NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

23RD NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - Third Year, 2017

AN ACTION

RELATING TO HEALTH, EDUCATION AND HUMAN SERVICES, NAABIK'ÍYÁTI'
AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING THE REINSTATEMENT OF SEAN
JEFFRY KING AS A MEMBER OF THE NAVAJO NATION

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. Pursuant to the Navajo Nation law: Any enrolled member of the Navajo Nation may renounce [his] membership by written petition to the President of the Navajo Nation requesting that his name be stricken from the Navajo Nation roll. See 1 N.N.C. § 705 (Renunciation of membership).
- B. The Navajo Nation in addition states, "[n]o person, otherwise eligible for membership in the Navajo Nation, may enroll as a member of the Navajo Nation, who, at the same time, is on the roll of any other tribe of Indians." See 1 N.N.C. § 703 (Member of another tribe).
- C. Renounced members may be reinstated by the Navajo Nation only by the vote of majority of the Navajo Nation Council. See 1 N.N.C. § 705 (Renunciation of membership).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. On January 01, 1940, Mr. Sean Jeffry King was enrolled with the Navajo Nation Census Roll, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
- B. Mr. Sean Jeffry King's father is a Navajo Nation tribal member and mother is a member of the Rosebud Sioux tribe, documents of parents tribal enrollments attached hereto as **Exhibit B and C**.
- C. Subsequently, Mr. Sean Jeffry King's mother renounced his membership from the Navajo Nation, when he was a minor and enrolled him with the Rosebud Sioux tribe, letter from Mr. Sean Jeffry King attached hereto as **Exhibit D**.

D. Mr. Sean Jeffry King is currently a member of the Rosebud Sioux tribe, awaiting disenrollment upon the re-enrollment with the Navajo Nation, relinquishment form attached hereto as **Exhibit E**.

E. The Iyanbito Chapter is in support and recommends the reenrollment of Mr. Sean Jeffry King to the Navajo Nation, resolution of Iyanbito Chapter attached hereto as **Exhibit F**.

SECTION THREE. REENROLLMENT

Mr. Sean Jeffry King, is and shall be reinstated, or otherwise reenrolled, as a member of the Navajo Nation. By this action of the Navajo Nation Council and pursuant to the laws of the Navajo Nation, he shall be entitled to all rights, benefits and privileges associated with membership with the Navajo Nation.

CERTIFICATION

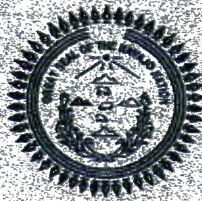

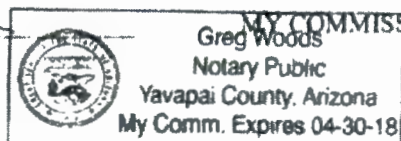

Supporting and Recommending for the Re-Enrollment
to the Navajo Nation for Sean J. King

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to Navajo Tribal Council Resolution W-30-55, and reaffirmed by Resolution CMY-23-79, the Council certifies and authorizes the Iyanbito Chapter as a Navajo Chapter; and
2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1, (B)(1)(2) and Section 103, the Iyanbito Chapter is recognized as a local government entity and delegated certain authorities and responsibilities with respect to local matters consistent with Navajo Nation laws; and
3. Pursuant to 1 N.N.C. Section 705, ... such person may be reinstated in the Navajo Nation only by the vote of a majority of the Navajo Nation Council; and
4. Mr. Sean J. King now seeks re-enrollment/reinstatement with the Navajo Nation.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Iyanbito Chapter hereby supports and recommends for the re-enrollment to the Navajo Nation for Sean J. King.
