BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Authority

- A. The Navajo Nation established the Law and Order Committee as a Navajo
Nation Council standing committee and as such gave the Committee
oversight over Navajo Nation Courts. 2 N.N.C. §§ 600 (C)(2).
- B. The Navajo Nation established the Budget and Finance Committee (BFC) as
a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such empowered BFC

1 to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the management of
2 all funds. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 300 (A), 301 (B)(2).

3 C. The Navajo Nation Council established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a
4 Navajo Nation standing committee and as such proposed legislation that
5 requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the
6 Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 700 (A).

7 D. The Title 12 Appropriations Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements
8 include:

- 9 1. When the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above
10 and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental
11 appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council. 12
12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
- 13 2. Supplemental appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall
14 only be made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at
15 § 820(F). The Controller of the Navajo Nation shall be responsible for
16 designating recurring and non-recurring revenues. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
- 17 3. All requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be
18 submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for budget
19 impact analysis. 12 N.N.C. § 820(M).

20 **Section Two. Findings**

- 21 A. This is a funding request for the Administrative Office of the Courts to, in
22 part, improve internet connectivity across judicial districts, update Navajo
23 Rules and Reporter, develop, plan design a central records management
24 facility and archive system for the Judicial Districts. See Exhibit A.
- 25 B. The supplemental funding request forms are attached as Exhibit A.
- 26 C. The Office of Management and Budget has been informed of this request.
- 27 D. The Office of the Controller has provided a memorandum dated September 8,
28 2017 indicating the balance in the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance as
29 of September 8, 2017 is \$31,258,307. This memorandum is provided to meet
30 the requirements of 12 N.N.C, 820 (L), however the Controller of the Navajo

1 Nation has not designated the funds as recurring or non-recurring. This
2 memorandum is attached as Exhibit B.

- 3 E. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest of the Navajo people to approve
4 this supplemental appropriation request.
5

6 **Section Three. Approving the Supplemental Appropriation from the Unreserved,**
7 **Undesignated Fund Balance in the Amount of \$3,142,117.00 for the**
8 **Administrative Office of the Courts.**

- 9 A. This supplemental appropriation of \$3,142,117.00 shall be from that amount
10 of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the Unreserved,
11 Undesignated Fund Balance as determined by the Office of the Controller
12 and to Business Unit Number 102001.

- 13 B. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the supplemental appropriation from the
14 Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance to the Tselani-Cottonwood Chapter
15 for the Administrative Office of the Courts, Business Unit Number 102001
16 for \$3,142,117.00.

18 **Section Four. Effective Date**

19 The provisions of this Act shall become effective in accord with 2 N.N.C. § 221(B).


PART II. REASON FOR REQUEST AND STATEMENT OF NEED:


The Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) is requesting supplemental funding in the amount of \$3,142,117. The Judicial Branch has limited funding to cover Operations and Maintenance (O&M) Costs for the entire fiscal year. Additional funding request are as follows: Travel - \$128,000 which includes funding for seven (7) new vehicles for Judicial Districts and Travel expense for staff; Meeting Expense - \$134,096 for Process Servers and non-employees. Supplies - \$75,000 for Laptops for training and funding to produce Navajo Reporter, Vol. X; Repairs & Maintenance - \$400,000 to improve Internet/Connectivity across Judicial Districts; Contractual Services - \$750,000 for Consultants to update Navajo Court Rules, produce Navajo Reporter, Vol. X; Computer and Audit Services; Special Transactions - \$37,021 for training fees and insurance premiums for new vehicles; Capital Outlay - \$1,618,000 to develop, plan and design a Central Records Management Facility and Archive System.

PART III. SCOPE OF WORK/METHODOLOGY




Subject: Financial Update-(General Fund Revenue, Expenditures, UUFB)

The gross General Fund Revenues, (see Exhibit "A"), as of August 31, 2017 is \$203,053,235, (see Footnote 1). The total General Fund set asides is \$ \$51,749,599 (Footnote 2). The Net Revenue for the General Fund is \$151,303,727 (see Footnote 3). The permanent fund income transfer is \$24,411,000 (Footnote 4). The reserve taken for the permanent fund income transfer is \$2,885,000 (Footnote 5). The grand total revenue for the General Fund is \$172,829,727 (see Footnote 6) which is 98.78% of the projection.

Next, are the total expenditures by Branch, (see Exhibit "B"), as of August 31, 2017, the Legislative Branch has expenditures of \$14,836,331 (see Footnote 1a); encumbrances of \$822,493 (see Footnote 1b) with a remaining budget of \$3,307,669 (see Footnote 1c). The Executive Branch expenditures are \$162,500,722 (see Footnote 2a); encumbrances are \$7,206,122 (see Footnote 2b) with a remaining budget of \$37,797,219 (see Footnote 2c). The Judicial Branch expenditures are \$11,718,156 (see Footnote 3a); with encumbrances of \$73,692 (see Footnote 3b) and remaining budget of \$2,356,349 (see Footnote 3c). Total General Fund expenditures are \$189,055,209 (see Footnote 4a); total encumbrances are \$8,102,307 (see Footnote 4b) with an overall remaining budget of \$43,461,236 (see Footnote 4c).

The updated Undesignated Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB), (see Exhibit "C") as of September 8, 2017 is \$31,258,217. The Fiscal Year 2016 audited numbers were approved via CJY-51-17 and an amount of \$11,728,198 that was previously reserved for debt service for capital projects was returned back to the UUFB with the approval of CJY-50-17. These two amounts have been incorporated into this new schedule.

SUBJECT : Legislation 0385-17: Supplemental Appropriation for the Administrative Office of the Courts in the amount of \$3,142,117 from the UUFB.

1. The Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary Form and the Budget Form are signed and dated September 15, 2017. The forms need to be updated.
2. There is another proposal submitted to OMB for all eighteen Judicial Branch programs which totals to the amount of \$425,950. This amount of \$425,950 is included as Exhibit 'L' in the FY 2018 budget resolution CS-53-17. Therefore, the Administrative Office of the Courts has two supplemental appropriations proposal going through the Legislative review process. What are the priorities?
3. In a memorandum dated October 2, 2017, OMB informed the Branch Chiefs and Navajo Nation Council that there are 30 UUFB proposals totaling more than \$46 million. Since then, there are more (possibly 10) and the new total amount requested is about \$60 million. Again, what are the priorities?
4. The Appropriations Act requires that non-recurring funds be used for non-recurring purposes (12 NNC § 820 (E), (F), (J), (L). The Controller would make this determination.
