# RESOLUTION OF THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' STANDING COMMITTEE 25th NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL -- First Year, 2023

AN ACTION RELATING TO NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE; CONCURRING WITH THE NAVAJO NATION PRESIDENT TO ACCEPT A DONATION OF \$15,000.00 TO THE NAVAJO NATION BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB OF DINÉ YOUTH FROM THE BOYS AND GIRLS CLUBS OF AMERICA'S NATIVE AMERICAN ENDOWMENT FUND

## BE IT ENACTED:

## SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Navajo Nation established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 700(A).
- B. The President of the Navajo Nation shall, for and on behalf of the Navajo Nation, accept or decline gifts of property, provided that any such acceptance or refusal of a gift of an estimated value in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) shall be with the concurrence of the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. § 1010.
- C. All public officials, elected and non-elected, of the Navajo Nation receiving gifts, whether intended as a gift to the official or to the Navajo Nation, shall record or cause to be recorded such gift with the Ethics and Rules Office." 2 N.N.C. § 1012.

## SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. On February 10, 2023, the Navajo Nation was notified of its award of \$15,000.00 from the Boys and Girls Clubs of America's Native American Endowment Fund. The purpose of the award is to assist the Boys and Girls Club of Many Farms Clubhouse with repairs.
- B. For purposes of accounting and budgeting, and consistent with the intent and purpose of the donation, the Boys and Girls Club of Diné Youth has provided Navajo Nation Budget Forms within the 164 Review packet, attached as Exhibit A. The 164 Review packet includes a letter from Native Services and check in the amount of \$15,000.00.
- C. The Office of Management and Budget has determined the funding to be a donation rather than a grant award as indicated in a

memo from Cordell Shortey dated March 28, 2023, and included within Exhibit A.

## SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby concurs with the President of the Navajo Nation to accept the \$15,000.00 donation made to the Boys and Girls Club of Diné Youth from the Boys and Girls Clubs of America's Native American Endowment Fund.
- B. The Boys and Girls Club of Diné Youth shall record the receipt of the donation with the Ethics and Rules Office pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 1012.

The subject document was reviewed pursuant to FY 2023 NN BIM. The document was issued as Section 164 (B) review by yourself and Dr. Begay signed cover but is not dated. Our review determined the documents insufficient due to issues noted in Section E., of the attached CGS Document Review Checklists and further explained below:

- Navajo Nation Department of Dine Youth get direct donation/funding by BGCA. Appendix
  L. § VIII. C. of the BIM states grant awards on which the grant applications were not authorized
  by the Nation through review and approval required by § VI. B shall obtain full review by
  OMB, OOC and DOJ and such award includes the respective Branch Chief, for acceptance by
  the Nation prior to implementation. Award attached requires NN President's signature for
  acceptance.
- Appendix L. § VIII. D. of the BIM states grant award that is submitted very untimely for review, acceptance, and implementation, the Division Director shall explain the reason in memorandum addressed to OMB and the respective Branch Chief and shall take corrective action to resolve the noncompliance. Award letter is dated 2/10/23 ODY/DODE submittal is very untimely.
- 3. Appendix L § III. B. 3, of the BIM states the amount budgeted for each cost code shall be explained or supported by calculations or formula that supports how the budget amount was determined and is sufficient for proposed expenditure. Budget form 4 does not have calculations.
- 4. Appendix L § IX. C. 2. of the BIM states the latest executed IDC Negotiation Agreement between the Interior Business Center/DOI and the Nation shall be used to budget for recovery of IDC funds. The IDC rate used is 15.46%. The current IDC rate is 12.59%.
- 5. Appendix L. § VIII. Therefore, our office will inform BGCoA-Native Services, National Vice-President, Carla Knapp of award procedures to include in the future contribution/donation.
- 4. Correction, our office is the one has been inserting signature pages behind award letters for the NN President to accept the funds. As request, our office will revise signature page to include both NN Council Speaker and the NN President for signature acknowledgement to accept fundings.

