RELATING TO BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE; APPROVING THE GAMING
DEVELOPMENT FUND BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016

BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Findings.

- A. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 1606 the Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council shall provide oversight for the Gaming Development Fund.
- B. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 1604 the Controller of the Navajo Nation shall have authority to approve fund expenditures pursuant to a budget and operating plan approved by the Budget and Finance Committee. The Office of the Controller shall establish policies and procedures governing the procedure by which parties may make application to the Controller for approval of expenditures.
- C. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 1604, the Budget and Finance Committee approved BFCMA-05-07, the Navajo Nation Gaming Development Fund Policies and Procedures.
- D. Pursuant to a memorandum dated October 12, 2015, Exhibit A attached hereto, from the Office of the Controller, there is an amount of \$8,345,160.00 that is available for budgeting for the FY 2016 Gaming Development Fund Budget.

E. Three governmental entities submitted proposals for funding from the Gaming Development Fund pursuant to the policies and procedures. These are the Navajo Nation Gaming Regulatory Office for \$6,328,706, Exhibit C attached hereto, and the Office of the Controller for \$66,454, Exhibit D attached hereto, and Navajo Nation Gaming Enterprise for \$1,950,000.00, Exhibit E;

Section Two. Approval

- A. The Budget and Finance Committee, pursuant to 12 N.N.C § 1604, hereby approves the Gaming Development Fund budget for Fiscal Year 2015 at \$8,345,160 as found in Exhibits C and D attached here to.
- B. The Budget and Finance Committee approves the carryover of any unexpended amount from FY' 15 to FY'16 for Business Unit No. 507007 to be utilized for the Navajo Nation Gaming Regulatory Office.

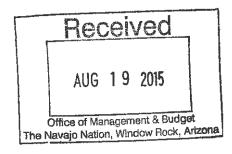

In accordance with the Navajo Nation's Gaming Development Fund, please consider this letter as a request for \$1,923,374 from the Navajo Gaming Development Fund to pay for gaming development within the Navajo Nation.

I. CONTACT PERSON

II. USE OF FUNDS

The Navajo Nation Gaming Enterprise ("Enterprise") is a wholly-owned Navajo Nation business entity created by the Navajo Nation Council to conduct gaming and hospitality activities within the Navajo Nation in accordance with Navajo law, the applicable Navajo Nation-state gaming compacts, and federal law. The Enterprise's long-term plan is to improve and expand our current gaming facilities as well as to continue to develop gaming hospitality facilities on Navajo lands.

The Enterprise through its four (4) facilities employs over 1,200 employees, of which over 83 percent are Navajos, and the development of these properties has provided construction employment for hundreds of Navajo construction workers, Navajo subcontracts, and Navajo vendors and suppliers. The Enterprise is currently paying interest on its gaming loan, and applicable Navajo taxes and fees to the Navajo Nation.

The Enterprise is presently working to improve and expand our current gaming facilities as well as to continue to develop gaming hospitality facilities (Class III gaming) on

Navajo lands that are on the perimeter of the Navajo Nation, and several select bingo hall/casinos and/or hotel facilities on Navajo lands within the Navajo Nation. Specifically a permanent structure at Fire Rock Navajo Casino, expanded services at Twin Arrows Navajo Casino Resort with the development of an RV park and a hotel conference center expansion at Northern Edge Navajo Casino. As part of this development work, the Enterprise will continue to meet with standing committees of the Navajo Nation Council, Navajo Tribal Utility Authority (NTUA), Navajo Nation Department of Justice, Navajo Nation Division of Economic Development, Navajo Nation Environmental Protection Agency (NNEPA), other Navajo government divisions, departments and advisors on various issues dealing with the operations of four (4) Navajo casinos and the development of other properties.

In addition, the Enterprise continues to work with external consultants to develop various land surveys, reports, archeological surveys, land user consents, land withdrawal, land purchases, utility and infrastructure information (availability of water, waste water, electricity, road access, etc.) for projects under consideration.

Finally, the Enterprise has been continuing to work with the Investment Committee, Office of the Controller, and the Budget and Finance Committee to refinance, consolidate, and manage the four outstanding loans for Fire Rock Navajo Casino, Flowing Water Navajo Casino, Northern Edge Navajo Casino and Twin Arrows Navajo Casino Resort.

Below are the activities of the Enterprise, as it relates to the gaming development within the Navajo Nation and as it directly relates to the request for funds from the Gaming Development Fund. The fund request will allow the Enterprise to continue its gaming development which includes hiring, contracting, or procuring Enterprise development staff and management, contractors, subcontractors, consultants, attorneys, and other companies to compile studies, surveys, legal opinions, reviews, analysis, pre-opening costs, opening costs, negotiations, and the one-year development cost and projects for each Navajo casino and hotel project. Finally the negotiated financial loans with the Navajo Nation require the Enterprise to contribute gaming revenues and other revenue sources, other than the loan funds, to develop the proposed casinos. Therefore, the fund request will allow the Enterprise to continue its gaming and hospitality development through the programs listed below:

1. Gaming, Hospitality & Tourism Expansion

Complete the expansion feasibility studies in order to prioritize project development opportunities, both on and off Navajo, to include a full economic impact analysis required to calculate ROI.

2. AZ Gaming Compact Initiative

Seek and execute favorable changes to the Arizona Department of Gaming Appendices.

3. Gaming Enterprise Property Development

Define options for constructing a permanent facility for Fire Rock Navajo Casino which would replace the temporary sprung structure. In addition, we plan to complete the Twin Arrows Master Plan and the Northern Edge Navajo Casino Master Plan as part of multiplan phases through 2020.

4. Other Development

The Enterprise continues to work with the Navajo Nation to protect Navajo gaming interests from other Indian tribes and other private gaming interests.

III. NAVAJO NATION BENEFIT

The property improvements and gaming hospitality development plans listed above will:

- 1. Increase revenues:
- 2. Increase Navajo jobs;
- 3. Build additional roads and utility infrastructure across the Nation;
- 4. Create additional tax streams to the Nation; as well as,
