16	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY
17	A. The Law and Order Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation
18	Council. 2 N.N.C. § 600(A).
19	B. By resolution CO-45-12, all hearing functions of the former Ethics and Rules
20	Committee were transferred to the Navajo Nation Office of Hearings and Appeals. The
21	Law and Order Committee has oversight authority over the Office of Hearings and
22	Appeals pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 601(C).

24	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS
25	1. The Navajo Nation Regulations And Standards Of Conduct For All Elected Officials
26	addresses the conduct of all Navajo Nation elected officials. See ERC-08-001.
27	2. It is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation that Regulations And Standards Of
28	Conduct For All Elected Officials be amended to clarify the restrictions against alcohol
29	use while on official travel.

3. Aside specific oversight responsibilities, a general purpose of the Law and Order Committee is "to improve the administration of justice on the Navajo Nation." 2 N.N.C. § 600(C)(1).

SECTION THREE. AMENDING REGULATIONS AND STANDARDS OF CONDUCT FOR ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS

The Navajo Nation hereby amends Regulations And Standards Of Conduct For All Elected Officials as follows:

Regulations and Standards of Conduct for Elected Officials of the Navajo Nation

Section Two. Use of Drugs or Alcohol

- A. The provisions of the Navajo Nation Policy On Drugs And Alcohol In The Workplace shall apply to all elected officials. Further, N no elected official shall use, or be under the influence of, alcohol or any controlled substance during the performance of any of his or her duties or while on travel for official business. These provisions shall apply to all official meetings and hearings attended by elected officials, including those meetings and hearings attended within or outside the Navajo Nation. The provisions herein shall apply to the entire duration of any travel for official purposes.
- B. Elected officials are subject to removal and other sanctions for the habitual abuse of drugs or alcohol, particularly if such abuse impairs or otherwise adversely impacts the performance of official duties of office.
- C. In respect to the regulation governing drugs and alcohol, elected officials, while on official travel, shall conduct themselves in a professional and dignified manner.

All instances involving violations of this section shall be reported to the Ethics D. and Rules Office within 10 days of occurrence.

SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE

The amendments enacted herein shall be effective immediately upon the bill's certification.

SECTION FIVE. COMPILATION OF REGULATIONS

The provisions enacted or otherwise amended herein shall be inserted into the existing Regulations And Standards Of Conduct For All Elected Officials and the complete copy of the rules and regulations shall be printed and made available by the Navajo Ethics and Rules Office.

SECTION SIX. SAVINGS CLAUSE

Should any provision of these amendments be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those amendments that are not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Nation.

 - Regulations and Standards of Conduct enacted by ERC-98-011 (a) shall continue to be applicable to Council Delegates for allegations of misconduct preceding the date of the amendments herein.
 - The Regulations and Standards of Conduct, as amended, shall be (b) applicable to all events occurring hereinafter; there shall be no retroactive application to events preceding the date of the amendments.