The BGC-Many Farms building is closed currently by the Office of Navajo Environment Health/Code Enforcement (ONEH) until repairs are complete. Therefore, processing our 164 Document as sufficient review surnaming is appreciated to be moved forward to the next Reviewers. This document needs to be completed as soon as possible to begin building renovation for the reopening of BGC-Many Farms. Soon local School's will be out for the Summer, and parents will need a place for their children to go to be safe and involve in scheduled youth activities.

Information having been presented to the Office of Environmental Health/Code Enforcement, Navajo Division of Health, duly designated as and herein the Regulatory Authority, that the Boys and Girls Club of Many Farms/Dine Youth in Many Farms, AZ has not corrected critical building deficiencies noted by the Indian Health Service Many Farms OEHE Field Office. Continued occupancy of the Building poses a substantial health and safety risk to employees, clients, children, and visitors. Further, continued occupancy substantially exposes the Navajo Nation to potential claims of loss from said employees, clients, children, visitors, or property due to potential hazards.

This Office of Dine' Youth facility has been surveyed by Many Farms OEHE Field Office and since May 13, 2022, only 3 out of 14 critical violations listed below have been corrected, 12 critical violations remain open. The following are repeated critical violations and recommend a corrective action:

- 1. There is no central heating provided.
- The addition is 20' x 40' with one exit door that leads into a hallway, and this does not met
  the Life Safety Code. Another exit door is recommended from this room, so the new addition
  is not a dead-end. Priority should be to address this issue first. Life Safety Code NFPA 101
  17.2.5.2
- 3. Door to outside in newly added addition swings inward. NFPA Door Swing and Arrangement states: Doors must swing in the direction of exit travel.
- 4. Door to outside in newly added addition has two deadbolt locks. NFPA states a door must be provided a knob, panic bar, or other simple type of releasing device.
- 5. Backdoor entrance to the outside lower threshold seal has a gap. Gaps allow access for rodents and insects to enter building.

- 6. Due to backdoor gap, there is a rug being used to cover gap. According to NFPA 101: all exits should be kept clear, accessible, and maintained. In an event of an emergency, rug is a potential tripping hazard.
- 7. Outside stairs to newly added addition is made of cinder blocks. Cinder blocks are loose and unstable. There are no effective hand rails and no wheelchair ramp. Loose and unstable stairs pose a falling and tripping risk for occupants and is not ADA compliant.
- 8. Smoke detector in building addition is beeping. A beeping smoke detector indicates the batteries need replacing.
- 9. The facility had no emergency lighting inside nor flashlight provided. Since this facility remains open an emergency lighting is recommended in case of power failure.
- 10. There is no "EXIT" signage to the outside in the newly added addition to building. NFPA 101 7.10.1.5.1 states: Access to exits shall be marked by approved, readily visible signs. Install "EXIT" signage
- 11. There was no designated janitor closet with a mop curb floor sink. Vacuum cleaner and mop continue to be kept/stored at backdoor entrance. Any future development or renovation should keep in mind the importance of janitor closet with floor sink.
- 12. A spray bottle labeled "BGC" and filled with an unknown chemical is found in storage area. Any spray bottle filled with chemicals needs to be properly labeled and provided a Safety Data Sheet.

These deficiencies, specifically the lack of a central heating system, need to be corrected before normal operation commences. Therefore, the Navajo Office of Environmental Health hereby issues the following:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an Order of Closure is warranted and shall be effective ten calendar days upon service. Therefore, the Boys and Girls Club of Many Farms/Dine Youth employees shall be relocated until the noted deficiencies are corrected.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Order of Closure is to reduce or eliminate the substantial health and safety risk and to mitigate any hazards and ill effects from potential loss or claims and is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that failure to comply shall subject you to further adverse actions from, including, but not limited to, the Regulatory Authority or the Navajo Nation Occupational Safety and Health Administration.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, pursuant to Subchapter 6, Section 601, (B), of the Navajo Nation Occupational Safety and Health Act of 2000, "Any person, including any employee, may file a written compliant with the Agency concerning any alleged violation of a regulation or any hazardous condition."

