RE : Legislative Process Regarding What Constitutes Committee Action

Question Presented

When a committee is not a final authority committee, what is the effect to legislation placed on the approved agenda when it does not receive a motion or second to consider?

Short Answer

The legislation moves forward to the next assigned Committee or Council as required at 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(12).

Analysis

The Rules of Order for Standing Committees of the Navajo Nation Council, Rule 11, states:
“If there is no second to the main motion, the motion shall be void and the legislation shall be automatically stricken from the committee agenda.”

This rule is in conflict with the statutes as found at 2 N.N.C. §164 (A)(12) which require:

“A legislation that does not receive sufficient vote for passage by a committee with final approval authority over the matter shall be deemed permanently eliminated from the agenda of the Committee. A legislation that does not receive sufficient vote for passage by a committee without final approval authority over the matter shall move forward to the subsequent assigned committee(s) or Navajo Nation Council for action. If the voting results of the committee with final approval authority over the legislation are different from the voting results of the other committee to which legislation was assigned, the legislation shall be

referred to the Naabik'iyáti' Committee for final action, notwithstanding any other delegations to other committees of final approval authority."

Operationally the conflict between the procedures described at Rule 11 in the Rules of Order for Standing Committees and the requirements of the Navajo Nation Code at 2 N.N.C. §164 (A)(12), both as cited above, raises the question of which requirement applies? The answer is that whenever there is a conflict between a statute and an adopted rule on the same matter, the statute prevails.

Further examination into the operational particulars that confront a committee also raises the question of what constitutes "...not receiving sufficient vote for passage..."

Previous analysis by the Office of Legislative Counsel has established that a committee without final approval authority over legislation that is part of an approved agenda, and the sponsor or co-sponsor are present, is acting on that legislation when it:

- 1) Recommends passage or non-passage as in voting for or against the legislation;
- 2) Tables the legislation, in which case, per 2 N.N.C. §164 (A)(11), the legislation moves on;
- 3) Not making a first or second motion on the legislation before it. In not acting, the committee essentially recommends a "do not pass" on the legislation. The Committee has the opportunity to consider and make recommendations on the proposed legislation to the final approval authority. The lack of a main motion and second to the motion is to be noted in the committee report and the proposed resolution should proceed to the final approval authority committee or Navajo Nation Council for consideration.

The legislative process as created in 2 N.N.C. 164 (A) is specifically designed so that any legislation can make its way to the ultimate legislative approval authority and not be impeded or stopped by any committee not having final approval authority.

I trust this helps clarify the issues the Committee recently faced. I have can be of further assistance or answer additional questions and concerns, please let me know.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Authority

A. The Law and Order Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation Council on proposed amendments and enactments to the Navajo Nation Code. 2 N.N.C. § 601(B)(14).

B. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council serves as the oversight committee for the Navajo Nation chapters. 2 N.N.C. § 501(C)(1).

C. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to coordinate and review all fiscal, financial and investment activities of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 301(B)(5).

D. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee considers proposed resolutions that require final action by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(9).

1 E. The Navajo Nation Council approves enactments and amendments of positive law. 2
2 N.N.C. § 164(A).

4 **Section 2. Findings**

- 5 A. The current formula for distributions to chapters is governed by the “fifty-fifty” method
6 as indicated in 12 N.N.C. § 820(O).
7 B. Some concerns have been expressed by chapters with a smaller population of registered
8 voters that the current distribution method provides a greater advantage to chapters with a
9 larger population of registered voters.
10 C. The “seventy-thirty” method would provide chapters with a smaller population of
11 registered voters additional funds from appropriations intended for all chapters of the
12 Navajo Nation.
13 D. Examples of the Fiscal Year 2020 Planning Allocations using the current and proposed
14 distribution method are attached as **Exhibits A** and **B**, respectively.

16 **Section 3. Amendments to Title 12 of the Navajo Nation Code**

17 The Navajo Nation hereby approves amendments to the Navajo Nation Code, Title 12,

28 O. Where not otherwise prohibited by existing law, any appropriation intended for
29 distribution to all chapters of the Navajo Nation shall be as follows: ~~fifty~~ seventy percent
30 ~~(50%)~~ (70%) of the appropriation shall be divided equally among all chapters and the

1 remaining ~~fifty~~ thirty percent (~~50%~~) (30%) shall be divided proportionately among the
2 chapters using a percentage equal to that figure which the number of registered voters in
3 each chapter bears to the whole of registered Navajo Nation voters as determined by the
4 most current voter registration figures available as of the date of the appropriation.

8 **Section 4. Effective Date**

9 The amendments enacted herein shall be effective pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §221.

11 **Section 5. Codification**

12 The provisions of the Act which amend or adopt new sections of the Navajo Nation Code
13 shall be codified by the Office of Legislative Counsel. The Office of Legislative Counsel
14 shall incorporate such amended provisions in the next codification of the Navajo Nation
15 Code.

