BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE NAVAJO NATION ON BEHALF OF THE NAVAJO NATION AND THE NAVAJO NATION OFFICE OF SCHOLARSHIP AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE; AND DIRECTING THE NAVAJO NATION OFFICE OF SCHOLARSHIP AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO RECORD THE \$10,000.26 MONETARY GIFT WITH THE ETHICS AND RULES OFFICE

BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Findings

- 1. Gifts and donations can be made to the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §1010. Navajo Nation law provides that the President of the Navajo Nation, on behalf of the Navajo Nation, can either accept or decline offers of gifts and donations of property. Gifts or donations exceeding \$10,000, or estimated values thereof, must be approved by the Naabik'íyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. §1011. All gifts and donations to the Navajo Nation remain property of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §1010.
- 2. The Windhover Foundation, Inc. has offered \$10,000.26 gift/donation to the Navajo Nation Office of Scholarship and Financial Assistance for scholarship for Navajo students. The President of the Navajo Nation has accepted this gift/donations. See Exhibit "A."

Section Two. Concurrence; Signature authorization

The Navajo Nation hereby concurs with the President of the Navajo Nation's acceptance of the donation of \$10,000.26 from the Windhover Foundation, Inc. The President is authorized to sign the agreement attached as Exhibit "B" (reflecting the intent and purpose of this gift/donation). Section Three. Business Units and Object Code(s); Recording of gift

- For purposes of accounting and budgeting, and consistent with the intent and purpose of the gift/donation accepted herein, the Navajo Nation Office of Scholarships and Financial Assistance shall provide the Office of Management and Budget with the appropriate business unit and object code(s), as well as any necessary budget forms.
- 2. The Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship and Financial Assistance shall record the receipt of the gift/donation accepted here with the Ethics and Rules Office as required by 2 N.N.C. §1012.



INTRODUCED BY: Tracking No. _____

AN ACTION RELATING TO A DONATION, ACCEPTING \$10,000.26 FROM THE WINDHOVER FOUNDATION, INC., PURSUANT TO 2 N.N.C. §1010.

WHEREAS:

- 1. The President of the Navajo Nation shall, for and on behalf of the Navajo nation, accept or decline gifts of property, provided that an such acceptance or refusal of a gift of property, provided that any such acceptance or refusal of a gift of an estimated value in excess of one thousand dollars shall be with the concurrence of the Government Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council. All gifts to the Navajo Nation shall be and remain the property of the Navajo Nation.
- 2. The Government Services Committee is no longer a committee of the Navajo Nation Council. The Nabik'iyati' Committee replaces the Government Services Committee pursuant to § 5 of Legislation CAP-10-11.
- 3. The Windhover Foundation, Inc. has donated \$10,000.26 to the Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship and Financial Assistance.
- 4. President Russell Begaye has accepted the donation in the amount of \$10,000.26 on behalf of the Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship and Financial Assistance, attached as Exhibit "A."
- 5. Windhover Foundation, Inc. has asked the Navajo Nation to sign the attached "Grant Agreement." The Grant Agreement is attached as Exhibit "B."
- 6. It is best of the Navajo Nation for the Nabik'iyati' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council to concur with the President's acceptance of the Windhover Foundation, Incorporated's donation of \$10,000.26.
