PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to approve a project change within Council Resolution CAP-35-18 for Chilchinbeto Chapter.


This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Authority

- A. The Resources and Development Committee exercises authority over chapters of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 501(C)(1).
- B. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council exercises authority over budgeting, appropriation, investment and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. § 301 (B)(2).
- C. Council Resolution CAP-35-18 provides, “[a] chapter project, powerline, or waterline project may be changed, including the year funded, or added to Exhibits A through E with the concurrence of the Delegate representing the chapter’s Council District and the approvals of the Resources and Development Committee and Budget and Finance Committee, as long as such project has been certified as construction-ready by CPMD or NTUA and the total Síhasin Funding for the District does not exceed \$4,166,666.67.” CAP-35-18, Section Four, Paragraph

1 **Section Two. Findings**

2 A. The Navajo Nation Council adopted Council Resolution CAP-35-18, "Adopting the
3 Síhasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan Pursuant to CD-68-14,
4 as Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, as Amended; Waiving 12
5 N.N.C. §§ 810 (F), 820 (I) and (M) and 860 (C) Relating to the Capital Budget and
6 Capital Improvement Process" on April 17, 2018.

7 B. Chilchinbeto Chapter requests to change the approved funding year in CAP-35-18 to
8 delete \$300,000 from year one funding in project D-65 and to add \$300,000 to year
9 three funding. Chilchinbeto further requests the project scope be changed from multi-
10 purpose building to include plan, design, and construct Chilchinbeto multi-purpose
11 building.

12 C. The Síhasin Project Amendment Certification, attached as **Exhibit A**, has been signed by
13 the Delegate representing the chapter's council district as required by CAP-35-18,
14 section 4, paragraph C. 2. No chapter resolution is required pursuant to CAP-35-18.

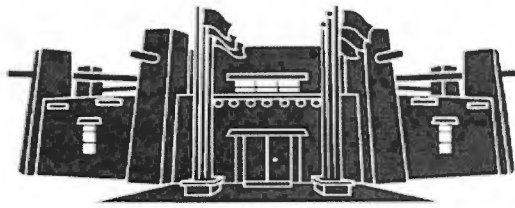

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
