
TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO AN EMERGENCY OF THE NAVAJO NATION; APPROVING A DISTRIBUTION OF THE INCOME FROM THE NAVAJO NATION VETERANS TRUST FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION, NINETY-FOUR THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTY FOUR DOLLARS (\$1,094,784) TO THE FIVE VETERANS AGENCY ORGANIZATIONS, BUSINESS UNITS 103016-103020

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to authorize a distribution form the Veterans Trust fund to provide financial assistance to Navajo veterans.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Authority

A. The Navajo Nation Code provides, "[m]atters constituting an emergency shall be limited to the cessation of law enforcement services, and disaster relief services, fire protection services or other direct services required as an entitlement under Navajo Nation or federal law, or which directly threaten the sovereignty of the Navajo Nation." 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(16).

B. This legislation is offered as an emergency legislation due to the significant impact on individual veterans due to a loss in direct services.

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1	Section	n Two. Findings
2	A.	This is a disbursement of funds from the Trust Fund income of the Navajo Nation
3		Veterans Trust Fund, codified in 12 NNC §§ 1171-1178. The disbursement amounts are
4		detailed in Exhibit A.
5	B.	This distribution will be made in accordance with the 50/50 formula described in 12
6		N.N.C. § 820(O).
7	C.	The definition of Trust Fund income in the Navajo Nation Veteran's Trust Fund is to
8		"consist of all earnings (interest, dividends, and other such related earnings) generated by
9		the principal and interests of the Fund, as well as annual set-asides by the Navajo Nation
10		Council as noted in Section 1171 of the subchapter." 12 N.N.C. § 1175, as amended by
11		Navajo Nation Council Resolution, CO-63-17. See also Navajo Nation Council
12		Resolution CD-74-17, overriding the Navajo Nation President's veto of Resolution CO-
13		63-17.
14	D.	The Navajo Nation Code provides for the expenditure from the Veterans Trust Fund as
15		follows:
16		Seventy-five percent (75%) of the total income earned, plus the current
17		projected set aside of the Fund, will be used as supplemental funding for
18		programs and services to benefit veterans, as noted under § 1172 on an
19		annual basis, excluding two percent (2%) which shall be for the exclusive
20		use of the Veterans Housing Program in accordance with 12 N.N.C. §
21		1171 (A) and Navajo Nation Council Resolution CS-56-17. The income
22		earned at the end of the previous audited fiscal year plus the current fiscal
23		year projected set aside will be used to determine the allowable
24		expenditure (i.e. budget purposes).
25		12 N.N.C. § 1176(A), as amended by Navajo Nation Council Resolution CJA-02-18.
26	E.	The aim of Council Resolution CO-63-17, CD-74-17, and CJA-02-18 was to allow for
27		additional fund to be distributed to offset the expenses faced by individual veterans.
28		Exhibits B and \mathbf{C} show the additional funds available for distribution to veterans as a
29		result of Council Resolutions CO-63-17, CD-74-17, and CJA-02-18.
30		

1	F.	Exhibit C shows Resolutions CD-74-17 and CJA-02-18 provided additional funds of
2		\$7,544,298. Of this total, seventy-five percent (75%) will available to the Veterans for
3		distribution. The remaining twenty-five percent (25%) will be reinvested.
4	G.	The seventy five percent (75%) available for distribution is broken down further, with
5		ninety-five percent (95%) available to go directly to veterans and five percent (5%) to be
6		used for administrative fees. See Exhibit B.
7	H.	Since the Council amended the relevant sections of the Navajo Nation Code after the start
8		of Fiscal Year 2018, and in order to allow for additional reinvestment of the funds, the
9		disbursement is limited to \$1,094,784 at this time.

11	Sectio	n Three. Approval
12	A.	The Navajo Nation Council approves a disbursement of \$1,094,784 to the Navajo
13		Nation Veterans Agencies for the 110 Chapters of the Navajo Nation using the 50/50
14		formula detailed in 12 N.N.C. § 820(O) in accordance with Exhibit A.