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that failure to comply shall result in further adverse action(s) without notice.

The attached subject document was received at OMB on March 23, 2024 as you resubmitted by memo of March 20, 2023. It was previously reviewed by CGS, surnamed insufficient and reasons explained in memo of March 14, 2023. Below are comments on the re-review:

- Five (5) comments on concerns or action needed were in the CGS memo of March 20. Your memo of March 20 addressed or resolved four (4) of the items. The item that remains is obtain full review (by OOC, DOJ) on the document.
- 2. February 10, 2023 letter by Ms. Carla Knapp of Native Services, states the funding is to assist with repairs of Boys and Girls Club of Many Farms Clubhouse. The budget on NNBF 4 is for Building R&M Supplies object code 6030. The repairs needed should be assessed to determine the scope of the repairs and the budget prepared based on that. Be advise of the following that applies to the budget also:
  - The budget amounts in PART III Column (B) of NNBF 1 was corrected via type written but not signed. There is no indication the Program Manager (you) and Division Director (Dr. Begaye) are aware and approve the revision.
  - Below is clip of Appendix L § IX. C. of the BIM on Budgeting for Recovery of IDC funds.
     You may want to handle IDC accordingly.
  - C. Budgeting for Recovery of IDC Funds.
    - 1. Budget for recovery of IDC funds shall be included in application for federal funds and awards pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 701(A)(10). Budget for recovery of IDC shall be included in application and award for state, county, and local government funding agencies provided that the funding agency allows for IDC recovery. It is not required for Program to seek a waiver of the IDC rate under 2 N.N.C. § 701(A)(10) if the non-federal funding agency does not allow the program to apply the current IDC rate under the latest approved IDC Negotiation Agreement.
- 3. Appendix L § V. of the BIM list documents that should be in application and grant award e.g., Grant Agreement (Agreement), SOW, budget, etc. The Agreement usually specify purpose of the funding, the budget period start and end date, reporting requirements and due date, etc. While the letter by Ms. Knapp referenced at no. 2 above indicates the purpose, there is no Agreement in the packet so the budget period, reporting requirement and other terms and conditions are not specified.
- 4. The funding is awarded without the Nation applying for it. So is it a donation that President Nygren can accept pursuant 2 NNC § 1010, which in part states, Navajo Nation President shall, for and on behalf of the Navajo Nation accept gifts of property. Page 2 of letter by Ms. Knapp has line for signature by President Nygren.

Also attached is a memo of Feb 24, 2022 by which CGS commented on donation to NDSS. It refers to resolution CMA-08-20 the Council enacted authorizing Speaker to concur on gifts accepted by NN President. CGS is not aware if that authorization still applies. DOJ is requested to advise on that.

As advised in CGS memo of March 20 and referred to at no. 1 above, obtain full review on the packet and promptly so the donation can be authorized for implementation.



The Department of Justice (DOJ) has reviewed Doc. No. 20235 regarding the acceptance of funds from the Boys and Girls Native Endowment Grant for Clubhouse repairs in Many Farms. Upon review, the document has been found sufficient.

Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 1010, the President of the Navajo Nation has the authority to accept or decline gifts of property that are in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) with the concurrence of the Naabik'iyati' Committee. However, under Navajo Nation Council Resolution CMA-08-20, the Navajo Nation has approved minimized procedures for accepting donations during the duration of the Navajo Nation's COVID-19 Emergency Declaration and temporarily waiving 2 N.N.C. § 1010. Pursuant to CMA-08-20, Section 4(a), the Speaker is authorized to act alone, without resolution, on behalf of the Naabik'iyati' Committee to concur with the President's acceptance or refusal of a gift in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000). Further, Section 5 states the resolution is effective until the Declaration of Emergency is lifted.

