**PURPOSE:** This resolution will prohibit the scheduling of committee and commission meetings while the Navajo Nation Council is in session or while the Naabik'iyáti' Committee is meeting. The resolution will also restrict the travel of delegates during Council sessions and Naabik'iyáti' Committee meetings. In addition to this, delegates will not be paid stipends or reimbursement for attending chapter meetings, including Planning meetings, conducted during Council sessions or during Naabik'iyáti' Committee meetings.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

#### BE IT ENACTED:

#### Section One. Findings

- A. The Law and Order Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has the authority to review and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation Council on proposed amendments to and enactments to the Navajo Nation Code. 2 N.N.C. §601(B)(14).
- B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(9), "a proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council [must] be assigned to standing committee(s) having authority over the subject matter at issue and the Naabik'íyátí Committee."

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- C. The Navajo Nation Council, pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §102(A), is the "governing body of the Navajo Nation ...".
- D. Navajo Nation Council delegates are assigned to serve on standing committees of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 180. In addition, delegates, where permitted under Navajo Nation law, may be allowed to serve on governing boards of other Navajo Nation entities.
- E. It is important that delegates attend sessions of the Navajo Nation Council and meetings of the Naabik'íyátí Committee. Title 2 of the Navajo Nation Code mandates, "[a]Il delegates to the Navajo Nation Council shall attend all regular and special meetings of the Navajo Nation Council or Committees." 2 N.N.C. § 167. The presence of delegates at Council and Naabik'íyátí Committee meetings is essential because only delegates themselves, not anyone else, can debate and cast votes on agenda items. *Rule 22(F), Navajo Nation Council Rules of Order*. Meetings of boards and commissions, upon which delegates serve, should not conflict with the time when the Council is in session or when the Naabik'íyátí Committee is meeting.
- F. It is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation that no meetings of boards and commissions, on which delegates serve, are to be held or conducted while the Navajo Nation Council is in session or while the Naabik'íyátí Committee is meeting. Meeting times should not conflict. For the same reasons, stipends and reimbursement should not be permitted for delegate attendance at chapter meetings or planning meetings during Council sessions or during Naabik'íyátí Committee meetings.

#### Section Two. Amending 2 N.N.C. §183(F)

The Navajo Nation Council hereby amends 2 N.N.C. §183(F) as follows:

<sup>&</sup>quot;No committee or commission meeting shall be held while the Navajo Nation Council is in special or regular session or while the Naabik'iyati' Committee is meeting, except to consider a matter which is already a part of the agenda for the

Council session, or the Naabik'iyati' Committee meeting, then in progress and for which committee or commission action is a legal condition precedent to action by the Council or the Naabik'iyati' Committee. Nor shall t The Speaker shall not approve travel for any member of the Council which is to take place during a special or regular session of the Council requests of delegates for travel when the Council will be in session or when the Naabik'íyáti' Committee will be meeting except when such travel is to conduct a meeting with, or to give official testimony to, the government of another sovereign. Further, no delegate shall receive a stipend or reimbursement for attending a Chapter meeting, including planning meetings, conducted during a Council session or during a Naabik'íyáti' Committee meeting.

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#### Section Three. Effective date

The amendments enacted herein shall be effective pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §221(B).

#### Section Four. Codification

The provisions of these amendments of the Navajo Nation Code shall be codified by the Office of Legislative Counsel. The Office of Legislative Counsel shall incorporate such amendments in the next codification of the Navajo Nation Code.

#### Section Five. Savings Clause

Should any provision of these amendments be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those amendments that are not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Nation.
