19	A. The Budget and Finance Committee exercise oversight of the Office of the Controller.

28	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS.	
29	A. The Office of the Controller ("OOC") is a program in the Executive Branch of the	
30	Navajo Nation government.	

- B. A full and complete performance audit of OOC is necessary to identify potential issues or deficiencies within the operations of OOC.
- C. The Navajo Nation Office of the Auditor General is responsible for conducting audits on for Navajo Nation government divisions, departments, programs, and offices, or for outsourcing audits through the Navajo Nation's procurement process.
- D. The Budget and Finance Committee determines that conducting a performance audit of OOC is necessary at this time to determine how OOC's performance and operations can be improved.

## SECTION THREE. DIRECTIVE THE OFFCIE OF THE AUDITOR GENERAL

A. The Navajo Nation Budget and Finance Committee directs the Auditor General to include the Office of the Controller in its Fiscal Year 2021 Audit Plan schedule.
