial Complex/Supreme Court project in the total amount of \$15.5 million. The DCD-Capital Improvement Office should clarify this and advise if there is any adjustment.
- 3. The current request for \$300,000 is to finish a modular building for the Supreme Court.
- 4. OMB has recently advised the Branch Chiefs to prioritize over 160 Additional Need Proposals in total exceeding \$116 million so that the government can consider priorities. The Supreme Court is listed with an additional need for \$18.1 million as recommended by the Law and Order Committee by resolution LOCAU-11-15.
- 5. The Law and Order Committee, by resolution LOCAU-11-15, has recommended 14 unmet needs for the Judicial Branch in an amount exceeding \$19 million. This is why Branch Chief prioritization is important.
- 6. Budget Form 2 is missing.