17 **Section 6. Saving Clause**

18 Should any portion of the amendment enacted herein be determined invalid by the Navajo
19 Nation Supreme Court, or the District Court of the Navajo Nation, without appeal to the
20 Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those portions not determined invalid shall remain the law of
21 the Navajo Nation.

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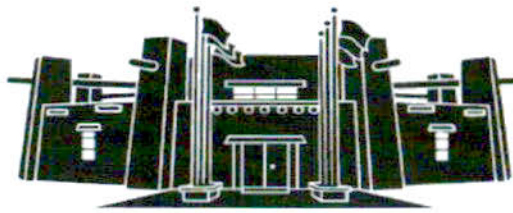

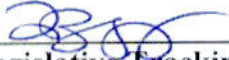

RE: Five (5) Day Comment Period on Chapter Funding Distribution Legislation #0241-19

On behalf of the Chinle Chapter Administration, the legislation being proposed by Delegate Jimmy Yellowhair, #0241-19, does not make chapters more efficient or seem like a logical idea. The notion that funding can be better suited for smaller chapters by creating this change is not ideal nor logical. Instead you will create more opportunities for smaller chapters to not be accountable and mismanage funding and this affects the larger chapters as those that are LGA Certified still need funding to have match funds for grants they seek or obtain plus Administrative Costs that are incurred will suffer and funding to pay operating costs too.

A good example of this can be seen by the sponsoring delegate's chapters (5), they alone have approximately \$3,689,364.00 in funding sitting in their Fund Balance for Fiscal Year 2019 at the end of July 2019. That averages to \$737,873.00 per chapter he represents up to the end of July 2019. Chinle Chapter at this point has \$228,400.00 ending the month of July 2019. This information was obtained from the WIND System for the chapters under public access. This is a good example of showing how a chapter that is fiscally sound should be and notice the disparaging difference by \$500,000.00. The notion that more money for smaller chapters by making the change in the chapter funding distribution is NOT substantiated nor justified as this is a prime example and shows that this legislation was made in haste and not properly thought out. (Attached are WIND print outs for Fund Balances of sponsoring delegate and Chinle Chapter)

A look into all 110 chapters will show that making this change is not for the betterment of chapters but a call for making more unaccountability to occur and happen. Some of those chapters that have become LGA certified and use this concept to their advantage rely upon the 50/50 distribution and if anything, a change in the distribution should favor those chapters that use their funding correctly and demonstrate accountability by having clean audits. Those chapters must have funding to provide match for Grants they obtain and seek which benefit their communities. At one time, LGA Land Trust Funds was counted on for paying utility costs and operating costs but that funding has shrunk to the extent that a chapter like the size of Chinle could not pay its bills due the proposed legislation.

In closing, the legislation to change the chapter funding distribution should NOT happen and is not Fiscally sound and right at this time.

4. Chinle Chapter Government feels that the matter of concerns by smaller chapters needs to be addressed in a more tactful manner and not just through hearsay as you have smaller chapters that are NOT using their current allocated funds; and
5. Chinle Chapter Government expends all funds appropriated in a useful and timely manner and in looking at small chapters, they do not use the funds appropriately nor do they use the funds as evident in the huge amounts of funding carried over by them; and
6. Chinle Chapter Government will be greatly impacted in having NO matching funds for the outside Grants they have acquired and are pursuing; and
7. Chinle Chapter Government will have NO funding to cover costs attributed to daily operations such as utility and water costs as the funding of Fund 3 (Land Claims Trust) will be non-existent and this also includes Administrative Costs; and

1. Chichiltah Chapter is certified Navajo Nation Chapter is delegated the governmental authority with respect to local matters consistent with Navajo Law, including customs, traditions and fiscal matters; and

Chichiltah Chapter had a very large land base with a large voting population continues to work with a inadequate budget to cover cost for expenditures, infrastructure and the basic needs for our community membership and this legislation does not address the many elements of each Chapter and lacks data to support this legislation.

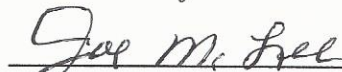

3. Pursuant 2 N.N.C SECTION: 4028; the Eastern Navajo Agency Council is vested with government authority to review all matters affecting the community to make most appropriate recommendations when necessary to the Navajo Nation, County, State, Federal and other local agencies; and
4. The current distribution to Chapters is governed by the 'Fifty-Fifty' method as indicated in 12 N.N.C. Section 820(O); and
5. Some Navajo Chapters have expressed concern that Chapters with fewer registered voters are at a disadvantage to Chapters with a larger number of registered votes; and
6. Legislation No. 0241-19 as drafted indicates the method/formula to be modified to Seventy percent (70%) and Thirty percent (30%).

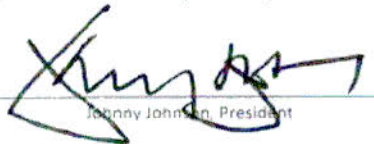
