TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE; APPROVING THE SPEAKER'S APPOINTMENT OF NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL MEMBERS TO THE NAVAJO-HOPI LAND COMMISSION

PURPOSE: This resolution, if approved, will confirm the Speaker's appointment of nine (9) members to the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission of the 25th Navajo Nation Council.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committee. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each committee member to review the proposed resolution in detail.

- D. The Speaker's memorandum appointing nine members to the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- E. The Navajo-Hopi Land Commission members shall serve at the pleasure of the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. § 852 (B) (2).
- F. The Navajo-Hopi Land Commission members shall serve a term coinciding with their term as Navajo Nation Council Delegates and until their successors are appointed. 2 N.N.C. § 852 (D).

Nevertheless, "the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council shall introduce [the proposed resolution] into the legislative process by assigning it to the respective oversight committee(s) of the Navajo Nation Council having authority over the matters for proper consideration." 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(5).

Please ensure that his particular resolution request is precisely what you want. You are encouraged to review the proposed resolution to ensure that it is drafted to your satisfaction.
