28	A. The Navajo Nation Council approved Resolution 1	No. CAP-35-18, entitled, "Adopting the
29	Síhasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Exp	enditure Plan Pursuant to CD-68-14, as
30	Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-	2508, as Amended; Waiving 12 N.N.C.

§§ 810 (F), 820 (I) And (M) And 860 (C) Relating to the Capital Improvement Budget and the Capital Improvement Process." CAP-35-18 is incorporated herein by reference.
B. Section 4(C) of CAP-35-18 provides: "A chapter project, powerline, or waterline project may be changed, including the year funded, or added to Exhibits A through E with the concurrence of the Delegate representing the chapter's Council District and the approvals of the Resources and Development Committee and Budget and Finance Committee, as long as such project has been certified as construction-ready by CPMD or NTUA and the total Síhasin Funding for the District does not exceed \$4,166,666.67."

C. The amount of \$75,040 for the Tse Si Ani (Lupton) Chapter Road Improvement Project was approved in Exhibit D of CAP-35-18. The CAP-35-18 Exhibit D showing the Chapter Project No. 146 is attached hereto as **EXHIBIT 1**.

D. In Resolution No. TSA-2021-07-044 the Chapter requests to delete No. D-146 and to reallocate the \$75,040 in approved funds to the N-9402 Road Improvement Project that will significantly benefit the Chapter community. **EXHIBIT 2**.

- E. Regarding this change request, the Division of Community Development, Capital Projects
 Management Department ("CPMD") has submitted on behalf of the Chapter, a Síhasin
 Project Amendment Certification Form, attached hereto as EXHIBIT 3. The CPMD
 Amendment Certification Form shows the signature of the Navajo Nation Council
 Delegate for the Tse Si Ani (Lupton) Chapter, as required by CAP-35-18 Section 4(C).
- F. As required by CAP-35-18 Section 4(C), the new N-9402 Project to receive the Síhasin funds has been certified by CPMD as construction-ready and the total Síhasin Funding for the Chapter's Council District will not exceed \$4,166,666.67. In fact, the Síhasin funding amount of \$75,040 originally approved in CAP-35-18 will remain unchanged.

G. The Síhasin Fund shall be reimbursed, in the amount of the allocation authorized in this Legislation, from prospective funds available to the Navajo Nation from any and all appropriate state and federal sources.

SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

The Navajo Nation Council hereby approves a change to Resolution No. CAP-35-18, Exhibit D, Project No. 146, for the Tse Si Ani (Lupton) Chapter, as shown in **EXHIBIT 3**.

SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Legislation shall become effective pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §2505.

SECTION FIVE. SAVING CLAUSE

If any provision of this Legislation is determined invalid by the Supreme Court of the Navajo Nation, or by a Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the provision(s) not determined invalid shall remain as Navajo Nation law. - Tse Si Ani Chapter is a certified chapter that is recognized by the Navajo Nation Council pursuant to 26 N.N.C. Section 3, and pursuant to 11 N.N.C. Part 1, Section 10, the Navajo Nation Council adopted the Navajo Nation Local Governance Act, which directs local chapters to promote all matters that affect the local community members and to make appropriate decisions, recommendations and advocate on their behalf; and
- Per the Sihasin Legislation CAP-35-18, the Tse Si Ani Chapter had the project D-146 Road Improvement for pre-design; however the current language limits the ability to improve the road beyond pre-design; and
- The Tse Si Ani Chapter approves a change to resolution CAP-35-18 for project D-146 Road Improvement of Exhibit D for deletion and the transfer of funds of \$75,040 to D-144 N-9402 Road Improvement Project; and
- 5. Amend the Project Description to Plan, Design and Construct; and
- 6. The Tse Si Ani Chapter is striving to better serve its community for all ages to provide economic and social strides in service and delivery.