Currently, the Declaration of Emergency has yet to be lifted and is therefore deemed to be in effect. The Native Endowment Grant may be accepted by the concurrence of both the President and Speaker of the 25<sup>th</sup> Navajo Nation Council. ## RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION ON EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

DECLARING THE DEACTIVATION OF THE MARCH 11, 2020 PUBLIC HEALTH STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE NAVAJO NATION (CEM-20-03-11) DUE TO SIGNIFICANT DECREASES IN TRENDS OF THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE ("COVID-19") ON THE NAVAJO NATION.

## WHEREAS:

- Pursuant to 2 N.N.C., § 881 the Navajo Nation Council established the Commission on Emergency Management, authorizing it to assess, verify, recommend and declare states of emergency with the concurrence of the President of the Navajo Nation; and
- 2. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C., § 883 (A) and (C) the Commission is empowered to coordinate immediate emergency and disaster relief services with Navajo Nation and non-tribal entities in conjunction with the Department of Emergency Management to recommend and deploy appropriate resources regarding natural and man-made emergencies; and
- Pursuant to 2 N.N.C., § 884 (B), (2) the Commission on Emergency Management may seek assistance from federal, state, other tribal governments, and local and private agencies to address emergency and disaster related situations; and
- On March 11, 2020, a public health state of emergency was declared for the Navajo Nation (CEM-20-03-11) due
  to extensive impacts and increase in laboratory test confirmed cases of SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) disease which
  had spread locally, regionally, and globally; and
- Current COVID-19 trends, derived through disease surveillance and reporting by the Navajo Nation Department
  of Health (NNDOH) indicate the Navajo Nation is no longer in the critical, emergency pandemic stage compared
  to the height of the pandemic in 2020-2021, and with hospital bed occupancy and hospital admission rates now
  considered to be at low risk; and
- 6. On May 11, 2023, the federal Public Health Emergency for COVID-19, announced under Section 319 of the Public Health Service (PHS) Act, expired in response to significantly declining trends in COVID-19 cases; and
- During March 2023, the States of New Mexico, Arizona, and Utah also terminated, or allowed to expire, their
  respective emergency declarations related to COVID-19, citing that COVID-19 was no longer of severity and
  magnitude to continue emergency declarations; and
- 8. The Navajo Nation Department of Health is positioned to continue monitoring COVID-19, and has established partnerships with organizations such as the CDC, NAIHS, states departments of health, tribal health organizations, John Hopkins Center for Indigenous Health, and other partners, including maintaining a COVID-19 Team, to implement measures such as prevention and control strategies as on-going public health priorities; and
- 9. It is acknowledged that while COVID-19 is still a public health priority, the Navajo Nation has mitigation and prevention strategies in place, and the Navajo Nation will also align with nation-wide efforts to transition away from emergency phase and continue to build capacity by strengthening partnerships in addressing future-infectious disease outbreaks.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Navajo Nation Commission on Emergency Management hereby declares the deactivation of the March 11, 2020 Public Health Emergency for the Navajo Nation (CEM-20-03-11) due to significant decreases in trends of the COVID-19 disease on the Navajo Nation.
- 2. Continue monitoring and examining the on-going public health needs of the Navajo Nation by better understanding and addressing health-related impacts such as providing health care, disabilities due to long COVID, mental health, and working to mitigate the impacts.
- 3. All Navajo Nation Branches, departments, programs, will continue to comply with and adhere to directives, instructions, and/or policies forthcoming from the Navajo Nation Department of Health as related to continuing efforts in addressing COVID.
- 4. Continue to address the needs of the Navajo Nation in a manner to provide the necessary resources to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Navajo Nation through acquisition of additional personnel, medical supplies, equipment, monetary funding, and other sources.
- 5. Maintain the momentum achieved in pandemic preparedness planning, and continue to utilize public education outreach to maintain public knowledge of risk and exposure to COVID-19, particularly for the Navajo Nation's vulnerable population (elderly and immunocompromised), encourage independent responsibility and action in practicing mitigation measures.


