### Section Two. Findings

- A. The Navajo Nation Council adopted Council Resolution CAP-35-18, "Adopting the Síhasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan Pursuant to CD-68-14, as Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, as Amended; Waiving 12 N.N.C. §§ 810 (F), 820 (I) and (M) and 860 (C) Relating to the Capital Budget and Capital Improvement Process" on April 17, 2018.
- B. Houck Chapter requests to change the approved funding year in CAP-35-18 to delete cemetery from year one funding in project D-149 and to replace it with access road and grading (plan, design, and construction). The project funding of \$46,722 will remain in year one.
- C. The Sihasin Project Amendment Certification, attached as **Exhibit A**, has been signed by the Delegate representing the chapter's council district as required by CAP-35-18, section 4, paragraph C.
- D. The Capital Projects Management Department, through its signature in section IV of Exhibit A, has indicated the project is construction ready. Also, while not a requirement pursuant to CAP-35-18, Houck Chapter has indicated its support of this request in Houck Chapter Governance Resolution, HCR-091520-02, attached as Exhibit B.

The Navajo Nation hereby approves the project change requested by Houck Chapter in accordance with **Exhibit A.**
