Section Two. Findings

- A. The Navajo Nation Council adopted Council Resolution CAP-35-18, "Adopting the Síhasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan Pursuant to CD-68-14, as Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, as Amended; Waiving 12 N.N.C. §§ 810 (F), 820 (I) and (M) and 860 (C) Relating to the Capital Budget and Capital Improvement Process" on April 17, 2018.
- B. Chilchinbeto Chapter requests to change the approved funding year in CAP-35-18 to delete \$300,000 from year one funding in project D-65 and to add \$300,000 to year three funding. Chilchinbeto further requests the project scope be changed from multipurpose building to include plan, design, and construct Chilchinbeto multi-purpose building.
- C. The Síhasin Project Amendment Certification, attached as **Exhibit A**, has been signed by the Delegate representing the chapter's council district as required by CAP-35-18, section 4, paragraph C. 2. No chapter resolution is required pursuant to CAP-35-18.

The Navajo Nation hereby approves the project change requested by Chilchinbeto Chapter in accordance with **Exhibit A.**
